## MINNESOTA, CROOKSTON PREVIEW

The Golden Eagles are coming off one of their strongest weekends of the season after picking up road victories over two teams in the top half of the conference by taking down Northern State 75-66 and U-Mary 70-65. Minnesota, Crookston is currently in a tie for ninth in the conference with BSU's other opponent this weekend, MSU Moorhead. The Golden Eagles handled the Beavers in Bemidji earlier this season with UMC holding the Beavers scoreless for the first seven minutes of the game on Dec. 4.

The Golden Eagles are led by reigning *NSIC Player of the Week* Jamie Zelinsky who averaged 20 points and seven rebounds in UMC's two victories last weekend. Zelinsky tallied 17 points against the Beavers in December. The Golden Eagles had four players score in double figures against BSU earlier this season as they shot 56.9 percent from the field and outrebounded the Beavers 42-33. UMC shot 50 percent from beyond the arc led by two threes apiece from Zelinsky, Bri Zabel and Gina Jaroszewski.

## SERIES HISTORY

Bemidji State leads the all-time series against Minnesota, Crookston 17-8. The Golden Eagles have captured the last three games from the Beavers with BSU last upending UMC 78-76 on Valentine's Day in 2009. The Beavers last win in Crookston came on Feb. 10, 2008.

## MSU MOORHEAD PREVIEW

After opening the season 6-1, the Dragons have had a mixed bag of results as they currently sit tied for ninth in the NSIC standings. MSU Moorhead is coming off a weekend with two losses to Northern State and U-Mary. The Dragons have dropped five of their last six games with their only win coming against Minnesota, Crookston on Jan. 29.

Angie Jetvig leads MSU Moorhead averaging 18.7 points and 8.4 rebounds. Jetvig gave the Beavers all sorts of problems in their meeting earlier this season. Jetvig had 22 points on eight of 10 shooting from the field in the Dragons' 74-46. MSU Moorhead shot 44.2 percent from the floor against BSU earlier this season including 37.5 percent from beyond the arc led by Betsy Dickson's three of three performance from downtown.

## SERIES HISTORY

BSU has lost its last five meetings to MSU Moorhead with its last victory coming Feb. 2, 2008 in Bemidji 92-91.

## BSU WEEKEND PREVIEW

The Beavers will look to end a 12-game road losing streak and nine-game overall losing streak when they head to face University of Minnesota, Crookston and Minnesota State University Moorhead this weekend. BSU has not won on the road since Jan. 29, 2010 when they defeated Minnesota State University. The Beavers have not won of the season since upending No. 21 Augustana College on Jan. 8, 2011.

BSU is led on the season by **Colleen McKay** (Sr., C, Barnum, Minn.) averaging 9.2 points per game. **Jessie Althoff** (So., F/C, Becker, Minn.) is right behind McKay in the scoring column with a 9.1 points per game average. The Beavers have had a strong boost in January and February from freshman guard **Morgan Lee** (Hayward, Wis.). Lee is averaging 7.1 points per game since the UMD game in Duluth on Jan. 3.

## BSU RANKED IN TOP 15 NATIONALLY FOR FREE THROWS

The BSU women's basketball moved up to No. 15 nationally this week in free-throw percentage according to the NCAA National Statistics Summary for Division II. The Beavers jumped two in the rankings after being ranked No. 17 nationally for free-throw percentage a week prior. The Beavers men's and women's team make up one of four universities in the country to be ranked in the top 15 for both men and women joining Bellarmine University (Ky.), University of Nebraska Kearney and St. Cloud State University.

## BEAVER PRIDE ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

BSU has had three players honored as the *Beaver Pride Female Athlete of the Week* so far this season. **Colleen McKay** (Sr., C, Barnum, Minn.) earned her second honor of the season after averaging 16 points and nine rebounds as the Beavers split with No. 21 Augustana and No. 9 Wayne State. McKay along with **Anna Hebrink** (Sr., G, Austin, Minn.) and **Ellie Wessling** (Fr., G/F, Winsted, Minn.) are the three Beaver players to be honored this season.

## HANG ON!

Bemidji State has run into troubles this season when it can't hold onto the ball. In the Beavers' nine games this season in which they had 20 turnovers or more they have only come away with one victory and have been dealt seven losses. BSU has struggled even more to maintain control of the basketball in the new year as they are averaging 20.5 turnovers per game in 2011 and are 1-9 so far in the new year with their only victory coming in an upset victory over No. 21 Augustana College. BSU is 4-2 when they have fewer than 20 turnovers in a game.

## SCORING OPTIONS

BSU has a lot of players on the roster this season with the capability to score double-figures. That can be a good or bad thing as the Beavers have found inconsistency to be a problem this season. BSU has had eight different players lead the team in scoring and seven different players lead the team on the glass this season. **Jessie Althoff** (So., F/C, Becker, Minn.), **Ellie Wessling** (Fr., G/F, Winsted, Minn.) and **Colleen McKay** (Sr., C, Barnum, Minn.) have led the way in scoring five different times this season, which marks the most for any BSU player.

## BSU AGAINST RANKED FOES

Bemidji State has played some of their best games this season against teams ranked in the top 25. On Nov. 19 at the Maverick Classic in Mankato, Minn., the Beavers came within two points in the waning seconds against No. 19 California University (Pa.) but ultimately came short. Then last Saturday the Beavers followed up their early season performance with an upset of No. 21 Augustana College. The win is the first victory for BSU over a ranked opponent since upended defending National Champion Minnesota State University, ranked No. 11 at the time, on Dec. 19, 2009. BSU struggled in their last ranked game on Sunday as they fell to conference-leading Wayne State College, ranked No. 9 in the country.

## NEW YEAR BRINGS BIG NUMBERS FOR LEE

The new year has seen an improved **Morgan Lee** (Fr., G, Hayward, Wis.). Lee is averaging 7.1 points per game since the turn of the calendar year. She has tallied four double-figure scoring performances. Prior to 2011, Lee had been averaging 4.9 points per game and was held to no double-figure scoring outings.

## ROAD WOES

Bemidji State has lost their last 12 games on the road dating back to Jan. 29, 2010 when they defeated Minnesota State at the Taylor Center, 71-69. The Beavers are 0-7 in road games this year losing their last two to Concordia, St. Paul and St. Cloud State on the road. The Beavers will have four more chances to end the streak this season as they have road trips against MSU Moorhead, UM-Crookston, Winona State and Upper Iowa remaining on the schedule.

## BEMIDJI STATE IN TOURNAMENT GAMES

BSU holds a 9-13 record in tournament games under Curfman. BSU went 1-1 this season in tournament games picking up a victory over Grand View and a loss to No. 19 California (Pa.) at the Maverick Classic in Mankato, Minn. The Beavers went 3-1 last season in nonconference tournaments picking up wins against Western State and Western New Mexico at the Grand Canyon Thanksgiving Tournament and Martin Luther at the Grinnell Tip-Off Tournament. The three tournament victories in 2009 were the most in one season under a Curfman coached squad. The Beavers went 2-2 in 2007 with victories over St. Scholastica and Wisconsin-Stout at the University of Wisconsin-Stout Tournament.
