WINONA STATE PREVIEW

Coach Scott Ballard has the warriors off to their best start in school history as Winona State University will enter BSU Gymnasium on Friday with an unblemished 5-0 mark and a 1-0 record in NSIC play.

The Warriors are led by the sharp shooting of Katie Wolff, who is currently averaging 16 points per game. Wolff comes into Friday's game shooting 60.7 percent from beyond the arc. In addition to Wolff, Winona State will look to 6-0 forward Michelle McDonald who is currently averaging 15 points and seven rebounds per game. Senior forward Natalie Gigler also comes into Friday averaging in double figures (11.8 points per game).

Winona State has wins over Upper Iowa University, Saint Mary's University, Clarke College, University of Colorado at Colorado Springs and Oklahoma Panhandle State University entering the weekend.

SERIES HISTORY

Bemidji State leads the all-time series with Winona State 38-28. The Beavers and Warriors split last years meetings with BSU upending Winona State 79-69 on the road and falling 78-67 to the Warriors at BSU Gymnasium.

UPPER IOWA PREVIEW

The Peacocks are under the leadership of new coach Carol Russell, who arrives from Nebraska Kearney where she led the Lopers to five NCAA tournament appearances in eight seasons. Upper Iowa enters Saturday with an 0-5 mark. The Peacocks lost to Winona State 89-58 to open conference play last weekend.

Upper Iowa is led by senior center Cassandra Deiters and her 12.6 points per game. Junior Heidi McKean has chipped in 11.2 points per game.

SERIES HISTORY

BSU currently has the upper hand against Upper Iowa with a 7-3 lead in the all-time series with the Peacocks. The Beavers won their only meeting with Upper Iowa last season 78-76 in Fayette, Iowa.

BSU WEEKEND PREVIEW

The Bemidji State University women's basketball team enters play on Friday with a 3-3 mark after picking up an 83-31 victory over the College of St Scholastica on Wednesday led by **Samantha Baldwin's** (Jr., G, St. Thomas, N.D.) first career double-double with 11 points and a career-high 13 rebounds.

Baldwin continues to be one of the most consistent players for BSU. The 5-7 guard is currently averaging 9.3 points and 5.5 rebounds through five games. She has tallied double-figure scoring on four occasions this season. In addition to Baldwin, the Beavers have had strong play from freshmen Melissa Borstner and Ellie Wessling, along with sophomore Jessie Althoff. Borstner and Wessling are the team's leading scorers entering Friday with a 10.8 per game average. Althoff is currently averaging 8.5 points and 4.7 rebounds.

The Beavers are 0-2 in nonconference play after struggling against MSU Moorhead and Minnesota, Crookston last weekend. BSU failed to score a basket for the first seven minutes of the contest against the Golden Eagles.

BALDWIN A DOUBLE-FIGURE MACHINE

Samantha Baldwin tallied only one double-figure scoring outing last season for the Beavers with 10 points against U-Mary. However, Baldwin has become a new player of sorts thus far in the 2010-11 season. She has tallied double-figure scoring in four-of-six games and tallied her first career double-double against the College of St. Scholastica. Baldwin scored in double figures in seven games as a freshman. Her 13 rebounds against CSS marks the third time in her career she has grabbed over 10 rebounds.

BSU DEFEATS CSS, 83-31

The Bemidji State Beavers dominated play on Wednesday ending the night with a 83-31 victory over the College of St. Scholastica. The 52-point victory marked the first win by over 50 points since since upending the University of Minnesota Morris by 58 points on Feb. 22, 2003. The 31 points by St. Scholastica marks the lowest scoring output for a BSU opponent in a Beaver victory since giving up 35 points to St. Catharine's during the 1984-85 season.

NEWCOMERS SHINE

The newcomers of the Bemidji State University women's basketball team exploded onto the scene in their first three games as **Ellie Wessling** (Fr., G/F, Winsted, Minn.) and **Melissa Borstner** (Fr., G, East Bethel, Minn.) are currently BSU's two leading scorers averaging 14.0 points and 13.7 points, respectively. Wessling and Borstner continue to be the team's leading scorers through six games with each averaging 10.8 points per game.

In addition to Wessling and Borstner, BSU has gotten key minutes from freshmen **Morgan Lee** (Fr., G, Hayward, Wis.) and **Kate Warmack** (Fr., C, East Grand Forks, Minn.). Lee scored seven second-half points on Saturday against Minnesota, Crookston. Warmack tallied 11 boards on Wednesday against St. Scholastica.

EPEMA WATCH

Sydney Epema (Jr., G, Crookston, Minn.) had shown her prowess from beyond the arc in her first two seasons in Bemidji as she currently ranks fifth all-time for career threes with 136. Epema needs 33 threes to surpass Kris DeMaris in fourth place. Epema had 56 made three-pointers as a sophomore after tallying 73 as a freshman. Her 73 made three-pointers still ranks third all-time for most made threes in a season.

BEMIDJI STATE IN TOURNAMENT GAMES

BSU now holds a 9-13 record in tournament games under Curfman. BSU went 1-1 this season in tournament games picking up a victory over Grand View and a loss to No. 19 California (Pa.) at the Maverick Classic in Mankato, Minn. The Beavers went 3-1 last season in nonconference tournaments picking up wins against Western State and Western New Mexico at the Grand Canyon Thanksgiving Tournament and Martin Luther at the Grinnell Tip-Off Tournament. The three tournament victories in 2009 were the most in one season under a Curfman coached squad. The Beavers went 2-2 in 2007 with victories over St. Scholastica and Wisconsin-Stout at the University of Wisconsin-Stout Tournament.

BSU AGAINST RANKED FOES

Bemidji State played their first game against a ranked foe when they faced No. 19 California University (Pa.). The Beavers came up just short of an upset against the Vulcans as they were within two points with less than 30 seconds remaining in the game. BSU is 3-13 in the Curfman era against ranked foes. Last season they upended defending NCAA Champion Minnesota State, ranked No. 11 at the time.

NSIC PLAYER TO WATCH

Jessie Althoff (So., F/C, Becker, Minn.) was selected as BSU's Player to Watch by the NSIC heading into the season. Althoff led the team in scoring last season with 10.1 points per game as a freshman. She was selected as an NSIC All-Freshman team member following the conclusion of the season.
