#### THE GAME

The Bemidji State University women's basketball team (4-1; 0-1 NSIC, 0-1 NSIC North) opens its home portion of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference schedule Dec. 6-7 when it welcomes St. Cloud State University (5-0; 1-0 NSIC, 1-0 NSIC North) and University of Minnesota Duluth (3-2; 0-1 NSIC, 0-1 NSIC North). Friday's contest is set for 6 p.m., while Saturday's game is scheduled for 4 p.m.

#### THE BEAVERS

The Beavers ran into a hot-shooting University of Minnesota Crookston team Nov. 30 in the NSIC opener in Crookston, Minn. The Golden Eagles knocked down eight 3-pointers in the first half, en route to a 13-for-20 (65%) game from long range to defeat the Beavers 104-84. BSU was guided by a 33-point, 11-rebound and five-block performance by senior **Kate Warmack**. Her 33 points were a career-high and the most by any NSIC player this season. Her four double-doubles this season is tied for the NSIC lead. Senior **Morgan Lee** is averaging a team-best 19.6 points per game, which ranks third in the league. Warmack leads the league in rebounding (11.6 rpg), sits fifth in scoring (19.4 ppg) and ranks sixth in field goal percentage (60.0%).

# Opponent Information / Game Notes

**The Huskies:** The St. Cloud State women's basketball team posted a 4-0 record in non-conference play before hosting Minnesota Duluth to open NSIC play. Five Huskies scored in double-figures, as SCSU downed the Bulldogs 81-73. Jessica Benson guided the team with 17 points and 11 rebounds for her fourth double-double of the season. She leads the team with 17.6 points and 10.2 rebounds per game. Rachael Moen leads the NSIC in assists per game (6.2 apg).

**All-time Series vs. the Huskies:** The Beavers are 14-33 all-time against SCSU and have lost seven of the last eight meetings. BSU lost 73-48 at home and 81-53 on the road last season.

**The Bulldogs:** The Minnesota Duluth women's basketball team is 3-2 overall and 0-1 in NSIC play after falling on the road to St. Cloud State, 81-73. Katrina Newman posted 18 points against the Huskies, while Hannah Rutten added 11 points and nine rebounds. Rutten is the team's leader in points (16.4 ppg) and rebounds (10.2 rpg). The Bulldogs own 12.8 steals per game to sit in a tie for first in the NSIC.

**All-time Series vs. the Bulldogs:** Bemidji State owns a 29-61 all-time mark against UMD and have lost the last 10 games versus the Bulldogs. In 2012-13, the Beavers lost 85-56 at home and 65-50 on the road.

**NSIC Preseason Poll/Player to Watch:** The Bemidji State University women's basketball team was picked to finish 14th in the 2013-14 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Coaches' Poll. Senior guard **Morgan Lee** (Hayward, Wis.) was named BSU's Player to Watch. The Beavers earned 45 overall points for 14th, while they were pegged eighth in the NSIC North Division.

**A Grand Accomplishment:** Senior guard **Morgan Lee** became the 16th player in Bemidji State women's basketball history to reach 1,000 career points with a 29-point effort in BSU's 85-61 victory over Western State (Colo.), Nov. 16. Lee follows in the footsteps of her father, David Lee, who scored 2,034 points for the Beavers as a student-athlete from 1984-88. She is currently 14th all-time on Bemidji State's scoring list.

**Mike Curfman** enters his ninth year as head women's basketball coach for the Beavers. Curfman has directed Bemidji State University to a 82-136 overall record (.376) in his eight seasons while posting a 49-107 (.314) mark in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference.

Curfman is the third-longest tenured coach in the program's history, trailing only Doreen Zierer who coached 12 seasons (1990-2002) and Ruth Howe who coached the programs' first 10 seasons (1967-77). With a 77-72 victory against Upper Iowa University Feb. 24, 2012, Curfman moved into third on BSU's all-time coaching victories list with 71 and trails Zierer (129) and Howe (95).

After posting his lowest win total at BSU in 2008-09, Curfman and the BSU women's basketball team bounced back with a 12-15 overall mark in 2009-10, making it the fourth season out of five that the Beavers have tallied more than 10 wins. The last time BSU had as many 10 win-seasons in such a short period of time was from 1994-99, when Zierer led the Beavers to four 10-win seasons in five years.

Curfman guided the Beavers to a top six finish and an appearance in the conference tournament in each of this first three seasons. In his first campaign (2005-06), he led BSU to a fifth place finish in the NSIC and hosted the first round of conference playoffs, but fell to Minnesota State University Moorhead 59-58 in overtime.

At the conclusion of the 2011-12 season, sophomore Morgan Lee was named Second Team All-NSIC. The award marked the 10th student-athlete under Curfman to earn all-conference laurels. Lee was the fourth player to earn second team or higher honors from the league. Amy Lawson is the lone First-Team All-NSIC member under Curfman, as she earned the award following the 2007-08 season and was also the 2006 NSIC Defensive Player of the Year. Ten players have been named NSIC Player of the Week, including three in each of the 2006-07 and 2007-08 seasons.

In the classroom, 24 student-athletes have earned Academic All-NSIC honors. In 2011, Colleen McKay earned the NSIC Myles Brand All-Academic with Distinction Award - an award bestowed to senior NSIC student-athletes who have a cumulative grade point average of 3.75 or higher, are exhausting their eligibility and are on track to graduate. Curfman's 2007-08 squad was named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll. Lawson guided the team on the court and in the classroom that season and was named to the ESPN The Magazine / College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) College Division Academic All-District V Third Team.

Rejuvenating a program is nothing new to Curfman, he came to Bemidji State after six years at the helm of the University of Minnesota, Crookston program where three times during his tenure his teams set or equaled school records for wins (2000-01, 2001-02 and 2004-05) and racked up 55 victories during his final four seasons.

While at UMC, he helped to elevate the program to the NCAA Division II level. After a 1-26 season in 1999-2000, Curfman directed the Golden Eagles to a school-record nine wins in 2000-01 and increased UMC's win total to 16 the following year. In 2002-03, under Curfman, UMC made the NSIC tournament for the first time, cruising to the championship game before falling to NCAA Tournament bound University of Minnesota Duluth. In his last season at UMC in 2004-05 his Golden Eagles tied for fourth place in the NSIC posting a league record of 8-6 while going 16-12 overall and making their first ever appearance in the North Central Regional Polls. Curfman has mentored 10 All-Conference selections as a head coach including 2000-01 NSIC Newcomer of the Year and 2001-02 Player of the Year Jessica Forsline and was himself named as the 2002 NSIC Coach of the Year.

Curfman's teams have done equally as well in the classroom. During his tenure at UMC, the Golden Eagles posted at least a 3.0 team grade point average and finished in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's Top 10 Academic National Rankings with a team G.P.A. of better than 3.4 in 2004-05.

Previous to taking over the UMC program, Curfman was an assistant coach at St. Cloud State University (1994-99), serving as Dr. Lori Ulferts' top assistant for five seasons. He also coached under Dr. Ulferts at Moorhead State University (1992-94) as an assistant while serving as the head coach of the junior varsity team. He has presented at a number of camps and clinics and is a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and the Minnesota State High School League Coaches Association.

A native of Fosston, Minn., Curfman was an Academic All-America selection for the UMC basketball team while earning his A.A.S. degree. He then moved on to Concordia College in Moorhead, Minn. where he graduated in 1992 with his B.A. in Business Administration while captaining the Cobber men's basketball program. In 1994, Curfman earned his MBA in business administration from Moorhead State University (now Minnesota State University Moorhead) while acting as an assistant coach for the Dragons' women's basketball program.
