### Bemidji State Player to Watch

Hanna Zerr ranks fourth on the team in scoring with 8.5 points per game, while leading the squad in assists with 53. Last time versus MSUM she scored a season-high 18 points with six assists.

#### THE GAME

The Bemidji State University women's basketball team (7-7, 3-7 NSIC) hosts Minnesota State University Moorhead (9-5, 5-5 NSIC) and Northern State University (12-2, 8-2 NSIC) for a pair Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference games Jan. 17-18. BSU and MSUM are set to begin at 6 p.m. Friday from the BSU Gymnasium, while Saturday's contest versus the Wolves is scheduled for a 4 p.m. start.

#### THE BEAVERS

The Beavers suffered a 99-82 loss at Augustana (receiving votes nationally) and an 87-41 setback at No. 11 Wayne State, Jan. 10-11. The Beavers look to protect their 5-2 home record this weekend, while trying to remedy a 1-3 start to 2014. Entering the new year, BSU was shooting 41.8 percent from the field, 37.8 percent from 3-point range and averaging 79.0 points per game. In the last four games, the Beavers have shot 33.7 percent from the field, 18.0 percent from 3-point land and averaged 54.5 points per game. Saturday's contest marks head coach **Mike Curfman's** 400th career game as a head coach. In his 15th season, Curfman spent six seasons as bench boss at Minnesota Crookston before coming to Bemidji State.

# Opponent Information / Game Notes

## Fast Break

- With 10.4 rebounds per game, **Kate Warmack** is third in the NSIC and 24th nationally.
- Warmack has recorded seven double-doubles this season to sit second in the league and tied for 15th in the nation.
- Warmack has twice posted a career-high 17 rebounds, which stands tied for second most in the NSIC this season for rebounds in a game.
- Warmack is shooting 55.4 percent from the field to rank fourth in the league and 28th in the nation.
- **Morgan Lee's** 2.6 3-pointers per game is tied for third in the conference and sits 36th in the nation. Her 42.4 shooting percentage from long range is 35th nationally.
- Lee knocked down seven 3-pointers versus Western State (Nov. 16) to sit tied for first in the league for most 3-pointers in a game. The mark also ranks tied for 14th nationally.
- The Beavers are 7-3 this season when Lee knocks down two or more 3-pointers.
- Bemidji State pulled down 58 rebounds against Finlandia (Nov. 19) to tie for the most rebounds in a game by any NSIC team.

## The Dragons

MSU Moorhead (9-5, 5-5 NSIC) owns a 3-1 record in its last four contests, with the one loss coming its last game versus then-No. 17 Minnesota State, 85-57. Three players are scoring in double-figures, guided by Morgan Zabel's 14.1 points per game. Megan Strese owns 11.4 points and a team-high 7.7 rebounds per game. The Dragons own a +6.7 rebounding margin in conference games to sit second in the NSIC.

## All-time Series vs. the Dragons

The Beavers are 39-58 all-time against the Dragons and are on a four-game losing streak to MSUM. MSU Moorhead downed Bemidji State in Moorhead, Minn. earlier this season 94-69. The last BSU win came on the road Dec. 2, 2011 by the score of 75-68. The teams have played three overtime games during Curfman's career (1-2).

## The Wolves

Northern State (12-2, 8-2 NSIC) owns a seven-game winning streak entering the weekend. Both of NSU's losses have come in NSIC play and on the road. Alison Kusler's 16.5 points per game guides a team with three players scoring in double-figures. Rachel Krogman has recorded 14.9 points and a team-best 10.5 rebounds per game. In league games, the Wolves rank first in rebounding margin (+9.5) and third in scoring margin (+7.4).

## All-time Series vs. the Wolves

Bemidji State trails the all-time series with Northern State 10-48. BSU snapped a seven-game losing streak versus the Wolves Jan. 28, 2012 and split the season series last season, which included a 64-57 home win.

## NSIC Player of the Week - Kate Warmack

Senior **Kate Warmack** recorded a career night Dec. 20 against University of Minnesota Crookston, as she posted 24 points and 17 rebounds to be honored as *NSIC Player of the Week*, Dec. 23. She shot 9-for-16 (56.3%) from the field and was 6-for-9 (66.7%) from the free throw line with two steals, one block, one assist and just one turnover in 30 minutes of play.

## A Grand Accomplishment

Senior guard **Morgan Lee** became the 16th player in Bemidji State women's basketball history to reach 1,000 career points with a 29-point effort in BSU's 85-61 victory over Western State (Colo.), Nov. 16. Lee follows in the footsteps of her father, David Lee, who scored 2,034 points for the Beavers as a student-athlete from 1984-88. She is currently 12th all-time on Bemidji State's scoring list with 1,154 points.

**Mike Curfman** enters his ninth year as head women's basketball coach for the Beavers. Curfman has directed Bemidji State University to a 82-136 overall record (.376) in his eight seasons while posting a 49-107 (.314) mark in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference.

Curfman is the third-longest tenured coach in the program's history, trailing only Doreen Zierer who coached 12 seasons (1990-2002) and Ruth Howe who coached the programs' first 10 seasons (1967-77). With a 77-72 victory against Upper Iowa University Feb. 24, 2012, Curfman moved into third on BSU's all-time coaching victories list with 71 and trails Zierer (129) and Howe (95).

After posting his lowest win total at BSU in 2008-09, Curfman and the BSU women's basketball team bounced back with a 12-15 overall mark in 2009-10, making it the fourth season out of five that the Beavers have tallied more than 10 wins. The last time BSU had as many 10 win-seasons in such a short period of time was from 1994-99, when Zierer led the Beavers to four 10-win seasons in five years.

Curfman guided the Beavers to a top six finish and an appearance in the conference tournament in each of this first three seasons. In his first campaign (2005-06), he led BSU to a fifth place finish in the NSIC and hosted the first round of conference playoffs, but fell to Minnesota State University Moorhead 59-58 in overtime.

At the conclusion of the 2011-12 season, sophomore Morgan Lee was named Second Team All-NSIC. The award marked the 10th student-athlete under Curfman to earn all-conference laurels. Lee was the fourth player to earn second team or higher honors from the league. Amy Lawson is the lone First-Team All-NSIC member under Curfman, as she earned the award following the 2007-08 season and was also the 2006 NSIC Defensive Player of the Year. Ten players have been named NSIC Player of the Week, including three in each of the 2006-07 and 2007-08 seasons.

In the classroom, 24 student-athletes have earned Academic All-NSIC honors. In 2011, Colleen McKay earned the NSIC Myles Brand All-Academic with Distinction Award - an award bestowed to senior NSIC student-athletes who have a cumulative grade point average of 3.75 or higher, are exhausting their eligibility and are on track to graduate. Curfman's 2007-08 squad was named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll. Lawson guided the team on the court and in the classroom that season and was named to the ESPN The Magazine / College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) College Division Academic All-District V Third Team.

Rejuvenating a program is nothing new to Curfman, he came to Bemidji State after six years at the helm of the University of Minnesota, Crookston program where three times during his tenure his teams set or equaled school records for wins (2000-01, 2001-02 and 2004-05) and racked up 55 victories during his final four seasons.

While at UMC, he helped to elevate the program to the NCAA Division II level. After a 1-26 season in 1999-2000, Curfman directed the Golden Eagles to a school-record nine wins in 2000-01 and increased UMC's win total to 16 the following year. In 2002-03, under Curfman, UMC made the NSIC tournament for the first time, cruising to the championship game before falling to NCAA Tournament bound University of Minnesota Duluth. In his last season at UMC in 2004-05 his Golden Eagles tied for fourth place in the NSIC posting a league record of 8-6 while going 16-12 overall and making their first ever appearance in the North Central Regional Polls. Curfman has mentored 10 All-Conference selections as a head coach including 2000-01 NSIC Newcomer of the Year and 2001-02 Player of the Year Jessica Forsline and was himself named as the 2002 NSIC Coach of the Year.

Curfman's teams have done equally as well in the classroom. During his tenure at UMC, the Golden Eagles posted at least a 3.0 team grade point average and finished in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's Top 10 Academic National Rankings with a team G.P.A. of better than 3.4 in 2004-05.

Previous to taking over the UMC program, Curfman was an assistant coach at St. Cloud State University (1994-99), serving as Dr. Lori Ulferts' top assistant for five seasons. He also coached under Dr. Ulferts at Moorhead State University (1992-94) as an assistant while serving as the head coach of the junior varsity team. He has presented at a number of camps and clinics and is a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and the Minnesota State High School League Coaches Association.

A native of Fosston, Minn., Curfman was an Academic All-America selection for the UMC basketball team while earning his A.A.S. degree. He then moved on to Concordia College in Moorhead, Minn. where he graduated in 1992 with his B.A. in Business Administration while captaining the Cobber men's basketball program. In 1994, Curfman earned his MBA in business administration from Moorhead State University (now Minnesota State University Moorhead) while acting as an assistant coach for the Dragons' women's basketball program.
