- 1) The Bucs will be looking to rebound from their first SoCon loss of the season and their first defeat in 17 straight games, as they face Western Carolina on Saturday. ETSU lost in its last outing, 74-56, to UNC Greensboro.
- 2) The Bucs have won 20 of their last 22 games and are 10-4 on the road this season. The team had a 16-game winning streak -- which was the longest in the nation at the time and also tied for the longest ever in program history -- before the loss to UNCG on Monday.
- 3) ETSU is currently ranked 4th in the CollegelInsider.com Mid-Major Poll.

Our nickname is the Buccaneers, but Bucs is also acceptable.

Buc bits

When **Steve Forbes** was hired as the men's basketball coach at ETSU on March 31, 2015, he promised that the Buccaneers would have a program of "first, best and most." ... Less than two years later, Forbes made good on that guarantee as he guided the 2016-17 ETSU men's basketball team to a 27-win season, both a Southern Conference regular season and tournament title, and a 10th trip all-time to the NCAA Tournament ... Overall, the Bucs have combined to win more games than any other program in the SoCon over the last two years (51) and have made back-to-back appearances in the league's tournament championship game ... As the squad enters the 2017-18 season, the momentum and excitement around the program are high, but there will be challenges. ... Graduating four of its starting five players from a year ago, the Bucs have lost 62 percent of its offensive production from a year ago, along with its two best interior post defender.

The series vs. Western Carolina

ETSU leads the all-time series 53-24 and had won 17 straight matchups with the Catamounts before losing to Western Carolina 67-61 in the first round of the 2015 SoCon Tournament. ... The Bucs have avenged that lone loss with five straight victories in the series, including a 66-50 win in the last meeting between the two teams back on Jan. 20 in Johnson City.

Last time out vs. Western Carolina

JOHNSON CITY, Tenn. (Jan. 20, 2018) - It took Western Carolina eight minutes of game play before scoring its first basket Saturday afternoon, and that's all the head start the ETSU men's basketball team needed. ... Building an 11-point halftime lead and then opening the second half with an 8-0 run, the Buccaneers cruised to their 10th-straight win with a 66-50 Southern Conference victory over the Catamounts in front of a season-high crowd of 5,412 fans at Freedom Hall. With the win, the Bucs have now won 14 of their last 15 games and improved to 16-4 overall, 7-0 in league play. ... Senior guard **Desonta Bradford** (Humboldt), who was honored prior to the game for reaching the 1,000-point plateau last week against VMI, finished with a game high 16 points to lead the Bucs, while fellow senior guard **Jalan McCloud** (Fort Worth, Texas) added 13. For the Catamounts, guard Deriece Parks matched Bradford's 16-point effort to pace WCU. ... The Bucs' defense established itself early, not allowing a Western Carolina a field goal for the opening nine minutes of play. During that stretch, the Bucs opened an 11-0 lead, but the Catamounts finally broke through with a score and ended up netting nine points in a row to pull within two at 11-9. From there though, the Bucs methodically beat back WCU and finished the half with a 31-20 advantage. ... After the intermission, the Bucs opened with eight straight points and ultimately led by as many as 22 points in the second half. Western closed to within 11 at 51-40 with nine minutes left in regulation, but that would be as close as they would get the rest of the way.

Last time out

GREENSBORO, N.C. (Feb. 12, 2018) - Facing a chance to stand alone with the longest win streak in program history, the ETSU men's basketball team unfortunately watched its special run of success come to an end Monday night inside the Greensboro Coliseum. ... Holding the Buccaneers to their lowest point production of the season and blocking 14 shots, UNC Greensboro used an 18-6 offensive run in the second half

to race past ETSU 74-56, handing the Bucs their first Southern Conference loss of the season and their first defeat in the last 17 games. ... Holding the Bucs to just 30.3 percent shooting, while hitting on 49 percent of their own shots, the Spartans got a team high 20 points from guard Francis

Alonso, while teammates Demetrius Troy and Marvin Smith had 17 and 13 points, respectively. Meanwhile, forward James Dickey had eight points and eight blocks to lead the UNCG defensive effort. ... For the Bucs, Bradford was the only player in double figures with 21 points on the night. ... Early turnover problems and inefficient offense for ETSU - combined with five 3-pointers by the Spartans - allowed UNCG to build a lead of 13 at 27-14 with just over seven minutes left in the opening 20 minutes. ... At that point, the Bucs relied on their own defensive effort to turn the tables on the Spartans, forcing nine UNCG turnovers by the half and outscoring the Spartans 11-2 off those miscues. With a 14-5 advantage in second chance points and a 23-19 advantage on the boards, the Bucs used those numbers to outscore the Spartans 19-6 to close the half, and when a 3-pointer by **Jalan McCloud** (Fort Worth, Texas) found the bottom of the bucket at the first half buzzer, ETSU trailed by just two at 33-31. ... After the break, the Bucs' momentum from the end of the first half did not carry over, as UNCG outscored ETSU 20-8 over the first eight minutes of play to take its largest lead of the game at that point, 53-39. The Bucs got back to within 10 at 53-43, but that would be as close as they could get the rest of the way.

Bucs have longest active win streak snapped

With a win over VMI on Saturday, Feb. 10 and St. Mary's loss to Gonzaga, the Bucs had the nation's longest win streak at 16 games ... However, with their loss to UNCG on Monday, Feb. 12, the Bucs watched their streak of success come to an end.

Win streak best in Forbes' era, ties program mark

The ETSU basketball team has enjoyed plenty of wins over three seasons under head coach **Steve Forbes**' direction ... But with its 16th win in a row on Saturday, Feb. 10 vs. VMI, the Bucs had the longest streak of success in those three seasons ... Forbes and the Bucs had also won seven straight in 2015-16 ... The Bucs' 16th win tied them with the 2003-04 squad, which also posted a 16-win streak.

Bradford named SoCon Player of the Month

Following a month when the ETSU men's basketball team posted a perfect 9-0 record in Southern Conference play, Buccaneers' senior guard **Desonta Bradford** (Humboldt) has been named the league's January Player of the Month. ... The SoCon office announced Bradford's honor on Monday, officially recognizing him for a month in which he averaged 15.6 points, 6.0 rebounds, 4.1 assists and 1.6 steals per game. Those efforts helped the Bucs extend their win streak, which currently stands at 15 games. Bradford shot nearly 52 percent from the floor in January, going 46-for-89, and had an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.1 with 37 assists and just 18 turnovers. ... Bradford scored at least 12 points in each contest, including a season-high 23 points to go along with 10 rebounds in the Bucs' 73-71 win at The Citadel to end the month. He had 12 points and nine rebounds in a win over UNCG on Jan. 11 and had 17 points and seven boards in a win over Wofford on Jan. 27. In a win over Mercer on Jan. 24, he scored 15 points and matched his career high with nine assists.

Forbes winning percentage among the nation's best

In his three seasons at ETSU, head coach **Steve Forbes** has a winning percentage of .745 (73-25), which ranks 13th nationally among active coaches with at least three years of NCAA Division I experience ... While names such as Mark Few (Gonzaga), Roy Williams (North Carolina), John Calipari (Kentucky) and Mike Krzyzewski (Duke) are ahead of Forbes on the list, ETSU's head coach does rank ahead of coaches Gregg Marshall (Wichita State), Bruce Pearl (Auburn), Jamie Dixon (TCU), Jim Boheim (Syracuse), Tom Izzo (Michigan State), Bob Huggins (West Virginia), Archie Miller (Indiana), Jay Wright (Villanova) and Steve Alford (UCLA).

Bradford more than just a scorer for the Bucs

While his game-winning score at Furman on Jan. 20th was a great play, senior guard **Desonta Bradford** (Humboldt) has been making winning plays for the Bucs throughout the season ... He currently ranks as one of -- if not the best -- all-around players in the SoCon ... As of today's game, Bradford is the only SoCon player in the league to display the following versatility, ranking in the Top 10 of multiple statistical categories per game, including points (15.4), field goal percentage (.482), rebounds (5.8), assists (3.4), steals (1.9), assist/TO ratio (1.6), defensive rebounds (5.1) and minutes played (32.3).

Bucs move to No. 4 in Colleg Insider.com Mid-Major poll

After just cracking into the Colleg Insider.com Mid-Major Poll four weeks ago at No. 16, the Bucs 16 straight wins in SoCon play allowed ETSU to move up to the No. 4 spot in the poll on Monday. ... This comes on the heels of the Bucs earning the No. 8 spot in the NBC Sports Mid-Major Power Rankings three weeks ago, while also being ranked No. 36 in Andy Katz's weekly power ranking of all Division I programs.

Bradford reaches milestone with 1,000th point

With a layup late in the second half of the Bucs' win over VMI (1/13), senior guard **Desonta Bradford** (Humboldt) reached 1,000 points for his career ... He became the 41st player in school history to eclipse that mark and has continued to move up the list. His position on the all-time scoring list is below:

ETSU's senior center **Peter Jurkin** (Juba, South Sudan) was named the Southern Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week for all contests from Jan. 2-8. ... The award is selected by the league office. ... Jurkin, who averaged 15.0 points and 6.5 rebounds in just 20.5 minutes per game last week.

Hodges goes on "Bo"-nanza in 113 seconds

In a less than two-minute span against Hiwassee College, freshman **Bo Hodges** (Nashville) put on a show ... The two-time Mr. Basketball in the state of Tennessee collected 11 points, four dunks, two layups, two steals and a free throw in a total of 113 seconds during the first half of the Bucs' win. ... Those numbers propelled Hodges to a game high 18 points on the night.

Forbes' Formula: ETSU's own version of "one-and-done"

While Power 5 programs such as Kentucky and Duke have defined the term "one-and-done" to describe freshmen that play a single season before moving on to the NBA, ETSU has created its own version of "one-and-done" which relies on fifth-year graduate players and other transfers to help give ETSU a jolt of competitive talent. ... In 2015-16, Cincinnati transfer **Ge'Lawn Guyn** (Lexington, Ky.) was one of these players for the Bucs, while last year Indiana transfer **Hanner Mosquera-Perea** (Istmina, Colombia) and Wichita State transfer **Tevin Glass** (Norcross, Ga.) provided ETSU with a single-season boost of talent during the 2016-17 campaign. ... This year, guard **Jalan McCloud** (Forth Worth, Texas) is carrying on the tradition after transferring from Texas Southern.

Bucs continue on 3-point streak list

Since Feb. 16, 1987 in a game against Davidson, the Bucs have made at least one 3-pointer in 956 consecutive games. ... ETSU was 0-for-8 in that 1987 game. ... The Bucs currently rank as the 7th longest streak in the NCAA.

SUMMARY: Just when a program record tying 16th straight win seemed somewhat in danger, ETSU senior guard Jalan McCloud (Fort Worth, Texas) would not let a chance at history pass. ... Leading by just one at halftime, McCloud scored the Buccaneers first 13 points of the second half and finished with a game high 20 to lead ETSU past Southern Conference foe VMI 70-56 Saturday afternoon inside Cameron Hall. With the win, the Bucs match the 2003-04 squad for the longest winning streak in school history and improved to 22-4 overall, 13-0 in SoCon play. ... Meanwhile, VMI dropped to 7-17, 2-11. ... Along with McCloud's game high 20, the Bucs also got 11 points from senior guard Devontavious Payne (Carbondale, Ill.), while freshman post Mladen Armus (Belgrade, Serbia) matched his career best with a game high 10 rebounds. As a team, the Bucs out-rebounded the Keydets 48-27, but committed 18 turnovers in the game, allowing VMI to outscore them 20-9 off those miscues. ... For the Keydets, three players reached double figures, with Austin Vereen netting a team high 14.

Holding the Buccaneers to their lowest point production of the season and blocking 14 shots, UNCG Greensboro used an 18-6 offensive run in the second half to race past ETSU 74-56, handing the Bucs their first Southern Conference loss of the season and their first defeat in the last 17 games. ... With the loss, the Bucs dropped to 22-5 overall, 13-1 in SoCon play, but will still return to Johnson City with a game-and-a-half lead over the second-place Spartans, who improved to 20-6, 11-2. ... Holding the Bucs to just 30.3 percent shooting, while hitting on 49 percent of their own shots, the Spartans got a team high 20 points from guard Francis Alonso, while teammates Demetrius Troy and Marvin Smith had 17 and 13 points, respectively. Meanwhile, forward James Dickey had eight points and eight blocks to lead UNCG.
