Battle For 4th Ensues In Regular Season Finale

FOURTH AND FINAL SPOT: A battle for the fourth and final spot in the GNAC Women's Soccer Championships will be decided in the regular season's final week. Montana State Billings holds the fourth position heading into the week with 16 points.

HOT ON THEIR TAIL: Simon Fraser and Central Washington enter the week three points behind MSUB, but with one more game remaining each. Simon Fraser plays Saint Martin's and Western Oregon, while Central Washington takes on Concordia and Montana State Billings.

REGIONAL RANKINGS: In the second NCAA Division II West Regional Poll, Western Washington remains ranked No. 1, while Seattle Pacific fell to No. 5 and Simon Fraser ranks No. 7. The regional rankings decide which teams are invited to the NCAA Regional Championships.

GNAC CHAMPIONSHIPS: The GNAC Women's Soccer Championships will be played on Terry Fox Field in Burnaby, B.C., beginning Thursday, Nov. 5. Western Washington, Concordia and Seattle Pacific have each secured spots at the tournament.

GNAC News & Notes

CENTRAL WASHINGTON:

- The Wildcats kept their playoff hopes alive with a 1-1 draw against Seattle Pacific and a 5-2 win over Simon Fraser.
- Central Washington enters the week tied with Simon Fraser for fifth place in the GNAC with 13 points and a 4-5-1 record.
- The Wildcats trail Montana State Billings by three points with two matches remaining. They are still eligible to reach the GNAC Women's Soccer Championships.
- **Whitney Lowe** leads the team in points (14) and goals (5). **Cassie Ripley** also has five goals.
- The Wildcats play their first match of the week at home against Concordia, who are second in the GNAC standings. They then play in a crucial match that could have playoff implications at Montana State Billings on Saturday.

CONCORDIA:

- The Cavaliers punched their ticket to the GNAC Women's Soccer Championships with wins over Montana State Billings 1-0 on Thursday in double overtime and Northwest Nazarene 2-1 on Saturday.
- Concordia still has a chance to earn the No. 1 seed in the tournament, but will need to win its last two matches with a Western Washington loss on Thursday to Northwest Nazarene.
- At worst, the Cavaliers will be the No. 2 seed, heading into the week with 25 points and an 8-1-1 conference record including a four match winning streak.
- **Olivia Brock** has been arguably the top goalkeeper in the conference this season. She leads the conference in goals average (0.41), save percentage (.917) and shutouts (8) and is third in saves (55).
- The Cavaliers will be at Central Washington on Thursday and host Western Washington on Saturday in a potential match for the regular season title.
- Although the Cavaliers are eligible for the GNAC Championship Tournament, they are not eligible for the NCAA Tournament as a part of their three-year transition period from the NAIA.

MONTANA STATE BILLINGS:

- The Yellowjackets played two tight matches last week, earning a split. They fell 1-0 to Montana State Billings in a double overtime thriller on Thursday, but responded with a 1-0 win over Western Oregon on Saturday.
- Montana State Billings played just about even the Concordia on Thursday, with the Cavaliers holding a narrow shot advantage of 19-17.
- The Yellowjackets enter the week in sole possession of fourth place with 16 points and a 5-5-1 conference record.
- **Jessica Spang** is tied for fifth in the GNAC with 15 points. Spang is tied for the team lead with **Alycia Wright** in goals (5).
- The Yellowjackets are one of two teams in the conference that has just one GNAC match left. They play fifth place Central Washington, who trails MSUB by just three points,

on Saturday in a match with potential playoff implications for both teams.

NORTHWEST NAZARENE:

- The Crusaders played their final home match of the season on Saturday against Concordia, but fell 2-1. They also were defeated on the road against Western Oregon 3-1 on Thursday.
- Northwest Nazarene is in eighth place in the conference with a 2-7-1 record.
- The Crusaders have been led this season by **Nicole Nsa**, who is tied for fifth in the GNAC in points (15) and goals (6).
- Goalkeeper **Daniele Ortiz** leads the conference in saves (105) by 48, almost doubling the next highest total.
- The Crusaders wrap up their season with two road matches, visiting No. 5-ranked Western Washington on Thursday and Saint Martin's on Saturday.

SAINT MARTIN'S:

- The Saints lost their lone match of the week at Seattle Pacific 4-0 on Saturday. The loss extended their losing streak to 10 matches.
- The Saints are led this season by **Abby McFaul**, who paces the team in points (11), goals (4), assists (3) and shots (38).
- Against Seattle Pacific, the Saints were locked in a 0-0 tied at halftime, but allowed four goals in the second half. Goalkeeper **Chelsie Still** made eight saves. She ranks second in the conference in saves per game (6.50).
- Saint Martin's is in ninth place in the GNAC. They are 1-13-0 overall.
- The Saints play their final two matches of the season at home. They host Simon Fraser on Thursday where they can play the role of spoilers against the Clan. They then host Northwest Nazarene on Saturday.

SEATTLE PACIFIC:

- The Falcons finished last week 1-0-1 and in doing so, clinched their spot in the GNAC tournament where they will be the No. 3 seed.
- Seattle Pacific drew 1-1 against Central Washington on Thursday. The teams traded goals less than 90 seconds apart in regulation before heading to the eventual tie.
- **Hannah Huesers** scored her league-leading 12th goal of the season. She leads the GNAC in goals, points (26) and shots (73).
- The Falcons also defeated Saint Martin's 4-0 on Saturday behind four second half goals. They led the Saints 12-0 in shots on goal.
- Seattle Pacific plays two more matches, with one in conference play. They play their final regular season conference match at home against Western Oregon and then host Carroll (Mont.) in their final home match of the season on Saturday.
- The Falcons ranked No. 5 in the NCAA Division II West Region Poll.

SIMON FRASER:

- The Clan remain in the hunt for the GNAC Championships despite losing both matches last week. They fell 4-0 against No. 5-ranked Western Washington on Thursday and 5-2 against Central Washington on Saturday.
- With the losses, the Clan is tied for fifth place with Central Washington with 13 points and are three points behind fourth place Montana State Billings.
- Christina Dickson** leads the Clan offensively this season in points (17) and goals (7). She ranks second in the GNAC in goals and points per game (0.54).
- The Clan play one match on the road and one match at home in the final week. They visit Saint Martin's on Thursday and host Western Oregon on Saturday.
- Simon Fraser hosts the GNAC Championship Tournament beginning on Thursday, Nov. 5. With two wins this week, they will give themselves a chance to grab the fourth seed depending on tie breakers.

WESTERN OREGON:

- The Wolves split last week's pair of matches, defeating Northwest Nazarene 3-1 on Thursday before falling to Montana State Billings 1-0 on Saturday.
- Western Oregon is in seventh place with 10 points and a 3-6-1 record. The Wolves will need help from other teams to have a shot at the GNAC tournament, trailing Montana State Billings by six points with two matches remaining.

- Makana Pundyke** leads the team in goals (6) and is tied for the team lead in points (13) despite missing two matches due to injury. **Vicky Cruz Rosales** also has 13 points this season.
- The Wolves will be on the road for their final two matches. They travel to Seattle Pacific on Thursday and to Simon Fraser on Saturday in must-win contests.

WESTERN WASHINGTON

- The Vikings have secured their spot in the GNAC Women's Soccer Championships and can be no worse than the No. 2 seed.
- Western Washington defeated Simon Fraser 4-0 on Saturday, marking its 13th straight win.
- The Vikings are 10-0-0 in conference and 15-1-0 overall. Despite keeping the winning streak alive, the Vikings fell to No. 5 in the NSCAA Division II Top-25 Poll.
- The Vikings have 30 points and are five points above second place Concordia. They can clinch the top-seed in the tournament with one win this week.
- Catherine Miles** is second in the GNAC in goals (7) and points (18). Teammate **Gabriela Pelogi** is fourth in points (16) and also tied for second in goals (7).
- The Vikings host their final match at home on Thursday against Northwest Nazarene. They then will be on the road at Concordia on Saturday in the final regular season match, which could potentially be for the GNAC regular season title.
