Player of the Week accolades*

Cumberland's Aaron White earned Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division Defensive Player of the Week accolades on September 3 after helping the Phoenix to an overtime victory over Union College. White collected seven tackles with 4.5 tackles for loss and 3.5 sacks for the Phoenix. The senior defensive lineman registered sacks on consecutive plays at the end of the first half and forced an intentional grounding call midway through the fourth period. The Nashville, Tenn., native added a tackle for loss on the first play of overtime and along with Tamim Aldarawchew, forced a fumble behind the line of scrimmage in the final quarter. He has 17 tackles this season, second most on the club, in three contests.

game-winning points in overtime against Union College. In his Cumberland debut, the Seneca, N.Y., native's 35-yard field goal to begin overtime put CU ahead before an interception ended the extra period. He made all four extra points for the Phoenix as well. Cumberland has seen major troubles in the kicking game over the last three years, converting just 9-of-25 field goal attempts from 2015-17, including 6-for-12 last season.

Offense still struggling to run

After ranking in the Top 15 nationally in rushing each of the last two seasons, Cumberland currently ranks 68th, averaging only 112.7 yards per contests through three games in 2018. In fact, the Phoenix amassed more passing yards than rushing in each of the first two outings. Of the team's 82 plays on 1st-and-10 through

three games, only 23 have produced gains of more than four yards and just 13-of-56 rushing plays on 1st-and-10 have gained more than four yards. CU ran effectively in the second half and overtime versus Union College two weeks ago, making five third downs via the run and converting 10-for-17 on third down for the contest. Cumberland converted only two third downs last week at Arkansas-Pine Bluff, both on the first drive of the game. The Phoenix have also hurt themselves with turnovers, fumbling four times against Union and six times overall. CU has seven turnovers through three outings.

Passing game comes through for CU

Cumberland has passed for more than 200 yards in two of the team's three games this season, with senior quarterback Dezmon Huntley completing 47 percent of his throws (34-of-72) for 446 yards, two touchdowns and one interception. The Mableton, Ga., native tossed TD passes of 47 yards to Kimlee North and 31 yards to Ian Hafner versus Union College, the 19th and 20th touchdown throws of his CU career. Of the 17 plays of 20-plus yards this season for the Phoenix, eight have come via the pass, with six plays over 30 yards. Huntley struggled last week in the rain at Arkansas-Pine Bluff, completing just 6-of-16 throws for 55 yards. He was also sacked three times by the Golden Lions defense.

North makes plays in different ways

Junior Kimlee North emerged as one of the team's best running backs at the end of the 2017 campaign, rushing for 453 yards and eight touchdowns over the final five games. The Nashville, Tenn., native carried 14 times for 154 yards and two scores against Bethel University and posted 133 yards and 20 attempts with two TDs at Lindsey Wilson. He added 14 rushes for 91 yards and two touchdowns in the season finale against Kentucky Christian. This season North has been limited in the rushing attack, carrying just eight times for 10 yards in three contests, but he has made a big impact in the passing game. North leads the club with seven receptions for 136 yards as well as a 47-yard TD grab versus Union College. He also made a 20-yard grab against the Bulldogs and caught a 34-yard pass in the season opener at Bluefield College.

New faces on the offensive line for CU

offense per game in 2016, averaging 232.4 yards per contest with 32 rushing touchdowns. Last season the club ranked sixth in rushing offense per game (260.7) with 35 rushing touchdowns, but seniors Nick Bodden, Chandler Peeples and Jason Smith along with redshirt junior Cooper Corley all graduated, the four players combining for 115 starts over four seasons. Senior Jeff Benson is the only returning starter on the offensive line for the Phoenix, with the Readyville, Tenn., native posting 27 career starts. Wyatt Page, Greg Davis, Jake Mathis and Sam Michael all made their first career starts for Cumberland in the season opener at Bluefield College and with an injury to Davis, freshman Sam McDaniel has started the last two games at center. With all of the new faces and a new offensive scheme, the offensive line has struggled at times, with CU averaging just 279.7 yards of total offense through three contests this season.

Tiller gets it done on defense

Senior Terry Tiller showed he was one of the best players on the field in the season opener at Bluefield College, supporting the run and defending the pass in equal measure. The Chattanooga, Tenn., native posted six tackles, five solo, mostly on running plays, and also defended a pair of passes, one on a beautiful play in the back corner of the end zone. The Cumberland defense allowed just 285 yards

of total offense, with Bluefield scoring on a blocked punt in the end zone and a field goal after another bad snap on a punt gave the Rams a short field. Tiller registered eight stops with 0.5 tackles for loss and forced a fumble, which Jace Capps picked up and returned for a touchdown, against Union College. He has four interceptions, 88 tackles and six pass breakups in 18 career contests for the Phoenix.

Rushin more than capable as the backup

Redshirt junior Joseph Rushin has shown he is more than capable when pressed into duty at quarterback for the Phoenix last season, passing for 524 yards and four touchdowns while rushing for 372 yards and a team-high 11 TDs. The McDonough, Ga., native passed for over 300 yards in a little less than two quarters at Georgetown College on Sept. 30 in relief of an injured Dezmon Huntley. Rushin completed 14-

of-25 passes for 304 yards and two touchdowns, both to Denarius Toliver, for 81 and 67 yards in the fourth quarter. He also had a 51-yard completion to Toliver and ran for a one-yard TD in the first quarter. It marked the first 300-yard passing day for a CU quarterback since Justin Snyder threw for 301 on October 22, 2016, versus Campbellsville University. Rushin tied for eighth in the Mid-South Conference with 11 rushing touchdowns in 2017, eight of those from one yard out. He posted a crazy stat line at the University of the Cumberlands, rushing eight times for four yards and four touchdowns with four one-yard TD runs. This year Rushin has played more as a fullback for the Phoenix, carrying 27 times for 54 yards, though he has completed 3-of-6 passes for 55 yards in limited action at quarterback.

Capps makes big impact in debut

Junior linebacker Jace Capps posted an impressive debut for the Phoenix in the season opener at Bluefield College. The Norcross, Ga., native registered six tackles with 2.0 tackles for loss and one sack. The Eastern Arizona College transfer also blocked a punt that set-up the second touchdown of the game for Cumberland. The CU defense allowed just 19 total points and 285 yards of offense to the Rams, a good showing for a unit with eight new starters under first-year coordinator Chris Elliott. Capps recorded three stops with 0.5 tackles for loss versus Union College but also picked up a fumble and returned it 53 yards in the second quarter for CU's first points of the game. He added six tackles last week at Arkansas-Pine Bluff, giving him 15 total stops for the season.

Big plays hurting Phoenix defense

Cumberland's defense played pretty well through the first two weeks despite lots of new faces in new places as well as six turnovers by the offense. The Phoenix ranked 25th nationally in total defense, allowing 305.0 yards per game, as well as tied for 13th in rushing defense, giving up 77.5 yards per outing, after games against Bluefield College and Union College, but Arkansas-Pine Bluff exploited the unit's lack of experience, especially in the passing game, finishing with 363 yards and three touchdowns. The defense's issues have come in the passing game throughout the three contests, allowing 272.7 yards per contest with 11 plays of 20-plus yards, five of those for touchdowns. Bluefield tossed a 60-yard TD late in the third quarter to

take the lead for good and Union College posted 38 and 72-yard TD throws, the second one tying the contest at 28 early in the fourth period. UAPB had scoring throws of 66 and 40 yards as well. Cumberland has just one returning starting defensive back, Terry Tiller, who has started at cornerback and safety in the three games.

Defensive scores are the norm for CU

Under former head coach and defensive coordinator Donnie Suber, Cumberland registered 34 defensive touchdowns in 10 seasons, which includes interceptions, fumble returns and blocked punts, as well as forcing six safeties. The Phoenix collected six defensive scores in 2017 with three fumble returns and three interceptions for touchdowns. That tradition has continued under first-year defensive coordinator Chris Elliott, with CU posting a pair of fumble returns for TDs against Union College. Terry Tiller forced a fumble and Jace Capps returned it 53 yards for a touchdown in the second quarter. On the next Union possession, JarVis Ruff forced a fumble and Justin Brown came out of the pile with the ball, rumbling 55 yards to even the game at 14. The chart on the top left of this page has a complete listing of all defensive scores from 2008-present.

Offense must cut down on miscues in 2018

After some major struggles with turnovers to end the 2015 campaign, Cumberland's offense kept miscues to a minimum in 2016, commit-

ting only 11 turnovers in 11 games. The Phoenix were not so lucky in 2017, committing 21 turnovers – 10 fumbles and 11 interceptions. Luckily the Cumberland defense allowed just 41 points off those 21 miscues. This season, Cumberland had one fumble and one interception in the season opener at Bluefield College as well as a pair of special teams miscues that all led to points for the Rams. Against Union College, four fumbles turned into 14 points, the first two touchdowns of the game for the Bulldogs, and Arkansas-Pine Bluff converted CU's only turnover, a fumble, into a touchdown last week. In 2015 Cumberland took care of the ball very well in the first five games, committing just six total turnovers, but miscues over the last six contests led directly to five straight defeats. The Phoenix committed 19 turnovers during those six outings, including four at Campbellsville University and five versus Bethel University. Cumberland opponents feasted on the offense's 25 miscues in 2015, turning those into 115 points, including 24 by Campbellsville and 21 apiece from Bethel and Lindsey Wilson.

Tate takes over in the middle

Redshirt junior Tyler Tate started the 2018 season as the team's middle linebacker, moving into the spot vacated by Cody Carr, who graduated last year. The Whitwell, Tenn., native played only on special teams as a redshirt freshman but bulked up and started the last four games in 2017 at linebacker, finishing the year with 49 stops, 6.0 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks. He also posted five quarterback hurries, two pass breakups and recovered two fumbles, both for touchdowns. Tate has a team-leading 18 tackles through three games this season, including five stops, four solo, in versus Union College. He collected a team-high 10 tackles last week at Arkansas-Pine Bluff with 1.0 tackles for loss. Tate registered six tackles and returned a fumble for a touchdown against Cincinnati Christian last season, earning Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division Defensive Player of the Week honors on Octo-

ber 9. Carr forced a fumble on a running play and the ball popped right into the hands of Tate, who raced 29 yards for the score. Tate fell on a fumble in the end zone at Edward Waters on September 16 as well.

Phoenix look to continue winning ways

Cumberland has compiled a 51-36 mark over the previous eight seasons, the best eight-year run in program history. The Phoenix posted 8-3 records in 2010 and 2012 and a 7-3 mark in 2011, playing for the division championship in all three campaigns. The squad was 7-4 overall in 2013 as well as 2017 and finished 6-5 in 2014. CU ranks fifth in total victories among the 18 football-playing schools in the state of Tennessee since the start of the 2010 season heading into this week's game at Ave Maria University. Carson-Newman (60-33) and Chattanooga (57-41) sit atop the standings, followed by Tennessee (53-49) and Middle Tennessee (53-50) and then Cumberland (52-38). The football-playing schools in the state include Austin Peay, Carson-Newman, Chattanooga, Cumberland, East Tennessee State (since 2015), Lane College, Rhodes College, Maryville College, Memphis, Middle Tennessee, Tennessee, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, Tusculum College, University of the South, UT Martin and Vanderbilt.

Head Coach Tim Mathis



First Season Georgia Southern, 1996

Cumberland University Director of Athletics Ron Pavan announced the hiring of Tim Mathis as head coach for the Phoenix on January 22, 2018. He becomes the sixth head coach since Cumberland restarted the football program in 1990.

Mathis served as an assistant coach for 10 seasons at Shorter University when the Hawks started their program in the

NAIA in 2005. He was the team's offensive coordinator his last five years at Shorter, including during the transition to NCAA Division II.

Mathis was a member of the Shorter staff for the inaugural season in 2005 and served five years as the team's offensive line coach. The Hawks led the NAIA in rushing, won the Mid-South Conference championship and earned the program's first-ever postseason playoff berth in 2008. Two players earned All-America honors and a dozen offensive linemen were named All-Mid-South during those five seasons.

He moved into the role of offensive coordinator from 2010-14, working with running backs for two seasons and quarterbacks and fullbacks the final three. Shorter ranked second nationally in rushing at 310.9 yards per game and posted 30.5 points per contest in 2010 and ranked third in the country in rushing (271.9), averaging 30.0 points per outing in 2011, the program's last in the NAIA.

In 2012, the first transition year to Division II, the Hawks ranked ninth nationally in rushing at 268.5 yards per game and ranked third the Gulf South Conference in rushing (227.9) and second in time of possession. Shorter ranked third in total offense in 2013, with fullback Bradley Moon leading the GSC and ranking sixth in rushing yards and quarterback Eric Dodson ranking fifth in the conference in total offense.

Shorter ranked third in the Gulf South and 22nd nationally in rushing in 2014 with 225.3 yards per contest.

Mathis was the head coach the last two seasons at St. Francis High



School in Alpharetta, Ga., posting a 2-8 record in 2016 with freshmen and sophomores making up 74 percent of the roster. He registered a 4-6 mark in 2017 with the Knights.

He also served one season as head coach at Franklin County High School in Eastpoint, Fla., helping the Seahawks break a 23-game losing streak and finishing the season 3-7 overall.

Prior to his time at Shorter, Mathis worked four years at Trion City Schools in Trion, Ga., coaching the offensive line all four seasons as well as serving as defensive coordinator for two years. He was also the wrestling coach for two years and the golf coach for two seasons.

Mathis earned his bachelor's in History with a minor in Political Science from Georgia Southern in 1996 and received his master's in Leadership from Shorter in 2010. He is married to the former Mesha Layman and the couple has two children - Abby and Hunter.
