Phoenix face Blue Raiders for Senior Day

Cumberland ends the home schedule Saturday, taking on Lindsey Wilson at Nokes-Lasater Field. Nine players - Jeff Benson, Marcus Bryson, Jawan Gray, Dezmon Huntley, Marques King, Josh Rohrer, Austin Sang, Coleton Thomas and Terry Tiller will be honored before the game. The Phoenix and Blue Raiders have each won three games in the series, with CU posting victories from 2010-12 and LWC collecting wins each of the last three seasons. Three of the six meetings have been decided by four points or less, including last year's 44-41 Lindsey Wilson victory. In that contest, Kimlee North rushed for 131 yards and two touchdowns and added a 38-yard TD reception, but Cumberland could not dig out of an early hole. The Phoenix fell behind 27-7 in the second quarter and trailed 34-14 at the half. The Blue Raiders took a 44-21 advantage with 2:54 remaining in the third quarter before CU put together a furious comeback. Ian Hafner's 13-yard touchdown catch on fourth down and Dezmon Huntley's 16-yard quarterback draw for a score pulled CU within 10 and North's one-yard score with 3:04 remaining made it a three-point game, but Lindsey Wilson ran out the clock with three first downs.

Keys, Jr., keeps making plays for CU

Cumberland's Jimmy Keys, Jr., recorded his fourth interception of the year, returned a blocked field goal 78 yards for a touchdown and added four tackles in last week's contest against Campbellsville University. Tony Bennett blocked a field goal in the second quarter and Keys, Jr., caught the block in the air and raced 78 yards for the score, getting the Phoenix on the board. The Memphis, Tenn., native collected his fourth INT of the year (in six games) and third in the last three games early in the fourth quarter, setting up the final CU touchdown. Keys, Jr., ranks fourth in the Mid-South Conference with the four interceptions and has registered 24 tackles along with five pass break-ups this season. He has 18 stops, four pass break-ups and three interceptions in the last three games for the Phoenix.

Defense continues forcing turnovers

Cumberland's defense has forced 18 turnovers this season, including 10 interceptions and eight fumbles, along with blocking two field goals and one punt through eight games. Nine of those 18 turnovers have come in the last two games, with the Phoenix registering five takeaways against Georgetown College and four versus Campbellsville University. The unit posted two interceptions and three fumble recoveries against Georgetown, with Tyler Tate forcing and recovering a fumble in the first quarter and Tony Bennett posting an interception in the second period. Jimmy Keys, Jr., collected an interceptions in the third quarter and Malik Trollinger forced a fumble at the CU2 early in the fourth quarter. Kylan Washington forced the last Georgetown fumble later in the final period. Last week against Campbellsville, Prentiss Sumerall's interception just before halftime set-up a CU touchdown and Bennett recorded his second INT in two games in the third quarter. Keys, Jr., added his third interception in three games early in the fourth period and Champ Leddon forced a fumble on a punt that was recovered by Marcus Bryson, also in the final quarter.

Toliver records big numbers for Phoenix

Junior receiver Denarius Toliver posted two straight contests with more than 100 all-purpose yards in games against Ave Maria University and Edward Waters in the month of September. The Brownsville, Tenn., native caught a 49-yard pass and finished with five receptions for 98 yards with an eight-yard TD catch versus EWC. He added a 19-yard rush as well. Toliver registered his best game of the season at Ave Maria, accounting for a pair of touchdowns. He caught a 50-yard TD pass in the first quarter to get the Phoenix on the board. He then sprinted 67 yards on an end-around for a touchdown in the third period, outracing defenders down the sideline for the score. It was the first career rush for Toliver. It also marked the second career outing with a pair of touchdowns after catching two TD passes last season at Georgetown College. Toliver leads the Phoenix with 18 receptions for 314 yards and three TDs this year.

Tiller gets it done on defense

Senior Terry Tiller continues to play well in the defensive backfield for the Phoenix, registering six or more tackles in 6-of-8 outings this season. The Chattanooga, Tenn., native posted

six tackles, five solo, and also defended a pair of passes, one on a beautiful play in the back corner of the end zone, in the season opener at Bluefield College. He registered eight stops with 0.5 tackles for loss and forced a fumble, which Jace Capps picked up and returned for a touchdown, against Union College. Tiller added a team-leading eight stops with two pass break-ups at Ave Maria University and registered five tackles against Edward Waters. He collected seven tackles with 2.0 tackles for loss at Cincinnati Christian and recorded six stops with 2.0 tackles for loss and a fumble recovery versus Georgetown College. Tiller recorded eight stops with one sack and two tackles for loss last week against Campbellsville University. He ranks second on the club with 51 tackles, 6.5 tackles for loss and five pass break-ups this season.

Offensive line shuffle continues

Cumberland's starting offensive line for the season opener - Wyatt Page, Jeff Benson, Greg Davis, Jake Mathis and Sam Michael - has played less than three quarters together this season. Davis was injured in the season opener, beginning a shuffle that has lasted all year but has become more exaggerated over the last month. The Phoenix will start its fourth different offensive line combination in the last four games this week against Lindsey Wilson after the season-ending injury to Page last week versus Campbellsville University. Michael will be

the only player to start all nine games this year (Page started the first eight at left tackle). It's a far cry from the last two campaigns when the combination of Benson, Nick Bodden, Chandler Peeples, Jason Smith and Cooper Corley helped Cumberland rank 11th nationally in rushing offense per game in 2016, averaging 232.4 yards per contest with 32 rushing touchdowns, and sixth in the country in 2017, averaging 260.7 yards per contest with 35 rushing touchdowns. Bodden, Peeples, Smith and Corley all graduated after last year, the four players combining for 115 starts over four seasons.

Rucker has big day against Eagles

Redshirt junior back Telvin Rucker rushed for 130 yards on 11 carries and one touchdown at Cincinnati Christian, doing the bulk of the work in the fourth quarter in a tie game. The Mem-

phis, Tenn., native posted runs of 19, five and four yards in the first drive of the final period that ended with a 23-yard TD pass to Ian Hafner. Rucker then carried on four of the six plays on the team's final possession of the contest, including a 53-yard scamper that took CU from its own 22 to the CCU25. He gained 13 yards on the next play and scampered 14 yards on third down, diving into the end zone for the game-sealing score for the Phoenix. He leads CU in rushing with 452 yards on 88 carries this season, collecting four touchdowns. It marked the first 100-yard rushing game for a Cumberland player this season and the second 100-yard rushing effort of Rucker's career after posting 140 yards on 20 attempts with one TD last year at Edward Waters.

Defensive scores are the norm for CU

Under former head coach and defensive coordinator Donnie Suber, Cumberland registered 34 defensive touchdowns in 10 seasons, which includes interceptions, fumble returns and blocked punts, as well as forcing six safeties. The Phoenix collected six defensive scores in 2017 with three fumble returns and three interceptions for touchdowns. That tradition has continued under first-year defensive coordinator Chris Elliott, with CU posting a pair of fumble returns for TDs against Union College. Terry Tiller forced a fumble and Jace Capps returned it 53 yards for a touchdown in the second quarter. On the next Union possession, JarVis Ruff forced a fumble and Justin Brown came out of the pile with the ball, rumbling 55 yards to even the game at 14. Last week the Phoenix added to that list, with Tony Bennett blocking a field goal and Jimmy Keys, Jr., racing 78 yards for a TD. Big plays hurting Phoenix defense

Cumberland's defense played pretty well through the first two weeks this season despite lots of new faces in new places as well as six turnovers by the offense. Arkansas-Pine Bluff exploited the unit's lack of experience, especially in the passing game, finishing with 363 yards and three touchdowns. The defense's issues have come in the passing game throughout the season, allowing 233.8 yards per game with 25 plays of 20-plus yards, 10 of those for touchdowns. Bluefield tossed a 60-yard TD late in the third quarter to take the lead for good and Union

College posted 38 and 72-yard TD throws, the second one tying the contest at 28 early in the fourth period. UAPB had scoring throws of 66 and 40 yards and Ave Maria recorded TD passes from 41 and 32 yards. Campbellsville University added to that list last week with TD throws of 21 and 25 yards. The Phoenix rank 18th in the Mid-South and 57th nationally in pass defense in 2018.

Capps makes plays for CU defense

Junior linebacker Jace Capps has registered 30 tackles with three tackles for loss and three quarterback hurries in the last four weeks for Cumberland. The Norcross, Ga., native collected eight stops with one QB hurry against Edward Waters and recorded a team-best nine tackles with one tackle for loss and one pass break-up at Cincinnati Christian. He posted seven stops with one tackle for loss and one quarterback hurry against Georgetown College and added six solo tackles with one tackle for loss and one QB hurry last week versus Campbellsville University. He made an impressive debut for the Phoenix in the season opener at Bluefield College, registering six tackles with 2.0 tackles for loss and one sack. The Eastern Arizona College transfer also blocked a punt that set-up the second touchdown of the game for CU. Capps recorded three stops with 0.5 tackles for loss versus Union College and also picked up a fumble and returned it 53 yards in the second quarter for CU's first points of the game. He has 47 tackles with 5.5 tackles for loss and 1.0 sacks through eight outings.

Running game halted against Georgetown
 Cumberland netted just 75 yards on 31 attempts rushing two weeks ago against Georgetown College, the second lowest output this season on the ground for the Phoenix. CU managed only 61 yards rushing in the season opener at Bluefield College but averaged 199.2 yards on the ground in the previous five outings before the Georgetown loss. Cumberland got back on track last week versus Campbellsville University with 170 yards on 45 attempts. The Phoenix have ranked in the Top 15 nationally in rushing each of the last two seasons but enters Saturday's game against Lindsey Wilson netting just 162.8 yards per game, 42nd nationally among 90 teams. The Phoenix compiled 290 yards on 52 attempts at Ave Maria University, grinding out the second half and especially the fourth quarter for the win. CU ran on 29 of its 38 second-half plays versus Ave Maria, amassing 192 yards and three touchdowns. Cumberland accomplished similar numbers at Cincinnati Christian, gaining 187 yards of total offense in the fourth quarter, including 164 on the ground, scoring a pair of touchdowns. The Phoenix ran on 16-of-17 offensive plays in the period.

Passing game hitting big plays for CU
 Cumberland has posted 20 passing plays this season for 20-plus yards, including 12 of 30-plus, through eight contests. Senior quarterback Dezmon Huntley has completed 47 percent of his throws (80-for-170) for 1072 yards with six touchdowns and four interceptions. The Mableton, Ga., native tossed TD passes of 47 yards to Kimlee North and 31 yards to Ian Hafner versus Union College. He added a 50-yard TD pass to Denarius Toliver at Ave Maria University and posted an eight-yard TD throw to Toliver against Edward Waters, his 22nd career touchdown pass. Toliver also has a 49 and two 36-yard catches this year while Kendall Johnson caught a 36-yard pass from Huntley. The Phoenix completed a 35-yard pass to Marcus Bryson and a 30-yard throw to North versus Georgetown College as well.

Offense must cut down on miscues in 2018
 Cumberland has struggled with turnovers on offense so far this season, especially with fumbles. The Phoenix have 26 fumbles, losing 12 of those, while tossing four interceptions through eight games. That continues a trend from last season when CU committed 21 turnovers, 10 fumbles and 11 interceptions. The Cumberland

defense allowed just 41 points off those 21 miscues in 2017, but opponents have netted 51 points off 16 turnovers this season through eight games. CU posted one fumble and one interception in the season opener at Bluefield College as well as a pair of special teams miscues that all led to points for the Rams. Against Union College, four fumbles turned into 14 points, the first two touchdowns of the game for the Bulldogs, and Arkansas-Pine Bluff converted CU's only turnover, a fumble, into a touchdown. Ave Maria did the same, taking a fumble in the first quarter and scoring a touchdown on the next play, while Edward Waters booted a field goal on its first drive, obtaining the ball after a fumble on a sack. Cincinnati Christian scored after an interception to start the second half for CCU's only TD of the game and Georgetown College registered a field goal on 1-of-2 fumbles against the Tigers. Campbellsville University's last touchdown of the game was a pick-six with 1:37 left in the contest.

Tate takes over in the middle
 Redshirt junior Tyler Tate started the 2018 season as the team's middle linebacker, moving into the spot vacated by Cody Carr, who graduated last year. The Whitwell, Tenn., native played only on special teams as a redshirt freshman but bulked up and started the last four games in 2017 at linebacker, finishing the year with 49 stops, 6.0 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks. He also posted five quarterback hurries, two pass breakups and recovered two fumbles, both for touchdowns. Tate leads the Phoenix this season with 55 stops, 4.0 tackles for loss and 3.0 sacks through eight outings. He recorded five tackles versus Union College and collected a team-high 10 stops at Arkansas-Pine Bluff with 1.0 tackles for loss. Tate added 10 tackles with one sack against Edward Waters and registered six stops while recovering a fumble at Cincinnati Christian. He registered seven tackles while forcing and recovering a fumble against Georgetown College and added eight stops with one sack last week versus Campbellsville University.

Keys, Jr., garners second Mid-South Player of the Week honor
 Cumberland's Jimmy Keys, Jr., earned Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division Defensive Player of the Week accolades on October 8 for the second time this season, collecting eight tackles with an interception against Georgetown

College. The Memphis, Tenn., native tied for the team lead with eight tackles, added two pass break-ups and collected his third interception of the season. The junior made seven solo tackles and posted his second straight game with two pass break-ups. His INT came in the end zone and ended the first drive of the third quarter for Georgetown, who led 10-0 at the time.

Keys, Jr., voted MSC Defensive POW

Cumberland's Jimmy Keys, Jr., was named Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division Defensive Player of the Week on September 17, blocking a field goal and making an interception in a 35-34 comeback victory at Ave Maria University. The Memphis, Tenn., native blocked a field goal attempt with just over six minutes remaining in the fourth quarter that would have put Ave Maria ahead by nine points. Cumberland drove the ensuing possession for the game-winning points. The redshirt junior intercepted the first pass thrown on the next Ave Maria possession, nearly sealing the comeback win for CU. He posted four tackles in the contest.

White garners Mid-South Player of the Week accolades

Cumberland's Aaron White earned Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division Defensive Player of the Week accolades on September 3 after helping the Phoenix to an overtime victory over Union College. White collected seven tackles with 4.5 tackles for loss and 3.5 sacks for the Phoenix. The senior defensive lineman registered sacks on consecutive plays at the end of the first half and forced an intentional grounding call midway through the fourth period. The

Nashville, Tenn., native added a tackle for loss on the first play of overtime and along with Tamm Aldarawcheh, forced a fumble behind the line of scrimmage in the final quarter.

Kline posts MSC Player of the Week honors

Cumberland kicker Sean Kline collected Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division Special Teams Player of the Week honors on September 3, booting a 35-yard field goal for the game-winning points in overtime against Union College. In his Cumberland debut, the Seneca, N.Y., native's 35-yard field goal to begin overtime put CU ahead before an interception ended the extra period. He made all four extra points for the Phoenix as well. Cumberland has seen major troubles in the kicking game over the last three years, converting just 9-of-25 field goal attempts from 2015-17, including 6-for-12 last season.

Phoenix look to continue winning ways

Cumberland has compiled a 51-36 mark over the previous eight seasons, the best eight-year run in program history. The Phoenix posted 8-3 records in 2010 and 2012 and a 7-3 mark in 2011, playing for the division championship in all three campaigns. The squad was 7-4 overall in 2013 as well as 2017 and finished 6-5 in 2014. CU ranks fifth in total victories among the 18 football-playing schools in the state of Tennessee since the start of the 2010 season heading into this week's game against Lindsey Wilson. Carson-Newman (64-34) and Chattanooga (60-43) sit atop the standings, followed by Tennessee (55-51) and Middle Tennessee (55-52). Cumberland (54-41) is next behind the Vols and

Blue Raiders. The football-playing schools in the state include Austin Peay, Carson-Newman, Chattanooga, Cumberland, East Tennessee State (since 2015), Lane College, Rhodes College, Maryville College, Middle Tennessee, Memphis, Middle Tennessee, Tennessee, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, Tusculum College, University of the South, UT Martin and Vanderbilt.

Head Coach Tim Mathis



First Season Georgia Southern, 1996

Cumberland University Director of Athletics Ron Pavan announced the hiring of Tim Mathis as head coach for the Phoenix on January 22, 2018. He becomes the sixth head coach since Cumberland restarted the football program in 1990.

Mathis served as an assistant coach for 10 seasons at Shorter University when the Hawks started their program in the NAIA in 2005. He was the team's offensive coordinator his last five years at Shorter, including during the transition to NCAA Division II.

Mathis was a member of the Shorter staff for the inaugural season in 2005 and served five years as the team's offensive line coach. The Hawks led the NAIA in rushing, won the Mid-South Conference championship and earned the program's first-ever postseason playoff berth in 2008. Two players earned All-America honors and a dozen offensive linemen were named All-Mid-South during those five seasons.

He moved into the role of offensive coordinator from 2010-14, working with running backs for two seasons and quarterbacks and fullbacks the final three. Shorter ranked second nationally in rushing at 310.9 yards per game and posted 30.5 points per contest in 2010 and ranked third in the country in rushing (271.9), averaging 30.0 points per outing in 2011, the program's last in the NAIA.

In 2012, the first transition year to Division II, the Hawks ranked ninth nationally in rushing at 268.5 yards per game and ranked third the Gulf South Conference in rushing (227.9) and second in time of possession. Shorter ranked third in total offense in 2013, with fullback Bradley Moon leading the GSC and ranking sixth in rushing yards and quarterback Eric Dodson ranking fifth in the conference in total offense.

Shorter ranked third in the Gulf South and 22nd nationally in rushing in 2014 with 225.3 yards per contest.

Mathis was the head coach the last two seasons at St. Francis High



School in Alpharetta, Ga., posting a 2-8 record in 2016 with freshmen and sophomores making up 74 percent of the roster. He registered a 4-6 mark in 2017 with the Knights.

He also served one season as head coach at Franklin County High School in Eastpoint, Fla., helping the Seahawks break a 23-game losing streak and finishing the season 3-7 overall.

Prior to his time at Shorter, Mathis worked four years at Trion City Schools in Trion, Ga., coaching the offensive line all four seasons as well as serving as defensive coordinator for two years. He was also the wrestling coach for two years and the golf coach for two seasons.

Mathis earned his bachelor's in History with a minor in Political Science from Georgia Southern in 1996 and received his master's in Leadership from Shorter in 2010. He is married to the former Mesha Layman and the couple has two children - Abby and Hunter.
