Tale of two halves for CU offense

After five years in the spread and five years before that in the hybrid wing, Cumberland unveiled an entirely different offense last Saturday at Bluefield College with mixed results. The unit posted 14 points and 181 yards in the first half, taking a 14-10 lead to the locker room, but the Phoenix managed only 16 yards of total offense in the third quarter and 78 total yards in the entire second half, eventually falling 26-14. The vaunted triple option running attack (ala Navy and Georgia Tech) preferred by head coach Tim Mathis, managed 61 yards on 45 attempts (though negative 39 yards on a bad punt snap hurt that total). Dezmon Huntley fared much better throwing the ball, especially in the first half (8-for-11 for 107 yards in the first 30 minutes).

New faces on the offensive line for CU

Cumberland ranked 11th nationally in rushing of offense per game in 2016, averaging 232.4 yards per contest with 32 rushing touchdowns. Last season the club ranked sixth in rushing offense per game (260.7) with 35 rushing touchdowns, but seniors Nick Bodden, Chandler Peeples and Jason Smith along with redshirt junior Cooper Corley all graduated, the four players combining for 115 starts over four seasons. Senior Jeff Benson is the only returning starter on the offensive line for the Phoenix, with the Readyville, Tenn., native posting 25 career starts. Wyatt Page, Greg Davis, Jake Mathis and Sam Michael all made their first career starts for

Phoenix, Bulldogs renew old rivalry

Cumberland opens the 2018 home schedule this Saturday, taking on Union College at Nokes-Lasater Field. The Phoenix lead the all-time series, 13-7, but the two teams have not played since a 47-46 CU victory in 2014. Cumberland has won 11 of the last 13 contests between the two schools. Three of the five meetings between 2010 and 2014 were decided by eight points or less. In 2014 Broc Loveless rushed for three touchdowns, Reed Gurchiek carried 42 yards for the winning score and Cayman Russell blocked two extra points, including the potential game-tying attempt with 2:04 remaining. Seven different backs touch ball for CU

With the new-look triple option attack implemented by head coach Tim Mathis, spreading the wealth is more the norm. Seven different backs got carries against Bluefield College, with Telvin Rucker's 10 attempts for 36 yards from the B-back (fullback) position leading the way. Luke Turner added nine carries for 32 yards and Joseph Rushin posted eight runs for 27 yards. Quarterback Dezmon Huntley recorded nine attempts for a negative six yards though a 13-yard loss on a fumble in the first quarter hurt his overall numbers. As a team Cumberland finished with 45 attempts for 100 yards (61 total because of a fumble on a bad snap on a punt.)

Bryson, Toliver shine in passing game

Senior Marcus Bryson and junior Denarius Toliver each caught four passes and combined for 96 receiving yards last week at Bluefield College. Bryson led the way with four catches for 56 yards, including 32 and 13-yard receptions. Toliver added 40 yards receiving through the air with a 27-yard grab. He was also open a couple of other times but the ball was either knocked away by a defender or slightly overthrown. Cumberland completed 17-of-34 passes for 199 yards in the contest, all but one of those throws from Dezmon Huntley. Seven different receivers caught a pass in the game, including

three receptions for 31 yards by Ian Hafner and two catches apiece for Kimlee North (41 yards) and Kendall Johnson (14 yards).

Tiller gets it done on defense

Senior Terry Tiller showed he was one of the best players on the field last Saturday at Bluefield College, supporting the run and defending the pass in equal measure. The Chattanooga, Tenn., native posted six tackles, five solo, mostly on running plays, and also defended a pair of passes, one on a beautiful play in the back corner of the end zone. The Cumberland defense allowed just 285 yards of total offense, with Bluefield scoring on a blocked punt in the end zone and a field goal after another bad snap on a punt gave the Rams a short field. He has four interception, 77 tackles and six pass breakups in 16 career contests.

Rushin more than capable as the backup

Redshirt junior Joseph Rushin has shown he is more than capable when pressed into duty at quarterback for the Phoenix last season, passing for 524 yards and four touchdowns while rushing for 372 yards and a team-high 11 TDs. The McDonough, Ga., native passed for over 300 yards in a little less than two quarters at Georgetown College on Sept. 30 in relief of an injured Dezmon Huntley. Rushin completed 14-of-25 passes for 304 yards and two touchdowns, both to Denarius Toliver, for 81 and 67 yards

in the fourth quarter. He also had a 51-yard completion to Toliver and ran for a one-yard TD in the first quarter. It marked the first 300-yard passing day for a CU quarterback since Justin Snyder threw for 301 on October 22, 2016, versus Campbellsville University. Rushin tied for eighth in the Mid-South Conference with 11 rushing touchdowns in 2017, eight of those from one yard out. He posted a crazy stat line at the University of the Cumberlands, rushing eight times for four yards and four touchdowns with four one-yard TD runs.

Capps makes big impact in debut

Junior linebacker Jace Capps posted an impress debut for the Phoenix last week at Bluefield College. The Norcross, Ga., native registered six tackles with 2.0 tackles for loss and one sack. The Eastern Arizona College transfer also blocked a punt that set-up the second touchdown of the game for Cumberland. The

CU defense allowed just 19 total points and 285 yards of offense to the Rams, a good showing for a unit with eight new starters under first-year coordinator Chris Elliott.

Defensive scores are the norm for CU

Under former head coach and defensive coordinator Donnie Suber, Cumberland registered 34 defensive touchdowns in 10 seasons, which includes interceptions, fumble returns and blocked punts, as well as forcing six safeties. Shedrick Kirk picked up a fumble and returned it 90 yards for a TD at Faulkner University, the only defensive score in 2016. David Emanuel added to the total with a 29-yard interception return for a TD versus Webber International last season, the first INT return for a TD by a CU player since November 15, 2014, versus Alderson Broaddus. JarVis Ruff forced a fumble near the goal line and Tyler Tate fell on the ball in the end zone for a TD at Edward Waters and Josh Bates picked up a fumble after a sack and raced 64 yards for a score at Georgetown College. Tate returned a fumble 29 yards for a score and Prentiss Sumerall returned an interception 29 yards for a touchdown versus Cincinnati Christian. Terry Tiller's 51-yard INT return for a score against Kentucky Christian was the final TD of the year in 2017. The chart on the top left of this page has a complete listing of all defensive scores under Suber.

Tate takes over in the middle

Redshirt junior Tyler Tate started the 2018 season as the team's middle linebacker, moving into the spot vacated by Cody Carr, who graduated last year. The Whitwell, Tenn., native played only on special teams as a redshirt freshman but bulked up and started the last four games last season at linebacker, finishing the year with 49 stops, 6.0 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks. He also posted five quarterback hurries, two pass breakups and recovered two fumbles, both for touchdowns. He registered six tackles and returned a fumble for a touchdown against Cincinnati Christian, earning Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division Defensive Player of the Week honors on October 9. Carr forced a fumble on a running play to the left by CCU's Garner Harris and the ball popped right into the hands of Tate, who raced 29 yards for the score. Tate fell on a fumble in the end zone at Edward Waters on September 16 as well.

Cincinnati Christian win one for the ages

Cumberland recorded a 58-0 victory over Cincinnati Christian on October 7, the largest margin of victory for the Phoenix in the modern era of football at the school (since 1990). The 58-0 win bested the previous mark of 49-0 set in 2012 against Bluefield College. It marked just the sixth win of 40-plus points for Cumberland since the program was revived in 1990.

ting only 11 turnovers in 11 games. The Phoenix were not so lucky in 2017, committing 21 turnovers – 10 fumbles and 11 interceptions. Luckily the Cumberland defense allowed just 41 points off those 21 miscues. Cumberland had one fumble and one interception last week at Bluefield College as well as a pair of special teams miscues that all led to points for the Rams. In 2015 Cumberland took care of the ball very well in the first five games, committing just six total turnovers, but miscues over the last six contests led directly to five straight defeats. The Phoenix committed 19 turnovers during those six outings, including four at Campbellsville University and five versus Bethel. Cumberland opponents feasted on the offense's 25 miscues in 2015, turning those into 115 points, including 24 by Campbellsville and 21 apiece from Bethel and Lindsey Wilson.

Record-setting day leads to Bethel win

Cumberland racked up 564 rushing yards and 672 yards of total offense in the October 14 victory over Bethel University, posting marks not seen on the football field at CU in at least 10 years. The Phoenix rushed 59 times for 564 yards, 9.6 yards-per-carry, with four touchdowns. That was the most rushing yards in a single game since recording 471 at Campbellsville University on October 27, 2007. Cumberland finished the contest with 672 yards of total offense, just the third game with more than 600 yards in the last 10 years as well.

Phoenix look to continue winning ways

Cumberland has compiled a 51-36 mark over the previous eight seasons, the best eight-year run in program history. The Phoenix posted 8-3 records in 2010 and 2012 and a 7-3 mark in 2011, playing for the division championship in all three campaigns. The squad was 7-4 overall in 2013 as well as 2017 and finished 6-5 in 2014. CU ranks fifth in total victories among

the 18 football-playing schools in the state of Tennessee since the start of the 2010 season heading into this week's game versus Union College. Carson-Newman (59-32) and Chattanooga (55-41) sit atop the standings, followed by Tennessee (52-48) and Middle Tennessee (52-49), both just ahead of Cumberland (51-37). The football-playing schools in the state include Austin Peay, Carson-Newman, Chattanooga, Cumberland, East Tennessee State (since 2015), Lane College, Rhodes College, Maryville College, Memphis, Middle Tennessee, Tennessee, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, Tusculum College, University of the South, UT Martin and Vanderbilt.

Head Coach Tim Mathis



First Season Georgia Southern, 1996

Cumberland University Director of Athletics Ron Pavan announced the hiring of Tim Mathis as head coach for the Phoenix on January 22, 2018. He becomes the sixth head coach since Cumberland restarted the football program in 1990.

Mathis served as an assistant coach for 10 seasons at Shorter University when the Hawks started their program in the NAIA in 2005. He was the team's offensive coordinator his last five years at Shorter, including during the transition to NCAA Division II.

Mathis was a member of the Shorter staff for the inaugural season in 2005 and served five years as the team's offensive line coach. The Hawks led the NAIA in rushing, won the Mid-South Conference championship and earned the program's first-ever postseason playoff berth in 2008. Two players earned All-America honors and a dozen offensive linemen were named All-Mid-South during those five seasons.

He moved into the role of offensive coordinator from 2010-14, working with running backs for two seasons and quarterbacks and fullbacks the final three. Shorter ranked second nationally in rushing at 310.9 yards per game and posted 30.5 points per contest in 2010 and ranked third in the country in rushing (271.9), averaging 30.0 points per outing in 2011, the program's last in the NAIA.

In 2012, the first transition year to Division II, the Hawks ranked ninth nationally in rushing at 268.5 yards per game and ranked third the Gulf South Conference in rushing (227.9) and second in time of possession. Shorter ranked third in total offense in 2013, with fullback Bradley Moon leading the GSC and ranking sixth in rushing yards and quarterback Eric Dodson ranking fifth in the conference in total offense.

Shorter ranked third in the Gulf South and 22nd nationally in rushing in 2014 with 225.3 yards per contest.

Mathis was the head coach the last two seasons at St. Francis High



School in Alpharetta, Ga., posting a 2-8 record in 2016 with freshmen and sophomores making up 74 percent of the roster. He registered a 4-6 mark in 2017 with the Knights.

He also served one season as head coach at Franklin County High School in Eastpoint, Fla., helping the Seahawks break a 23-game losing streak and finishing the season 3-7 overall.

Prior to his time at Shorter, Mathis worked four years at Trion City Schools in Trion, Ga., coaching the offensive line all four seasons as well as serving as defensive coordinator for two years. He was also the wrestling coach for two years and the golf coach for two seasons.

Mathis earned his bachelor's in History with a minor in Political Science from Georgia Southern in 1996 and received his master's in Leadership from Shorter in 2010. He is married to the former Mesha Layman and the couple has two children - Abby and Hunter.
