**Phoenix opens season with Bluefield**  
 Cumberland begins the 2017 season with its fourth straight home opener, taking on Bluefield College at Nokes-Lasater Field. The Phoenix stand 14-13 all-time in home openers, including 3-1 under head coach Donnie Suber. CU dropped the home opener last season, 33-29, to Lindsey Wilson, won 33-26 versus Georgetown College in 2015, posted a 34-27 victory over the University of the Cumberlands IN 2014 and collected a 40-10 win against Bluefield in 2013.

**Phoenix, Rams renew football series**  
 Cumberland and Bluefield College will meet for just the third time since the inception of the Rams program in 2012. The Phoenix have won the two previous meetings between the two clubs, 40-10 at home in 2013 and 59-28 at Bluefield in 2014. Broc Loveless rushed for 127 yards and three touchdowns, all in the second half, and Reed Gurchiek added 164 yards passing in CU's 40-10 victory. Loveless collected TD runs of 46, 13 and 23 yards, as CU scored 21 points over the final 17 minutes of the contest to break open a close game. Cumberland piled up 688 yards of offense and Reed Gurchiek accounted for 273 yards and four touchdowns in the 59-28 win. CU scored 31 straight points at one point in the contest and rushed 55 times for 450 yards and four touchdowns overall.

offense per game last season, averaging 232.4 yards per contest with 32 rushing touchdowns. The Phoenix return four starters on the offensive line who have a combined 81 career starts. Senior Nick Bodden has played in 28 games with 25 starts while Chandler Peebles has played in 28 outings with 27 starts. Senior Jason Smith transferred from Eastern Kentucky two years ago and has started 20 of the 22 contests the last two seasons and junior Jeff Benson saw action in all 11 games last year with nine starts.

### Huntley must stay healthy in 2017

Redshirt junior Dezmon Huntley showed flashes of brilliance last season, but the Mableton, Ga., native missed four games and almost all of another as well as the closing minutes of the season-opener against Lindsey Wilson in an injury-plagued 2016 campaign. He posted 107

rushing yards on 16 carries and also tossed a 13-yard TD pass, all in the second half, at Faulkner University. Despite the time missed, Huntley led the Phoenix in rushing last year with 745 yards on 111 attempts, 6.7 yards per carry, with six touchdowns, while passing for 855 yards on 61-of-104 with three TDs and two interceptions. He ranked seventh in the Mid-South Conference in total offense with 1,600 yards and eighth in rushing yards. He rushed for over 100 yards in five of his seven outings, beginning the year with 102 yards on 18 carries against Lindsey Wilson. He rushed 20 times for 134 yards and three touchdowns at Mississippi College, posted 171 yards on 19 attempts with a TD versus the University of Pikeville and rushed 16 times for 131 yards and two scores at Kentucky Christian. Huntley saw action in eight contests as a redshirt freshman at West Alabama, rushing 48 times for 272 yards and three touchdowns. He also completed 25-of-42 passes for 225 yards and two TDs. Huntley passed for 4,356 yards and rushed for another 2,705 in three years at Pebblebrook High School in Georgia.

**Johnson emerges as dual threat**

Freshman Kendall Johnson burst onto the scene in the 2016 season opener against Lindsey Wilson, scoring the team's first two touchdowns in the game, and put together his best all-around game of the season against Campbellsville University. The Nashville, Tenn., native rushed 18 times for 104 yards and scored the game-winning touchdown in the fourth quarter versus Campbellsville. He also caught five passes for 46 yards and returned a pair of kickoffs for 60 yards, amassing 210 all-purpose yards in the contest. Johnson posted 56 yards receiving and 54 yards rushing in the season opener against Lindsey Wilson and rushed around right end for 63 yards on the first play from scrimmage at Mississippi College. He carried seven times for 87 yards and caught two passes for 22 yards in that game. At Bethel University he collected seven catches for 93 yards, including the game-winning 18-yard TD reception in the second overtime, and also rushed five times for 54 yards. Johnson ranked third on the club in rushing with 376 yards and five touchdowns, averaging 5.8 yards per attempt, and finished last year with 29 receptions for 276 yards and one TD.

**Morton takes advantage of chances**

Redshirt sophomore Lorel Morton registered 31 catches for 377 yards, 12.2 yards-per-catch, last season, ranking second on the club in receptions and yards. The Murfreesboro, Tenn., native caught five passes in the season opener against Lindsey Wilson, with three of those diving receptions for short gains. He added three catches for 40 yards against the University of the Cumberlands and posted three more receptions at Mississippi College for 54 yards. Morton led CU with five catches for 54 yards against the University of Pikeville and added five receptions for 56 yards versus Campbellsville University. He will be asked to step into an even bigger role in 2017 with the departure of two-time All-Conference wideout Michael Green, who led the Phoenix in receptions and yards each of the last three seasons.

**Defense needs more turnovers**

Cumberland's defense forced only 13 turnovers in 11 games last season – seven interceptions and six fumble recoveries. The unit forced only 12 turnovers in 2015 – six fumbles and six interceptions – after registering 27 takeaways in 2014 and between 25 and 32 takeaways every season but one from 2009-14. The lack of turnovers did not provide short fields to a struggling offense and also contributed to the defense staying on the field for long stretches of the game last season. The unit was on the

field for 34-plus minutes on four occasions and Cumberland lost the time of possession battle in seven of the team's 11 contests in 2015. Last year the Phoenix posted a season-high three takeaways versus Campbellsville University with two fumbles and one interception and added a pair of interceptions at Kentucky Christian and East Tennessee State. Shedrick Kirk provided the only defensive touchdown of 2016, returning a fumble 90 yards for a TD at Faulkner University, the first defensive score for the Phoenix since October 3, 2015 at the University of Pikeville.

**Defensive scores are the norm for CU**

Under head coach and defensive coordinator Donnie Suber, Cumberland has registered 29 defensive touchdowns in nine seasons, which includes interceptions, fumble returns and blocked punts, as well as forcing six safeties. The Phoenix registered three defensive scores

in 2015, with Nathan Anderson blocking a punt out of the end zone for a safety at West Alabama and Anthony Knight picking up a blocked extra point and returning it 85 yards for two points at Valdosta State. At the University of Pikeville, Anderson blocked his second punt of the season and returned it six yards for the TD. Shedrick Kirk picked up a fumble and returned it 90 yards for a TD at Faulkner University, the only defensive score for the Phoenix last season. The chart to the left has a complete listing of all defensive scores under Suber.

**Offense keeps turnovers to a minimum**

After some major struggles with turnovers to end the 2015 campaign, Cumberland's offense kept miscues to a minimum last season, committing only 11 turnovers in 11 games. The Phoenix fumbled twice against the University of Pikeville and had two miscues versus Campbellsville University, leading to a pair of Tiger touchdowns. CU did not commit a turnover in four outings last year. In 2015 Cumberland took care of the ball very well in the first five games, committing just six total turnovers, but miscues over the last six contests led directly to five straight defeats. The Phoenix committed 19 turnovers during those last six outings, including four at Campbellsville and five versus Bethel University. Cumberland opponents feasted on the offense's 25 miscues in 2015, turning those into 115 points, including 24 by Campbellsville and 21 apiece from Bethel and Lindsey Wilson.

**Phoenix look to continue winning ways**

Cumberland has compiled a 44-32 mark over the previous seven seasons, the best seven-year run in program history. The Phoenix posted 8-3 records in 2010 and 2012 and a 7-3 mark in 2011, playing for the division championship in all three campaigns. The squad was 7-4 overall in 2013, winning seven of its final nine outings, and finished 6-5 in 2014. CU ranks seventh in total victories among the 18 football-playing schools in the state of Tennessee since the start of the 2010 season. Chattanooga (52-33) leads all schools with Carson-Newman (50-30) second and Tennessee (48-40) third. Maryville College (45-25), UT Martin (45-35) and Middle Tennessee (45-42) are tied for fourth, with Cumberland next. The football-playing schools in the state include Austin Peay, Carson-Newman, Chattanooga, Cumberland, East Tennessee State (since 2015), Lane College, Rhodes College, Maryville College, Memphis, Middle Ten-

## Head Coach Donnie Suber



**Fifth Season as HC/  
10th Season as  
Defensive Coordinator/  
Defensive Backs Coach**

Donnie Suber was named head coach at Cumberland University on January 28, 2013, the fifth head coach of the program since it was revived in 1990. He begins his fifth year as head coach and 10th season in his third stint at Cumberland, serving as the defensive coordinator and defensive backs coach. He has worked as an assistant or head coach at the collegiate level for the past 24 years, 13 of those at CU.

Suber has compiled a 21-23 mark over four seasons as head coach with the Phoenix, including a combined 13-9 in his first two campaigns. Cumberland rebounded from a disappointing 3-8 year in 2015 with a 5-6 mark last season that included four losses by a combined 15 points. During his tenure as head coach, CU has earned 27 First or Second Team All-Mid-South Conference honors while collecting a pair of MSC Defensive Player of the Year accolades.

In addition 78 players have been named Academic All-Mid-South and 37 have garnered Daktronics-NAIA Scholar-Athlete recognition.

The Phoenix continued their recent winning ways in Suber's first year at the helm of the program, winning four straight games in the middle of the year and seven of the final nine outings to finish 7-4, the club's fourth consecutive winning season. Nathan Jernigan was voted the Mid-South Conference West Division Freshman of the Year. Cumberland also led the Mid-South Conference with 28 Academic All-MSC selections and ranked No. 1 in the nation for the second straight year with 16 Daktronics-NAIA Scholar-Athletes.

In 2014 the Phoenix ended the year 6-5 overall, losing its last three games thanks to a slew of injuries. Six players garnered All-Mid-South Conference recognition, including defenders Grant Jones, Justus Daus-



cha and Jernigan on the First Team.

Cumberland stood 3-3 midway through the 2015 campaign after a pair of victories and two early-season defeats to NCAA Division II institutions. Injuries and a sluggish offense led to a five-game losing streak to end the year. Eight players earned All-MSC honors, including defenders Cayman Russell and Jernigan on the First Team and Dauscha on the Second Team. Jernigan was voted MSC West Co-Defensive Player of the Year and First Team Academic All-America as well.

Cumberland's defense allowed 61.1 less rushing yards per game in 2016, helping the unit improve from 59th to 22nd in rushing yards allowed per game (140.4) and give up 12.0 fewer points per game, going from 72nd to 45th nationally. The unit also posted 28 sacks, ranking 21st in the country.

CU lost 33-29 in the season opener to Lindsey Wilson and dropped a 27-26 decision on the road at D-II Mississippi College on a last-second field goal. The club was on the wrong end of a 31-28 decision at Faulkner University and lost the season finale, 23-16, at East Tennessee State.

Four Cumberland players received All-MSC accolades, including defenders Dauscha and Jernigan, with Jernigan earning his second straight MSC West Defensive Player of the Year honor.

Suber earned his bachelor's in Recreation and Hotel Management from Georgia Southern in 1990 and played on NCAA Division I-AA national championship teams as a defensive back in 1986, 1989 and 1990.

His first coaching position was at Cumberland University as the defensive backs and strength coach as a graduate assistant. Suber earned his master's from Cumberland in Organizational Behavior in 1993.

He returned to his alma mater in 1994 as the restricted earnings coach in charge of defensive backs before coming back to Cumberland for two years in 1995-96 as defensive backs coach and men's and women's golf coach. The Columbia, S.C., native then spent four seasons as the defensive coordinator, defensive backs coach and recruiting coordinator at Newberry College.

In 2001 he held the same positions at Benedict College before serving as the linebackers coach in 2002 and then the receivers coach from 2003-06 at Presbyterian College.
