**CU plays final road title at Campbellsville**  
 Cumberland travels to Campbellsville, Ky., for Saturday's final road contest of the year against the Tigers. Campbellsville leads the all-time series, 14-13, with the teams alternating wins and losses the last nine years. Last season Kendall Johnson's three-yard TD run capped a 13-play, 91-yard drive and the Cumberland defense held one final time, preserving a 46-40 victory for the Phoenix. Johnson rushed 18 times for 104 yards and Austin Chaplin added 107 yards on 12 carries with two touchdowns, including scoring runs of 36 and 17. Justin Snyder added a career-best 301 yards passing with scoring throws of 63 and 57 yards to Michael Green. David Emanuel set-up the game-winning drive with a sliding interception at the nine yard line, ending a long Campbellsville drive that could have put the game away.

one pulling CU within 44-41 with 3:04 remaining. The sophomore added three catches for 51 yards, including a 38-yard catch-and-run down the sideline for a touchdown to get Cumberland on the board in the first quarter. North has rushed for 331 yards on 38 carries with six touchdowns over the last three games for the Phoenix.

### O-line a strength for CU

Cumberland ranked 11th nationally in rushing offense per game last season, averaging 232.4 yards per contest with 32 rushing touchdowns. This season the club currently ranks fifth in total rushing offense (2,415 yards) and sixth in rushing offense per game (268.3) through nine games with 31 rushing touchdowns. Seniors Nick Bodden, Chandler Peebles and Jason Smith along with junior Jeff Benson have a combined 112 career starts through nine games in 2017. Bodden has played in 36 games with 33 starts while Peebles has played in 35 outings with 34 starts. Smith transferred from Eastern Kentucky two years ago and has started 28 of the 30 contests the last two-plus seasons and Benson saw action in all 11 games last year, starting nine contests, and has nine starts this season as well. The unit has also allowed just nine sacks through nine contests as well.

### Huntley racks up yards in air, on ground

Redshirt junior Dezmon Huntley ranks eighth in the Mid-South Conference in total offense (1,739 yards), seventh in rushing yards (634) and 12th in passing yards (1105) despite missing nine quarters of action this season. The Mableton, Ga., native continued his impressive work on the ground against Bethel University three weeks ago, carrying 17 times for 144 yards, his third 100-yard rushing game this season and eighth in 15 career contests at CU. He added TD passes of 15 and 20 yards. He posted touchdown throws of 38 and 13 yards and rushed for a 16-yard score at Lindsey Wilson. Huntley rushed 10 times for 102 yards and two touchdowns at Presbyterian College on September 23 and enjoyed the best all-around performance of his career at the University of the Cumberlands on Sept. 2, passing for a career-high 291 yards and rushing for 101 yards and two touchdowns. He finished 12-of-27 passing for 149 yards and one touchdown and added 63 yards rushing with another TD in the season opener against Bluefield College. He accounted for 150 yards of offense and three

touchdowns in one quarter of action versus Webber International and passed for 158 yards and one score and rushed for 39 yards and another TD at Edward Waters. Huntley leads the Phoenix with 634 rushing yards on 91 carries, 7.0 yards-per-attempt, and has passed for 1105 yards on 88-of-176 with seven TDs and seven interceptions.

### Toliver takes advantage of chances

Sophomore Denarius Toliver has seen plenty of action for Cumberland over the last two seasons but his impact in the contest at Georgetown College on September 30 was easily the biggest of his career. The Chattanooga, Tenn., native caught five passes for 213 yards and two touchdowns, including TD grabs of 81 and 67 yards in the fourth quarter. The 6-foot-3 receiver also made a 51-yard grab in the contest. Toliver has 17 receptions for 394 yards (23.2 yards-per-catch) with a team-high four touchdowns this season. He posted only three catches for 49 yards in 10 games as a freshman.

### Rushin posts 300-yard passing day in relief

Redshirt sophomore Joseph Rushin passed for over 300 yards in a little less than two quarters at Georgetown College on Sept. 30, coming on in relief of an injured Dezmon Huntley. The McDonough, Ga., native completed 14-of-25 passes for 304 yards and two touchdowns, both to Denarius Toliver, for 81 and 67 yards in the

fourth quarter. He also had a 51-yard completion to Toliver and ran for a one-yard TD in the first quarter. It marked the first 300-yard passing day for a CU quarterback since Justin Snyder threw for 301 on October 22, 2016, versus Campbellsville University. Rushin ranks third in the Mid-South Conference with 10 rushing touchdowns this season, seven of those from one yard out. He carried six times for 35 yards with a six-yard TD run in the season opener against Bluefield College and posted a crazy stat line at the University of the Cumberlands, rushing eight times for four yards and four touchdowns with four one-yard TD runs. This season he has rushed 81 times for 317 yards and completed 31-of-56 passes for 513 yards with four touchdowns and three interceptions.

**Defensive scores are the norm for CU**

Under head coach and defensive coordinator Donnie Suber, Cumberland has registered 33 defensive touchdowns in nine-plus seasons,

which includes interceptions, fumble returns and blocked punts, as well as forcing six safeties. Shedrick Kirk picked up a fumble and returned it 90 yards for a TD at Faulkner University, the only defensive score in 2016. David Emanuel added to the total with a 29-yard interception return for a TD versus Webber International this season, the first INT return for a TD by a CU player since November 15, 2014, versus Alderson Broaddus. JarVis Ruff forced a fumble near the goal line and Tyler Tate fell on the ball in the end zone for a TD at Edward Waters and Josh Bates picked up a fumble after a sack and raced 64 yards for a score at Georgetown College. Tate returned a fumble 29 yards for a score and Prentiss Sumerall returned an interception 29 yards for a touchdown two weeks ago versus Cincinnati Christian. The chart on the top left of this page has a complete listing of all defensive scores under Suber.

**QBs spreading out passes to receivers**

Eleven different receivers have caught passes through nine games this season for Cumberland, but no receiver has more than 29 receptions. Quarterbacks Dezmon Huntley and Joseph Rushin continue to spread the wealth and hit big plays with everyone. Sophomore Kendall Johnson leads the club with 29 receptions for 246 yards with a 36-yarder versus Webber International. Junior Ladarius Rodgers has 16 catches for 184 yards with a 44-yard reception at the University of the Cumberlands. Sophomore Lorel Morton has posted 12 catches for 203 yards and two TDs, including a 43-yarder at the Cumberlands, and junior Marcus Bryson has 14 receptions for 222 yards with a 42-yarder at the Cumberlands. Sophomore Denarius Toliver ranks first on the club with 394 yards receiving and four TDs, most of that coming at Georgetown College on Sept. 30.

**Offense needs to cut down on miscues**

After some major struggles with turnovers to end the 2015 campaign, Cumberland's offense kept miscues to a minimum last season, committing only 11 turnovers in 11 games. The Phoenix have not been so lucky so far in 2017, committing 17 turnovers – seven fumbles and 10 interceptions. Luckily the Cumberland defense has allowed just 20 points off those 17 miscues, 10 of those by the University of the Cumberlands. CU posted three miscues against Bluefield College and two each versus the Cumberlands and Webber International to

start the year. Cumberland fumbled once at Edward Waters and at Presbyterian College and threw two interceptions at Georgetown College and versus Cincinnati Christian. The unit had a fumble and one interception against Bethel University and Lindsey Wilson. In 2015 Cumberland took care of the ball very well in the first five games, committing just six total turnovers, but miscues over the last six contests led directly to five straight defeats. The Phoenix committed 19 turnovers during those six outings, including four at Campbellsville University and five versus Bethel. Cumberland opponents feasted on the offense's 25 miscues in 2015, turning those into 115 points, including 24 by Campbellsville and 21 apiece from Bethel and Lindsey Wilson.

**Defense on a better pace for turnovers**

Cumberland's defense has forced 21 turnovers (14 fumbles, seven interceptions) this season, a far better pace than in the previous two campaigns. The unit forced only 13 turnovers in 11 games in 2016 (7 interceptions, 6 fumbles) and had just 12 turnovers in 2015 (6 fumbles, 6 interceptions) after registering between 25 and 32 takeaways every season but one from 2009-14. The unit was on the field for 34-plus minutes on four occasions and Cumberland lost the time of possession battle in seven of the team's 11 contests in 2015. Last year the Phoenix posted a season-high three takeaways versus Campbellsville University and added a pair of interceptions at Kentucky Christian and East

North earns Player of the Week accolades

Cumberland running back Kimlee North was named the Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division Offensive Player of the Week on October 16, rushing for a career-high 154 yards and two touchdowns in CU's 52-21 win over Bethel University, as announced by the league office. The Nashville, Tenn., native collected the first 100-yard rushing game of his career on just 14 attempts, scoring two fourth-quarter touchdowns. The Phoenix led 28-21 at the half and 31-21 entering the fourth quarter. North's nine-yard TD run with 13:53 left in the contest made it 38-21 and after the Cumberland defense held on the ensuing Bethel possession, the sophomore running back burst through the middle and outran three defenders for a 62-yard score, essentially sealing the win for the home team.

Tate garners MSC Defensive POW accolades

Sophomore Tyler Tate posted six tackles and returned a fumble for a touchdown in Cumberland's win against Cincinnati Christian, earning Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division Defensive Player of the Week honors on October 9. The Whitwell, Tenn., native returned a fumble 29 yards for a touchdown in the first quarter. Cody Carr forced a fumble on a running play to the left by CCU's Garner Harris and the ball popped right into the hands of Tate, who raced 29 yards for the score. It was the second touchdown of the year for Tate, who fell on a fumble in the end zone at Edward Waters on September 16.

**Patrick named MSC Defensive POW**

Cumberland's DeAnthony Patrick was named the Mid-South Conference Football Defensive Player of the Week on September 25 after registering a career-best 14 tackles in CU's 27-20 loss at NCAA Division I FCS Presbyterian College. The Nashville, Tenn., native was all over the field, making 13 stops over the final three quarters, including one tackle for loss. The senior safety posted one more stop than his previous career-best of 13 tackles at UT Martin on Sept. 11, 2014, and it marked his third career double-digit tackle performance. Patrick collected nine stops at the University of the Cumberland and seven at Edward Waters earlier this season.

**Travecedo garners Mid-South Conference Player of the Week accolades**

Cumberland's Pablo Dongarra Travecedo was voted Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division Special Teams Player of the Week on August 28 after hitting three extra points and one field goal in CU's 24-17 victory over Bluefield College. The Guayaquil, Ecuador, native connected on three extra points and booted a 37-yard field goal in his Cumberland debut. The wind knocked down his last kickoff of the game and the ball bounced away from the return men, a fumble the Phoenix recovered that led to his field goal late in the third quarter. Cumberland was just 2-of-7 in field goal tries last season and 3-for-13 over the last two years before Travecedo's 37-yarder versus Bluefield.

**Cumberland sweeps weekly MSC awards**

Cumberland's Dezmon Huntley, David Emanuel and Pablo Dongarra Travecedo swept the Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division Player of the Week awards on September 11 after their performances in a 38-24 victory over Webber International. Huntley passed for a touchdown and ran for two TDs in less than a quarter of action, accounting for 150 yards of total offense. He tossed a 24-yard TD to Lorel Morton for the team's first touchdown of the game and rushed 13 yards for a score on the next possession. He then scampered 55 yards for a TD, pushing the CU lead to 24-0 with 3:29 left in the opening period. Emanuel posted three tackles, one pass breakup and returned an interception 29 yards for a touchdown. The INT return gave CU a 31-0 lead less than three minutes into the second quarter. It was the fourth interception of

Emanuel's Phoenix career. Travecedo made a 22-yard field goal for CU's first points of the contest and added five extra points in the victory.

**Campagne named TSWA Player of the Week**

Cumberland's Alex Campagne was named the Tennessee Sports Writers Association Defensive Player of the Week on August 31, collecting 11 tackles and one tackle for loss in CU's 24-17 victory against Bluefield College. It marked the first double-digit tackle performance of Campagne's career. He posted nine stops twice last season – versus Campbellsville University and at Bethel University. He collected four solo tackles in the contest. Cumberland limited Bluefield to just 322 yards of total offense, including 208 in the final three quarters.

**Phoenix look to continue winning ways**

Cumberland has compiled a 44-32 mark over the previous seven seasons, the best seven-year run in program history. The Phoenix posted 8-3 records in 2010 and 2012 and a 7-3 mark in 2011, playing for the division championship in all three campaigns. The squad was 7-4 overall in 2013, winning seven of its final nine outings, and finished 6-5 in 2014. CU ranks fourth in total victories among the 18 football-playing schools in the state of Tennessee since the start of the 2010 season heading into this week's game. Carson-Newman (56-31) and Chattanooga (53-39) sit atop the standings, followed by Tennessee (51-43) and Cumberland (50-34). The football-playing schools in the state include Austin Peay, Carson-Newman, Chattanooga, Cumberland, East Tennessee State (since 2015), Lane College, Rhodes College, Maryville College, Memphis, Middle Tennessee, Tennessee, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, Tusculum College, University of the South, UT Martin and Vanderbilt.

## Head Coach Donnie Suber



**Fifth Season as HC/  
10th Season as  
Defensive Coordinator/  
Defensive Backs Coach**

Donnie Suber was named head coach at Cumberland University on January 28, 2013, the fifth head coach of the program since it was revived in 1990. He begins his fifth year as head coach and 10th season in his third stint at Cumberland, serving as the defensive coordinator and defensive backs coach. He has worked as an assistant or head coach at the collegiate level for the past 24 years, 13 of those at CU.

Suber has compiled a 21-23 mark over four seasons as head coach with the Phoenix, including a combined 13-9 in his first two campaigns. Cumberland rebounded from a disappointing 3-8 year in 2015 with a 5-6 mark last season that included four losses by a combined 15 points. During his tenure as head coach, CU has earned 27 First or Second Team All-Mid-South Conference honors while collecting a pair of MSC Defensive Player of the Year accolades.

In addition 78 players have been named Academic All-Mid-South and 37 have garnered Daktronics-NAIA Scholar-Athlete recognition.

The Phoenix continued their recent winning ways in Suber's first year at the helm of the program, winning four straight games in the middle of the year and seven of the final nine outings to finish 7-4, the club's fourth consecutive winning season. Nathan Jernigan was voted the Mid-South Conference West Division Freshman of the Year. Cumberland also led the Mid-South Conference with 28 Academic All-MSC selections and ranked No. 1 in the nation for the second straight year with 16 Daktronics-NAIA Scholar-Athletes.

In 2014 the Phoenix ended the year 6-5 overall, losing its last three games thanks to a slew of injuries. Six players garnered All-Mid-South Conference recognition, including defenders Grant Jones, Justus Daus-

cha and Jernigan on the First Team.

Cumberland stood 3-3 midway through the 2015 campaign after a pair of victories and two early-season defeats to NCAA Division II institutions. Injuries and a sluggish offense led to a five-game losing streak to end the year. Eight players earned All-MSC honors, including defenders Cayman Russell and Jernigan on the First Team and Dauscha on the Second Team. Jernigan was voted MSC West Co-Defensive Player of the Year and First Team Academic All-America as well.

Cumberland's defense allowed 61.1 less rushing yards per game in 2016, helping the unit improve from 59th to 22nd in rushing yards allowed per game (140.4) and give up 12.0 fewer points per game, going from 72nd to 45th nationally. The unit also posted 28 sacks, ranking 21st in the country.

CU lost 33-29 in the season opener to Lindsey Wilson and dropped a 27-26 decision on the road at D-II Mississippi College on a last-second field goal. The club was on the wrong end of a 31-28 decision at Faulkner University and lost the season finale, 23-16, at East Tennessee State.

Four Cumberland players received All-MSC accolades, including defenders Dauscha and Jernigan, with Jernigan earning his second straight MSC West Defensive Player of the Year honor.

Suber earned his bachelor's in Recreation and Hotel Management from Georgia Southern in 1990 and played on NCAA Division I-AA national championship teams as a defensive back in 1986, 1989 and 1990.

His first coaching position was at Cumberland University as the defensive backs and strength coach as a graduate assistant. Suber earned his master's from Cumberland in Organizational Behavior in 1993.

He returned to his alma mater in 1994 as the restricted earnings coach in charge of defensive backs before coming back to Cumberland for two years in 1995-96 as defensive backs coach and men's and women's golf coach. The Columbia, S.C., native then spent four seasons as the defensive coordinator, defensive backs coach and recruiting coordinator at Newberry College.

In 2001 he held the same positions at Benedict College before serving as the linebackers coach in 2002 and then the receivers coach from 2003-06 at Presbyterian College.
