● Cumberland continues a four-game homestand this Thursday, facing Shawnee State at the Dallas Floyd Recreation Center.

● Shawnee State leads the all-time series between the two clubs, 7-5, including three straight victories and five wins in the last six meetings. Cumberland is just 1-4 against the Bears in Lebanon, with four of the five meetings decided by three points or less.

● Kyra Tucker posted 13 of her 15 points in the second half and Cumberland had the game tied midway through the fourth quarter, but Shawnee State made 8-of-13 free throws in the final period in a 57-53 victory last month.

● Cumberland dropped to 1-6 against ranked opponents this season with last Thursday's defeat against Lindsey Wilson. CU has losses at No. 3 Freed-Hardeman, versus No. 4 Vanguard University, at 12th-ranked Lindsey Wilson, at No. 4 Shawnee State, versus third-ranked Campbellsville University and against No. 9 Lindsey Wilson. The Phoenix also won at 25th-ranked Talladega College.

● Cumberland ranks 10th nationally (among 89 schools) in scoring defense (55.870), 18th in total steals (247), 23rd in field goal percentage defense (.361) and 30th in 3-point field goal percentage defense (.290) as of February 6. The Phoenix have allowed 60 points just six times this season and more than 62 only four times.

Patton keeps filling the stat sheet

Junior Ant'Treasia Patton started the year hot-and-cold offensively, but the Nashville, Tenn., native has found her scoring touch more consistently over the last six games. She averaged 11.4 points per game through the first five contests this season, netting 19 points versus Freed-Hardeman and 17 points at Talladega College. Patton scored just 23 total points over the next five games before registering a season-high 22 points at Stillman College, hitting 7-of-13 shots overall with three 3-pointers. She followed that with 17 points and eight rebounds versus Huntington University, but an injury over the Christmas break left her unable to practice for almost two weeks. She collected just three points in 26 minutes in her return at Lindsey Wilson but netted 17 points with three 3-pointers and eight rebounds at the University of Pikeville. She missed all seven shots and all four attempts from behind the arc at Shawnee State but finished with 16 points with three 3-pointers and six rebounds versus the University of the Cumberlands. Her triple with 2:36 remaining put the Phoenix ahead for good. Patton scored 19 points versus Life University, including 17 in the first half, and netted 21 points with a season-best five 3-pointers and nine rebounds at Georgetown College. She collected 10 points against Campbellsville University and added 14 versus Lindsey Wilson. Patton ranks second on the club in scoring and rebounding with 10.9 points and 5.0 rebounds per contest. She has 13 games this season with five or more boards, including nine against Indiana-Southeast and seven versus Talladega College.

Tucker nets 22 points versus Life

Junior Kyra Tucker leads the Phoenix in scoring with 11.3 points per game, including 14

double-figure scoring outings. The Indianapolis, Ind., native has netted double-digits in 10 of the last 14 outings, posting 13.0 points per contest over that stretch. She is shooting 40 percent (23-for-57) from 3-point range during the 14 games as well. Tucker exploded for a career-best 27 points against the University of Mobile on December 31, hitting 10-of-15 shots overall and 6-for-6 from 3-point range. She collected 22 points versus Life University, 14 of those in the second half, scored 15 points against Indiana-Southeast and 14 versus Talladega College. In conference play Tucker recorded 17 points at Lindsey Wilson and added 17 points at Shawnee State. She is shooting 35 percent from 3-point range overall this season, second best among all CU players behind Ant'Treasia Patton (39 percent).

Norris helping Phoenix win with defense

Senior Micah Norris ranks third in the Mid-South Conference and 22nd nationally with 54 steals this season, 2.35 per outing. The Murfreesboro, Tenn., native has 11 contests with at least three thefts and seven outings with four or more steals. She ranks third on the club in rebounding with 4.1 per game and scoring at 9.3 points per contest. Norris has netted double figures 10 times in 2017-18, including 15 points at Talladega College and 16 versus Vanguard University. She scored 17 points in the second meeting with Talladega and added 16 in the victory over the University of Mobile. Norris posted nine points and a season-best 11 rebounds at Shawnee State, added 10 points versus the University of the Cumberlands and posted 14 against Life University. She scored eight of her 15 points in the final 2:10 at Georgetown College, hitting a pair of 3-pointers that helped seal the win.

Oliver most improved player for CU

Senior Kaitlin Oliver is averaging 7.2 points and 6.7 rebounds per game this season, more than doubling her outputs over any of her three previous campaigns at Cumberland. The LaVergne, Tenn., native has scored in double figures eight times after just one double-digit outing in 73 career games before this season, including a career-high 20 points at Oakwood University and 12 points versus Indiana-Southeast. She has grabbed double figure rebounds four times

as well, collecting 13 at Talladega College and 14 against Huntington University. Oliver registered 10 points and 11 rebounds at the University of Pikeville, the team's first double-double of the season. She followed that with 11 points and eight boards at Shawnee State and added 10 rebounds versus Life University. Oliver ranks ninth in the Mid-South Conference in rebounding per game and is averaging a team-high 30.3 minutes per game.

Lindsey's dishing big part of CU offense

Senior Janisha Lindsey missed six games from November 28-December 16, dealing with personal and family issues. She collected just eight points, eight assists and six rebounds in her first three games back on the court. The Evansville, Ind., native has averaged 5.9 points, 3.7 rebounds and 6.3 assists (44 assists to just 19 turnovers) per outing over the last seven games. She posted her best contest of the season at the University of Pikeville, finishing with 10 points, seven rebounds and six assists in 28 minutes. Lindsey followed that with 10 points at Shawnee State and collected six points, five assists and six steals against the University of the Cumberlands. She added eight points and eight assists versus Life University and registered six assists, five rebounds and three steals at Georgetown College. She has posted nine outings this season with five or more assists, including 13 at Oakwood University and nine versus Vanguard University and Campbellsville

University. Lindsey is averaging 5.00 assists per game, which would lead the Mid-South Conference if she qualified for league stats (she is one game short of 75 percent of the total games played). She also posts 2.59 steals per outing, which would rank third in the league.

Defense plenty good enough for Phoenix

Cumberland ranks 10th nationally in scoring defense per game (55.870) heading into Thursday's contest against Shawnee State. The Phoenix have allowed 60 points just six times this season and more than 62 only four times. Opponents are shooting just 36 percent from the field and 29 percent from 3-point range. CU is also forcing 19.48 turnovers per game, turning those into 424 total points, 18.4 per game. Cumberland's biggest issue so far in 2017-18 has been offense, with the Phoenix averaging just 59.9 points per game while shooting 39 percent overall and 30 percent from behind the

arc. Throw in 17.6 turnovers per game and too many possessions ending with either a missed shot (many times not a good shot) or a turnover. Cumberland has scored more than 70 points only four times in 23 games and more than 60 points just eight times this season.

News and Notes

All eight of Cumberland's losses this season have come against teams who were ranked at the time or are ranked currently, including Freed-Hardeman, Campbellsville University, Shawnee State, Lindsey Wilson (twice), Vanguard University, the University of Providence and Martin Methodist ... Senior Micah Norris has scored a combined six points in the last two games for CU, hitting 3-of-10 shots. She got in early foul trouble against Campbellsville, playing just 14 minutes in the loss and was 2-for-6 versus Lindsey Wilson ... Senior Janisha Lindsey has netted seven total points in the last three contests, making 2-of-10 shots overall. She averaged 8.5 points over four games from January 11-20 before her recent skid ... Junior Carli Codner-Pinto posted her second double-digit scoring outing of the season with 13 points against Campbellsville, hitting 3-of-5 from 3-point range. Her only other double-figure contest of the year was December 31 versus the University of Mobile ... After scoring in double figures in 3-of-4 outings from Jan. 4-13, senior Kaitlin Oliver has netted a combined 22 points in the last five outings, con-

necting on 10-of-32 shots (.313). She was 0-for-7 against the University of the Cumberlands and 2-of-10 versus Lindsey Wilson.

**Tucker earns Mid-South
Player of the Week accolades**

Cumberland's Kyra Tucker earned Mid-South Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week on January 1, netting 27 points with six 3-pointers in a 74-62 victory over the University of Mobile. The Indianapolis, Ind., native made all six of her 3-point attempts, the first Phoenix player with six triples in a game since Casie Cowan made six on January 25, 2014. Tucker connected on 10-of-15 shots overall in the contest while adding seven rebounds and three assists. The junior netted the first eight points of the contest and 11 of the team's first 13 points in the opening quarter, hitting three 3-pointers in the process. She added two more 3-pointers in the fourth quarter.

Patton garners TSWA weekly honor

Cumberland's Ant'Treasia Patton earned Tennessee Sports Writers Association Player of the Week accolades on December 20, averaging 16.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 2.7 assists in three wins for the Phoenix. The Nashville, Tenn., native posted nine points and seven boards in a victory over Talladega College, the team's second victory over the Tornadoes this season. The junior collected a season-best 22 points with

comers will look to fill the void for the Phoenix this season, beginning with senior guard Micah Norris, a Murfreesboro native who played last season at East Tennessee State. Kyra Tucker spent the last two seasons at Vincennes University and Ant'Treasia Patton played two years at Wallace State Community College and one year at Austin Peay. Carli Codner-Pinto, who spent the last two seasons at Columbus State Community College in Ohio, will share the point guard duties with Lindsey. Shawnee State received four first-place votes and 46 total points to take first place in the Coaches' Poll, with Campbellsville University and Lindsey Wilson tied for second with 41 points. Campbellsville posted one first-place votes and Lindsey Wilson got the other three. Cumberland ranked fourth with 29 points, just ahead of the University of Pikeville (26 points) and the University of the Cumberlands (20). Georgetown College (14) and Life University (7) rounded out the poll.

three 3-pointers in a 55-51 win at Stillman College, hitting 7-of-13 shots overall. It marked her first double-digit scoring outing since November 18 at Talladega, a span of seven games. Patton followed that with 17 points and eight rebounds with the game-winning basket in a 53-51 victory against Huntington University. She scored the team's first eight points of the contest and hit the game-winning 18-footer at the buzzer for Cumberland's sixth consecutive victory. Patton connected on 7-of-14 from 3-point range in the three games and made 17-of-32 shots from the field for the week.

CU picked fourth in MSC Preseason Poll

Cumberland women's basketball and ninth-year head coach Jeremy Lewis were picked fourth in the Mid-South Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll released in October. Lewis returns nine letterwinners but just two starters and lost the team's top four scorers from last season, including Third Team All-American Nicole Bowers and All-Mid-South Conference honorees Taliah Moore and Julia Fox. Senior guards Jailen Murphy (6.4 points, 3.2 rebounds) and Janisha Lindsey (5.7 points, 3.8 rebounds, 5.5 assists) return as the club's leading scorers from 2016-17. No other returner started more than two games or averaged more than four points or 2.2 rebounds. A small but strong group of new-

Head Coach Jeremy Lewis



Jeremy Lewis begins his ninth season as head coach for women's basketball at Cumberland University and his 13th as a full-time coach at his alma mater. It also marks Lewis' 17th year as a member of the Phoenix family as both a player and coach.

Lewis led the program to one of the most successful years in school history in 2012-13, finishing 33-3 overall and No. 4 in the final rankings. The Phoenix won the Mid-South Conference regular season and tournament titles and reached the NAIA Fab Four for the second time in program annals.

He was voted Mid-South Conference and Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Russell Athletic/Region 5 Coach of the Year during the campaign. CU made its fifth appearance in the NAIA National Tournament and first since 2007.

Cumberland was ranked in the Top 10 nationally from the first regular season poll of the year in December until the postseason, reaching as high as No. 5 in the country, then the highest ranking ever for the program. The Phoenix won their first regular season and conference tournament titles since 1998-99, also in the Mid-South Conference, and set the school record for victories, surpassing the previous mark of 27 held by the 1998-99 and 2006-07 squads.

Jessica Pace earned First Team All-Mid-South Conference accolades and TaCouya Allen, Briannica Tye and London Elie each garnered Second Team All-MSA honors. Pace also received Honorable Mention All-America honors from the WBCA and Second Team All-America accolades from the NAIA.

Lewis took over the women's program in May 2009 as interim head coach and had the interim tag removed by Director of Athletics Ron Pavan in January 2010. The Phoenix finished the season 9-18 overall in his first year but dropped nine games by seven points or less during the campaign. Allysia Bailey was voted TranSouth Conference Newcomer of the Year, Stephanie Martin was an All-Freshman Team selection and four players earned TranSouth Scholar-Athlete honors.

CU improved to 14-16 in 2010-11 and upped its record in TranSouth Conference play to 6-10. The squad lost five games by nine points or less that season as well. Casie Cowan garnered Second Team All-TranSouth and All-Freshman Team accolades and four players were named TranSouth Scholar-Athletes.

The 2011-12 club started the season 3-10 overall with losses to three ranked teams and three others who were ranked in the second half of the campaign. That stretch included single-digit defeats to future Mid-South Conference opponents St. Catharine College, Lindsey Wilson, Campbellville University, Georgetown College and the University of the Cumberlands.

The Phoenix turned the season around in January, winning 12 of their final

16 contests, including two losses to eventual national runner-up Union University by a combined seven points. Cowan earned Honorable Mention All-America honors at the end of the season while Tamara Gonzalez was named an NAIA Scholar-Athlete. Cowan garnered First Team All-TranSouth honors for the second straight season and Simone Ryan and Courtney Atkinson both garnered Second Team accolades.

In 2013-14 the club suffered through a myriad of issues from injuries to illness and ineligibility. Despite a depleted roster that included several games with only seven healthy bodies, Cumberland battled to a 9-9 mark at the end of January that included six defeats and a pair of wins over ranked opponents. The lack of depth showed in the month of February, with the squad losing seven straight before ending the year with a victory on Senior Day. Cowan and Allen both earned Second Team All-Mid-South Conference honors and Tasia Blue was named an NAIA Scholar-Athlete.

In 2014-15 Cumberland began the year 8-2 before a double overtime home loss to then fifth-ranked Campbellville. Injuries and ineligibility changed the club for the second half of the season, with CU dropping 6-of-7 including the Campbellville loss, but the squad rebounded to win seven of its final 11 outings in the regular season and conference tournament.

Cumberland received an at-large berth into the NAIA National Tournament, the second time under Lewis. Chelsey Hall earned First Team All-Mid-South and Third Team All-America accolades while Blue, Maryann Fenner and Andrea Morrisett were all named NAIA Scholar-Athletes.

In 2015-16 the Phoenix posted a 10-3 mark to start the campaign before running into trouble in the final game before Christmas, losing to Huntington University. That loss sent the club into a tailspin, dropping 6-of-8 contests. CU righted the ship in February, winning six of its final eight regular season games and earning another at-large berth into the national tournament.

Cumberland upset fourth-ranked Bethel University in the national tourney before falling to Lewis-Clark State. Hall garnered Third Team All-America honors again and Nicole Bowers was named Honorable Mention All-America while Hall was named an NAIA Scholar-Athlete.

Last season the Phoenix posted a 9-1 mark before an overtime loss at Campbellville to begin the month of December. The club split its six league games in January and entered the month of February 15-5 overall. Cumberland lost its seven contests of the year, five of those to ranked opponents, missing out on a third straight trip to the national tourney.

Bowers was voted Third Team All-America and First Team All-MSA honors while Taliah Moore and Julia Fox each garnered Second Team All-League accolades.

Before becoming the women's head coach, Lewis served four seasons as a full-time assistant for coach Lonnie Thompson and the CU men's team. His roles included scouting, recruiting, film exchange and budgeting, as well as monitoring the student-athletes' progress both on and off the court. His main responsibilities included developing the team's wing and guard positions, composing scouting reports for game preparation and recruiting incoming student-athletes. During his four seasons as an assistant coach, the Phoenix compiled a 68-56 overall mark, including 46-18 in the final two seasons with consecutive trips to the NAIA National Tournament in 2008 and 2009.

Lewis spent three seasons as the starting point guard at Cumberland from 2002-04 before serving one season as a graduate assistant for the Phoenix women's basketball staff in 2005. As a player he was named Honorable Mention All-Conference as a junior and senior and garnered National Scholar-Athlete and Academic All-Conference accolades as a senior. He was the starting point guard on CU's team that reached the Round of 16 and won the TranSouth Conference regular season championship in 2004.

He graduated from CU in May of 2004 with a bachelor's in Sports Administration and is currently working on his master's in Education Administration.

Lewis prepped at Beech High School in Hendersonville, Tenn., and played one season at Aquinas Community College in Nashville under the tutelage of Hall of Fame coach Charlie Anderson before transferring to Cumberland.
