

LIPSCOMB ATHLETICS COMPLIANCE PROGRAM ON-CAMPUS/OFF-CAMPUS HOUSING PROCEDURES AND FORM FOR FULL SCHOLARSHIP STUDENT-ATHLETES

For those student-athletes that choose to live **off-campus*** and are receiving a full scholarship (tuition, fees, room, board, required course-related books) of all gift aid combined (institutional -- athletic, academic, etc.; outside aid -- Pell, state grant, HOPE, etc.), you can have tuition, fees, required course-related books and a mid-level on-campus meal plan (i.e., Herd) covered by your scholarships. You will not have an on-campus room covered and you will not have a stipend to help cover your off-campus living arrangements. In addition, **if you live off-campus and qualify for a Pell Grant, you will not be able to receive a Pell Grant refund.**

* To be eligible to live off-campus, a student must meet the requirements set forth in the Lipscomb Student Handbook and receive clearance from the Dean of Students office

For those student-athletes that choose to live **on-campus** and are receiving a full scholarship (tuition, fees, room board, required course-related books) of all gift aid combined (institutional -- athletic, academic, etc.; outside aid -- Pell, state grant, HOPE, etc.), you can have tuition, fees, required course-related books, on-campus room, and a mid-level on-campus meal plan (i.e., Herd) plus \$125 Flex covered by your scholarships. Also, **if you live on-campus and qualify for a Pell Grant, you will be able to receive a Pell Grant refund.** In addition, **you must follow the on-campus definition (stated below) to receive that Pell Grant refund.**

A qualified** on-campus student is defined, for financial aid purposes only, as one who spends the majority of official class days (excluding weekends) overnight in university-provided housing and keeps his/her personal effects (clothing, shoes, toiletries, bedding, etc.) in this university-provided room. In emergency situations, exceptions to this definition can be made when a student is required to stay with a parent or grandparent due to a family illness or necessary work requirements. Head Residents, with the assistance of RAs, will validate that a qualifying student meets the definition of "on-campus."

**a student who has total gift aid (both institutional and outside aid) exceeding on-campus cost of attendance.
