Your role as a STUDENT HOST is very important in the recruiting process of our university athletic teams. You have a responsibility to understand and abide by the NCAA, (13.7.5.5) and institutional regulations. Please carefully **review** the following rules:

1. Only one student-athlete per day from our school can serve as official host. If you are a freshman, you must have been a high school qualifier. Other students may assist with hosting the prospect but shall pay for their own entertainment and meals.
2. It is important to note that all Lipscomb University rules listed in the Student Handbook concerning alcohol, drugs, gambling, sex and criminal activity apply when serving as a student host on an official visit.
3. A maximum of \$30 each day of the visit may be provided to cover all actual costs of entertaining yourself, the prospect (and the prospect's parents, legal guardians or spouse), excluding the cost of meals and admission to campus athletic events. These funds may not be used for the purchase of souvenirs such as T-shirts or other institutional mementos. It is permissible to provide the student host with an additional \$15 per day for each additional prospect the host entertains. **All student host entertainment money receipts must be retained and submitted to your head coach at the end of the visit. Also, any unused student host money must be returned to the head coach.**
4. No cash may be given to the visiting prospect or anyone else.
5. You may not use vehicles provided or arranged for by any coach, institutional staff member or booster of the university. **Never** allow the recruit to use or drive your car.
6. You may not transport the prospect or anyone accompanying the prospect more than 30 miles from campus.
7. You should not allow recruiting conversations to occur off campus between the prospect and a booster of the athletic program. (If an unplanned meeting occurs, only an exchange of greeting is permissible.)
8. A visiting prospect may engage in recreational or workout activities as long as the activity does not include the sport for which the prospect is being recruited. A coach cannot be present during such activities.
9. You may receive a complimentary admission (no hard tickets) when accompanying a prospect to an athletic event.
