#### Bison news and notes

- The Bisons are in the semifinal round for the third time in program history. LU is 0-3 in the semifinal round, looking for its first win Friday.
- The Bisons enter Atlantic Sun Conference Tournament play for the sixth consecutive year, the active leader in the conference. Mercer is next with five straight appearances.
- The Bisons have never faced Florida Gulf Coast in the A-Sun Championships.
- In regular season play, the Bisons handed the Eagles their only loss in the A-Sun season.
- The loss was just the second for the Eagles in three years of Atlantic Sun play. FGCU has accumulated 22-2-1 record in its three year run as league champs.
- Sophomore Omar Djabi garnered Second Team All-Conference from the league coaches released on Tuesday.
- Freshman Reece Holcombe picked up the only unanimous selection for the All-Freshman team released Tuesday.
- Senior Ethan Summers and sophomore Robbie Johnson earned All-Academic A-Sun honors for the combination of grades and play on the field. Summers owns a 3.63 GPA while Johnson has a 3.74 GPA.
- Reece Holcombe, Omar Djabi and Jeremy Reid all picked up Atlantic Sun Second Team honors from CollegeSportsMadness.com.
- Seniors Ethan Summers is the active leader in the Atlantic Sun with 77 games played. With a start on Wednesday, Summers will have started 73 games, placing him 4th all-time in the A-Sun.
- Fellow senior Jeremy Reid has played in 73 games, ranking him right up with Summers in the active leader category.
- Sophomore defender Omar Djabi was chosen by topdrawersoccer.com as a preseason Top-20 player to watch in the Atlantic Sun this season. Last year, Djabi was selected to the A-Sun All-Freshman team.
- The Bisons have had two five-point weekends this season, one each from senior Ethan Summers and freshman Reece Holcombe. Summers feat included his first career goal and game-winner while Holcombe's included his first multi-goal game.
- Summers earned Atlantic Sun Defensive Player of the Week after his five-point weekend which included an assist against Elon and two goals in the overtime victory against Oral Roberts.
- The Bisons took second place at the University of Central Arkansas Invite with Ethan Summers and Omar Djabi taking home All-Tournament Honors.
- In their home Hyatt Place Select/Lipscomb Invite, Ethan Summers, Jeremy Reid and Omar Djabi were named to the All-Tournament team.
- In the final early season tournament at Belmont, Ethan Summers earned his third trip to an All-Tournament team while Robbie Johnson picked up his first honor.
- Lipscomb was chosen to finish fifth in the Preseason Coach's Poll. ETSU was chosen as the league favorite. The coach's were correct on the Bisons pick. However FGCU was the winner, Mercer second and ETSU came in third.

**Head Coach: Charles Morrow**

A Lipscomb graduate himself, men's soccer head coach Charles Morrow has been a long-time stalwart around the Nashville soccer scene, first as a player during the Bison's NAIA days and now as a coach on the Division I level. He enters his eighth season as the head coach of the Lipscomb Bisons men's soccer team with lofty expectations for his program to break through and make its first NCAA Tournament.

Morrow arrived on Lipscomb's campus first in 1994 as a transfer after starting his collegiate career at DII power Queens College. From 1994-96, Morrow would be part of the Bison squad, serving as a captain during his tenure as a player.

After his playing career ended, Morrow stayed on as an assistant from 1996-97, graduating in 1997 with a degree in physical education and health.

In 2006, Morrow would go on to earn his Master's Degree in Sports Science from the United States Sports Academy in Daphne, Ala. Upon graduating from Lipscomb in 1997, Morrow took over head coaching duties for both the boys and girls squads at Goodpasture High School, where he stayed until 2000. His boys teams reached the regional semifinals in both 1999 and 2000.

Morrow returned to the collegiate ranks in 2000 when he accepted an assistant coaching position with Vanderbilt. He remained with the Commodores until 2003.

He left Vanderbilt to take on his first collegiate head coaching job at Belmont Abbey College in Belmont, N.C. in April, 2003. In two seasons with the Crusaders, Morrow directed the DII squad to conference runner-up honors in the regular season and conference tournament.

In 2005, Morrow accepted the head coaching job at his alma mater. In his first season back on the sidelines at Lipscomb, Morrow's charges secured five victories, more than doubling the total from the previous two seasons and earning one of the top turnarounds in the NCAA. It was the first of two occasions Morrow would lead a squad to one of the NCAA's biggest turnarounds from season-to-season.

Overall, Morrow has amassed a record of 46-73-15, including a 23-29-7 mark in Atlantic Sun play.

During Morrow's tenure, 12 Bisons have earned all-conference honors, including five first-teamers (Garret Pettis twice, Miguel DaSilva twice, and Ben Page). DaSilva was a three-time all-tournament performer, and all-freshman in 2007. As a senior, DaSilva became Lipscomb's first NSCAA All-Region performer.

Under Morrow, Pettis became the Bisons first-ever A-Sun Freshman of the Year in 2008.

In the classroom, 59 Bisons have been named Atlantic Sun All-Academic since Morrow took over, including 17 from the 2011 squad.

Off the pitch, Morrow and his squad active in the community, primarily through YES (Youth Encouragement Services). The coaches and players offer instruction to players and coaches in six-week fall and spring youth leagues.

Morrow is married to the former Beth Earnest of Nashville. She is also employed by Lipscomb University with the Institute of Law, Justice & Society. The couple has two sons, Trip and Will.

• Reece Holcombe ranks eighth in the A-Sun with 4 goals scored. David Geno of ETSU leads the league with 11 goals.

• Jeremy Reid ranks seventh in the A-Sun with four assists on the season. Ryan King of Mercer leads the league with eight assists.

• John Schnurbusch ranks sixth in the A-Sun with a 1.23 goals against average. Miguel Hof ranks ninth with a 1.79 goals against average.

• John Schnurbusch ranks seventh in the A-Sun with a .714 save percentage. Greg Ranjitsingh leads the league, saving .835 percent of shots.
