Last time out: Over the last weekend of play, Lipscomb played to a 0-0 draw against Mercer and a 3-2 loss to Kennesaw State. Goalkeeper Erin Zerio stopped all eight shots that came her way for her fourth shutout on the season and ninth in her career. In the 3-2 loss to Kennesaw State, the Lady Bisons fell in an early 3-0 hole before fighting back. Sophomore Brittany Ruppel connected on two penalty kicks and senior Andie Thornton missed just inches to the right, to tie the game.

Scouting the Spartans: USC Upstate enters Friday's match 2-12-0 overall and 0-5-0 in A-Sun play. Playing their travel partner last weekend, ETSU, the Spartans fell 3-0. Michelle Calmeyn leads Upstate with three points, having scored a goal and dished an assist. Goalkeeper Sarah Plantz has played in and started in 13 games accumulating an A-Sun high 90 saves. Plantz has a 2.96 goals against average and a .698 save percentage.

Scouting the Bucs: ETSU enters the weekend 9-4-0 overall and 3-2 in conference play, holding the sixth and final spot for the A-Sun Conference Tournament. The Buccaneer offense revolves around Kerns as she has set an ETSU single-season record with 33 points. The conference leader with 15 goals on 57 shots, Kerns has also added three assists. Sarah Zadrazil is second on the team with 16 points, scoring four goals and assisting on eight goals.

Head Coach Kevin O'Brien

Kevin O'Brien was named the head coach of the Lipscomb women's soccer program in February 2012. O'Brien is the third women's coach of the NCAA Division I era at Lipscomb.

O'Brien is excited for the opportunities at Lipscomb.

"I'm overjoyed to be joining the Lipscomb family," O'Brien said. "I am grateful to Philip Hutcheson and the search committee for putting their trust in me as their coach. I believe the future is bright for the Lady Bison soccer program and I am honored that I was chosen to lead these young women into a prosperous new era.

"Building a program that will have a lasting impact and reputation in women's soccer is a process that will take some time. It will take strong tactical coaching and player development initially, along with a transformation of the culture and expectations within the program, all the while creating a competitive and deep squad through recruiting".

This is O'Brien's first head coaching job. He had been the associate head coach and recruiting coordinator of the men's soccer program at Davidson College since 2009 and has shown to be not only a strong coach, but savvy recruiter as well. He assembled a top-notch recruiting class in 2011, including three players ranked in the top 150 nationally by College Soccer News.

On the field, O'Brien was part of Davidson's staff that led the Wildcats to upset three top-25 programs in the past three seasons, including a victory against the National Champion North Carolina Tar Heels last season. Both the 2009 and 2010 squads were ranked in the National Top 25 at one point in their respective seasons.

Prior to joining the staff at Davidson, O'Brien served as the top assistant and recruiting coordinator with another NSCAA Top 25 program - the Charlotte 49ers. The 49ers were NCAA College Cup finalists in 2011, with seven of eleven starters being recruited by Coach O'Brien in his time with the program.

In his playing days, O'Brien led College of Charleston to two NCAA post season appearances, multiple top-20 rankings, the Elite 8 and was a two-time All-Conference selection and All-South Region player. Following his collegiate career, he played professionally (USL) for 8 years with the Charleston Battery and Charlotte Eagles.

As an assistant at the college level, O'Brien has also worked at Creighton, Oregon State and Presbyterian College.

O'Brien holds a USSF "A" License and the NSCAA Advanced National Diploma. He spent several years coaching in the North Carolina Olympic Development Program and won a national championship in 2006.

The new head coach is eager to get started on building the Lipscomb women's program.

"My vision for the women's soccer program at Lipscomb University is to pursue excellence," O'Brien said. "If we strive for excellence in all we do and pursue it with a passion on the field, in the classroom and around town we will reap the successes that accompany this vision."

He married his wife, Shannon, a former University of Arizona women's soccer player, in 2003. Shannon played professionally for the Charlotte Lady Eagles. They have a 5-year old daughter, Keely and a 2-year son, Keegan.
