About the Game

Today's game is the first of back-to-back contests for the Hatters against Tennessee State ... Stetson and TSU will meet in DeLand on Dec. 14, after Stetson's break for final exams ... this is the first of two trips to Nashville for the Hatters, as Stetson will visit Atlantic Sun Conference foe Lipscomb on Jan. 21 ... Tennessee State assistant coach Pierre Jordan played for Stetson head coach **Corey Williams** when Williams was an assistant at Florida State (2008-11).

The Series

Today's game is the first meeting between Stetson and Tennessee State.

The Coaches

Stetson's **Corey Williams** is in his third season with the Hatters. The 21st head coach in school history, Williams is 19-51 at Stetson. The former Florida State and Oral Roberts assistant coach was a standout at Oklahoma State, and spent parts of two seasons as a player in the NBA with the Chicago Bulls and Minnesota Timberwolves. He was a member of Chicago's 1993 NBA championship squad.

Tennessee State's Dana Ford is 9-28 in his second season with the Tigers.

Last Time Out

Stetson placed four players in double-figures but the Hatters couldn't overcome a clutch-shooting UCF squad in a 94-85 setback, Wednesday at Edmunds Center.

UCF (2-3) built as much as a 12-point lead in the second half before the Hatters battled back. Down 67-55 with 8:31 to go, Stetson (3-5) clawed back in the game behind the play of **Grant Lozoya** and **Derick Newton**. The duo combined to score 13 points during a 21-10 run, as Stetson pulled to within 77-76 on a layup by Newton with 3:17 left.

But the Knights responded with a series of big shots, including a pair of three-pointers by Chance McSpadden, the last of which gave UCF an 86-80 lead with 1:25 to play.

The Hatters cut the deficit to five points when a pair of Newton free throws made it 90-85 with 10 seconds to play, but Stetson's comeback bid ran out of time.

Stetson controlled play for much of the first half, leading by as many as eight points when Newton drilled a three-pointer to make it 28-20. But after making 12 of their first 18 shots, the Hatters missed their next six attempts and UCF pulled to within 28-27.

The Knights eventually gained the lead in

the final moments of the half and led 39-38 at the break.

Stetson shot 45 percent for the game and committed just five turnovers but the Hatters struggled to defend the much-larger Knights. UCF's 7-foot-6 freshman Tacko Fall dominated the paint, scoring 23 points on 11-of-12 shooting. McSpadden scored 21, doing most of his damage from the perimeter. UCF also owned a 44-29 rebounding advantage.

Lozoya led the Hatters with 20 points on 8-of-12 shooting. Newton finished with 17, while **Brian Pegg** added 13 and a team-high eight rebounds. **Leo Goodman** scored a season-high 15 off the bench.

What a Difference a Year Makes

Stetson's offensive improvement since last year has been nothing short of stunning. A year ago, the Hatters averaged less than 67 points per game (66.6). Entering Saturday's game at Tennessee State, the Hatters are second in the A-Sun in scoring at nearly 83 points (82.9) per game, a figure which ranks 47th nationally.

The Young Get Younger

Last season, Stetson was one of the youngest teams in the country when they opened the season with seven scholarship freshmen. Flash forward 12 months and the Hatters are at it again as the 2015-16 version features a roster sans seniors. Stetson is one of just eight teams with no seniors. The others are Fairleigh Dickinson, LIU-Brooklyn, New Mexico State, Niagara, Northern Colorado, Providence and St. Mary's. the junior trio of **Brian Pegg**, **B.J. Glasford** (injured and yet to play this season), and **Cameron Harvey** have combined to play in 200 games while making a total of 74 starts. The rest of the roster has appeared in just 183 games, and that total includes 28 games played by sophomore **Luke Doyle** two years ago at Nicholls State.

for the first time this season and the second time in his career ... **Ty Cockfield** scored nine points after going scoreless in each of the last two games ... **Brian Pegg** scored in double figures for the seventh time in eight games ... the Hatters made nine three-pointers against the Knights on Wednesday and have made at least one 3-point field in each of the last 353 games. Stetson's last game without a trey was against Colorado State on Dec. 28, 2004.

Hatters Picked 7th in A-Sun Preseason Poll

North Florida enters the 2015-16 Atlantic Sun Men's Basketball season as the favorites to repeat after garnering first place in both pre-season coaches' and media polls, announced Thursday by the league office.

The defending regular season and tournament champions secured seven of the eight first place votes in the coaches' poll, while picking up 24 of the 31 first place votes in the media poll. FGCU came in second in both polls, as the Eagles collected the final first place vote in the coaches' poll and six first place nods in the media poll. League newcomer NJIT earned the final first place vote in the media poll.

NJIT and Lipscomb split third and fourth place in each poll, with the Highlanders picked third in the coaches poll and the Bisons picked third in the media poll. Jacksonville and USC Upstate followed in fifth and sixth in the coaches' poll. Kennesaw State and

Stetson were tied for seventh to round out the selections by the league's head coaches. In the media poll, the Spartans and Dolphins flipped positions, with KSU coming in seventh and Stetson eighth.

Hatters Ruled Eligible for A-Sun Tourney

Stetson Men's Basketball learned in early October that the Atlantic Sun Conference Presidents' Council granted the program partial relief from conference sanctions for the upcoming season through the conference appeal process. Earlier this year, Stetson received national sanctions, including a ban from the 2016 NCAA Men's Basketball Championship, for missing the NCAA academic performance rating (APR) standards by one point.

The decision by the Council permits the Hatters to play in the 2016 A-Sun Men's Basketball Championship in March. Stetson will realize a reduced conference revenue distribution for 2015-16, all of which will be invested directly in its new Leadership and Mentoring Program designed in-part to address student-athlete retention issues.

Stetson faced NCAA sanctions after falling one point below the APR postseason qualification threshold when an NCAA audit resulted in a change to 2012 calculated results. The one point change, in combination with Stetson voluntarily having permitted men's basketball student-athletes to depart in the interim - all of whom are making satisfactory progress towards degree completion at other

ESPN3 to Carry All Home Games

Stetson Athletics continues a new and exciting chapter this season as every regular season men's basketball home game will be carried live on ESPN3.

The Hatters will also continue their strong radio relationship with WSBB AM 1230/1490, with every game being carried on the Stetson Sports Network.

Stetson will produce and broadcast each event through its own Stetson Video Productions, under the guidance Director of Broadcasting Jeff Taylor. Games will be streamed on the Watch ESPN app and at WatchESPN.com.

Stetson's association comes about in part due to the Atlantic Sun Conference's E3 Initiative, which requires all member schools to broadcast every home men's and women's basketball game, which began with the 2014-15 season. Stetson is committed to expand upon that initiative and will eventually produce approximately 100 athletics and university events per year. Over 50 events are scheduled for the 2015-16 year.

Daytona Tortugas play-by-play man Tyler Murray begins his first season as the television voice of Stetson men's basketball. He'll be joined on broadcasts by Evan Weston, who also calls men's and women's soccer game on HatterVision and serves as part of the broadcast team for all Stetson football games on ESPN3.

All Games to be Broadcast on WSBB

In addition to home games on ESPN3, fans can also listen to WSBB on-line at MyAM1230.com or on a mobile device with the WSBB app available for Apple and Android.

Luke Mauro begins his second season as the radio voice of the Hatters. Mauro, who is also Stetson football's radio play-by-play broadcaster, served this past season as the radio voice of the Double-A Binghamton Mets. He'll be joined on home broadcasts by veteran broadcaster and former Auburn basketball standout Greg Turner.

Hatters Add Clay Verk for 2016-17

Clay Verk (Highlands Ranch, Colo.) signed a National Letter-of-Intent with Stetson Men's Basketball during the Early Signing Period.

Verk, who will be a freshman for the Hatters in 2016, is a 6-8, 250-pound forward at ThunderRidge High School in suburban Denver. The Grizzlies were the 2015 5A state run-

ner up.

Verk averaged 6.1 points and 3.4 rebounds per game as a junior while shooting 55 percent from the field. He served as a backup to two-time All-State selection Zach Pirog, currently a freshman at Nebraska-Omaha. Despite his reserve status, Verk scored in double figures seven times as a junior, with a high of 13 points against Douglas County.

About Stetson

Stetson University is located in DeLand, Fla., with a second campus in Gulfport, Fla. and two satellite centers. Founded in 1883 by Henry A. DeLand as the DeLand Academy and later renamed Stetson University to honor its benefactor, John B. Stetson, the university has a storied history of leadership, values and significance. The university is home to many Florida firsts, including the first collegiate newspaper, the oldest schools of business administration and music, the first college of law and was the state's first private university to integrate.

Stetson is home to 73 academic programs in four divisional areas and with undergraduate and graduate studies offered in many areas. The university is accredited by numerous accrediting agencies, including the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges, and curriculum is closely aligned with the marketplace to prepare students for life after Stetson.

Notable athletic alums include 2014 American League Cy Young Award winner Corey Kluber; 2014 National League Rookie of the Year Jacob deGrom; former NBA forward Lorenzo Williams; Atlanta Braves third baseman Chris Johnson; Ray Finkle, former Miami Dolphins kicker and later a police chief in Miami; Atlanta Falcons President & CEO Rich McKay; college basketball Hall of Fame inductee Dr. Glenn Wilkes; and ESPN reporter Britt McHenry.

Some of the more notable non-athletic alums include former actor Ted Cassidy, who played Lurch the Butler in TV's The Addams Family; composer Gerard Marino; 1960s country singer Wilma Burgess; and former Marine Corps General Roy Geiger.

HEAD COACH COREY WILLIAMS



With an NBA championship and nine NCAA Tournaments as both a player and coach on his resume, Corey Williams knows what it takes to be a winner. He also knows that it doesn't happen overnight.

Named the 21st head coach in program history on June 3, 2013 -- less than 10 weeks before the start of the school year -- Williams guided Stetson to a 7-24 record in his first season with the Hatters.

In his second season roaming the sidelines at the Edmunds Center, Williams guided one

of the youngest teams in the country to a second straight Atlantic Sun Conference Tournament appearance. With a lineup regularly featuring two or even three freshmen, Williams kept the Hatters competitive throughout the 2014-15 season while also laying the foundation for a strong future.

The young talent last season was evident. Guards Grant Lozoya and Divine Myles earned spots on the A-Sun's All-Freshmen teams, while fellow freshman Angel Rivera set the program's record for assists by a freshman with 120. He and Myles also became the first teammates, regardless of class, to each record 100 assists in the same season.

After opening his rookie coaching season with eight consecutive games away from home, Williams earned his first career head coaching victory with a 56-52 win over Volusia County rival Bethune-Cookman on Dec. 3, 2013 in DeLand.

Williams has been blessed throughout his basketball playing and coaching career to be surrounded by and learn from some of the finest minds in the game, including Phil Jackson, Eddie Sutton, Bill Self and Leonard Hamilton.

A native of Macon, Ga., Williams played point guard at Oklahoma State. He had a lengthy career as a professional player, spending his rookie season in the NBA with the Chicago Bulls where he was a part of the 1993 NBA Championship team, before starting his coaching career.

"I'm excited," Williams said at the press conference announcing his hire. "To be able to lead this program means an awful lot to me and my family. I knew back when I first started out in this profession that my ambition was always to be a head coach. For Stetson University to give me this opportunity, I'm very grateful. I'm humbled, I'm grateful."

"Stetson University is privileged to be able to call Corey Williams our new men's basketball head coach," Stetson Director of Athletics Jeff Altier said that day. "Corey is a winner, he has worked with and played for some of the finest minds in the world of basketball and as such he understands the discipline, commitment and strategy that is needed to be successful. Everywhere Corey has played or coached his teams have won and won big, and I am excited to have him as a part of the Stetson team."

Prior to taking the reigns at Stetson, Williams spent six seasons as an assistant at Florida State. His career with the Seminoles coincided with the team's winningest five-year period, beginning in 2007-08. During this time the team won its first ACC Championship, enjoyed a school-record run of four straight NCAA Tournament appearances, four consecutive years of double digit wins in ACC play, produced five NBA Draft picks, recorded 16 wins over nationally ranked teams and appeared in the national rankings in four straight seasons.

Williams assisted in the development of the Seminoles into one of the best programs in the ACC with the perseverance that has also made him one of the nation's top recruiters. He was instrumental in Florida State's run to the 2011 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 as well as the 2012 ACC Championship.

Before joining the Florida State staff, Williams was an assistant coach for seven seasons at Oral Roberts where he aided the Golden Eagles in achieving an average of 18 wins per season, including 20 or more wins in each of his last three seasons in Tulsa. ORU captured the Mid-Continent Conference regular season and tournament titles in 2006 and 2007, advancing to play in the NCAA Tournament each season. The 2006-07 squad not only finished with a 23-11 record, but the Golden Eagles also stunned the college basketball world when they defeated then-No. 3 Kansas, 78-71, in an early-season game at legendary Allen Fieldhouse.

Williams played collegiately at Oklahoma State from 1989-1992. He finished his career eighth on OSU's career scoring charts with 1,320 points. During his collegiate playing career he helped lead the Cowboys to consecutive NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 appearances under Coach Eddie Sutton in 1991 and 1992. The Cowboys were ranked 14th in the final Associated Press poll of the 1991 season and 10th in the final coaches' poll following the 1992 season. With Williams in Oklahoma State's line-up for 128 games during his four-year varsity career, the Cowboys ranked as one of the top teams statistically in the nation.

Following the conclusion of his collegiate career, Williams was a 2nd-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls, but that wasn't his only professional opportunity. Despite having not played football since junior high, the Kansas City Chiefs selected Williams in the 12th round of the 1992 NFL Draft. He was the only OSU Cowboy drafted that year.

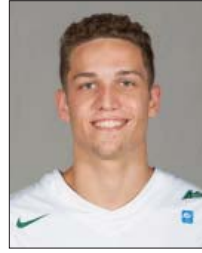
As a rookie in the NBA, Williams was a member of the Michael Jordan-led Bulls as the franchise captured its third straight NBA title. Following his one season in Chicago, Williams played parts of the next season with the Minnesota Timberwolves, while also playing for the Oklahoma City Cavalry of the CBA. He returned to Oklahoma State as a student assistant in 1994, serving as a member of the Cowboys' staff during their 1994 Final Four campaign. Williams then played and coached professionally in Taiwan, from 1995-98.

Williams, 45, earned his bachelor's degree in education from Oklahoma State in 2002. He and his wife, Nicole, have two children: Jourdan (16) and Corey, Jr. (12).
