Next Up in Crusader Baseball: The Valparaiso University baseball team will welcome the Missouri Valley Conference preseason favorites to Emory G. Bauer Field this weekend for a three-game conference series. Dallas Baptist has won seven of its nine MVC affairs after hauling in seven of the eight first-place votes in the preseason coaches poll. This marks the first of two straight home weekends where Valpo will host programs with proud baseball traditions, as DBU and Missouri State – both teams that played in the NCAA Tournament a year ago – come to town for the first time.

Last Time Out: ACC foe Notre Dame edged Valpo 6-5 in a midweek matchup at Frank Eck Stadium in Notre Dame, Ind. on Wednesday. The Crusaders gave the Fighting Irish a late push by scoring two runs in the seventh and two more in the ninth, but Notre Dame held on to prevail 6-5 as the visitors left the potential tying run stranded at second base in the top of the ninth. Zack Leone had three doubles, Sam Shaikin ripped two extra-base knocks including a home run and Chet Joslyn tossed 2 1/3 innings of scoreless relief.

On the Air: All three games in the series will air on 95.1 FM Valparaiso, WVUR. Ben Ariano will narrate the play-by-play story throughout the series. The broadcast is also available online via the TuneIn Radio app. Follow @ValpoBaseball for in-game updates. Links to live audio and stats (StatBroadcast) will be available on ValpoAthletics.com.

Series Notes: The Patriots will make their first ever trip to Valparaiso this weekend. All four all-time meetings between the two teams prior to this series occurred in 2016, when host DBU took three of four. Dallas Baptist entered that series ranked 25th nationally. The Crusaders won 6-1 in the third game of the set, a contest that two current Crusaders participated in – Scott Kapers (2-for-4, 2 RBIs) and Chase Dawson (1-for-4).

Almost Only Counts in Horseshoes & Hand Grenades: The Crusaders incurred their 10th one-run loss of the season on Wednesday at Notre Dame. Nine of the 10 setbacks have come on the road for a team that has played 85.7 percent of its schedule away from Emory G. Bauer Field. The Crusaders are just 1-10 in one-run decisions with the lone win coming 7-6 over Michigan State in the second game of a doubleheader on April 13.

Six is the Magic Number: Valpo is just 1-18 this season when scoring five runs or fewer. When the Crusaders score six runs or more, they own a 13-3 mark. The only time Valpo came away with a win without reaching the six-run plateau was on March 30 vs. Bradley, a 5-2, 10-inning win. Furthermore, Valpo is 0-11 when scoring fewer than five runs.

The Race to One: Scoring first has been critical for the Crusaders this season. They are just 1-15 when the opposition plates the first run of the game, but own a 13-6 record when they strike first.

Two-Bagger, Three Times: Zack Leone enjoyed a three-double game on Wednesday at Notre Dame, becoming the second Valpo player with three doubles in one game this season, joining Blake Billinger (March 2 vs. CSUN). Only three players in the entire Missouri Valley Conference have had three-double games this season, and two of them play for the Crusaders. No Valpo player had posted a three-double game since Andrew

Quinnette on April 26, 2008 against Butler prior to this season.

Birthday Boy: Valpo first baseman Zack Leone will enjoy his 23rd birthday on Friday. He'll look to celebrate by adding to his already-impressive .396 batting average that leads the Missouri Valley Conference.

Garbella Gains MVC Recognition: Valpo outfielder Giovanni Garbella was selected as a Missouri Valley Conference Scholar-Athlete of the Week, presented by Enterprise Bank and Trust Company, for his performance in both the classroom last week. Garbella, a finance major, had seven hits in 15 at-bats (.467) while ripping a double and a homer as Valpo took three of four during the week. He drove in six runs in four games and played a key role as Valpo knocked off No. 25 Illinois last Tuesday and then won its first Missouri Valley Conference series since joining the league over the weekend at Evansville. Garbella became the first Valpo male athlete in any sport to capture MVC Scholar-Athlete of the Week honors. He joins a pair of Crusaders who won the MVC Female Scholar-Athlete of the Week award during the winter season – women's basketball players Dani Franklin and Meredith Hamlet.

Welcome to the Watch List: Valpo shortstop Sam Shaikin was named to the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List, which was announced by the College Baseball Foundation late last week. The honor puts Shaikin in elite company, a group of 53 of the most talented athletes in Division I college baseball. The award honors the nation's top shortstop and will be presented this summer. The award is named after former Texas Tech shortstop Brooks Wallace, who played for the Red Raiders from 1977-1980. Wallace died of leukemia at the age of 27. Shaikin is one of five MVC shortstops on the list, joining Missouri State's Jeremy Eierman, DBU's Jimmy Glowenke, Southern Illinois' Connor Kopach and Illinois State's Owen Miller. The Missouri Valley Conference trails only the ACC (9) and the SEC (8) in number of players on the watch list.

Early Offense: Valpo had scored a first-inning run in five straight games before Wednesday's contest at Notre Dame. Last week, the Crusaders made early exits for opposing hurlers a trend. They bounced Illinois' starter from the game before he recorded an out and scored four earned runs against him last Tuesday. In the weekend series, Evansville's starters lasted 3 2/3 innings, one inning and 1/3 of an inning against the Valpo offense. Opposing starting pitchers worked five total innings and had a 28.80 ERA against Valpo last week.

Providing Relief: Valpo senior Hayden Kissee had a strong week out of the Valpo bullpen. First, he worked two scoreless frames to gain the win against nationally-ranked Illinois last Tuesday, his first victory of the season. Then, the right-hander worked out of a challenging jam after inheriting two baserunners with nobody out in the seventh inning in Sunday's 6-1 win over Evansville. Kissee induced a double play, got out of the inning with a shallow fly ball and went on to pitch three scoreless frames to close out Valpo's first conference series win since joining the MVC. Kissee was awarded his first save of the season.

In The Other Dugout – Dallas Baptist: The Patriots come to Emory G. Bauer Field winners of each of their last eight weekend series. Their eight straight weekend series wins are their most since becoming a Division I program in 2004. Dallas Baptist has made seven NCAA Regional appearances in the last 10 years, produced 14 All-Americans since 2005 and 10 Freshman All-Americans since 2007. The Patriots have had 43 draft picks in Dan Heefner's 10 years as head coach. They are one of only 18 teams nationally to have advanced to the NCAA Tournament in at least six of the last seven years. This game will feature the top two hitters in the Missouri Valley Conference in terms of batting average, as Devlin Granberg (.392) enters the weekend four points behind Leone. Granberg holds the conference lead in both slugging percentage at .615 (13 points ahead of second-place Garbella) and on-base percentage at .511 (11 points ahead of Leone). Jameson Hannah is the league leader in runs scored with 45. Entering this weekend, players in the DBU-Valpo series account for the individual conference leaders in the following offensive categories – batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, runs scored, doubles, triples, home runs and bases on balls. Dallas Baptist plays its home games at Horner Ballpark, a venue that has been ranked among the best in collegiate baseball by multiple media outlets. The Crusaders will make their way to Dallas next month as the Patriots host the MVC Tournament.

Pitching Profiles – Weekend Rotation

- **Jon Tieman:** Freshman All-American last season... Started his freshman year as Valpo's closer before moving into the weekend rotation by season's end... Became the first Valpo underclassman to get the Opening Day start for the Crusaders since Bryce Shafer in 2009. Six of Valpo's last seven Opening Day starters had been seniors before Tieman got the ball at Alabama this season... Got the win on March 16 at Arkansas Pine Bluff after throwing eight innings and allowing seven runs (five earned) on 10 hits. The most impressive aspect of his start was that he struck out seven and issued no walks. The Crusaders didn't allow any walks in that game, the first time they'd done that since April 23 of last season... One of his strongest starts of the season was when he pitched Valpo to a 9-2 win over the school's instate rival Butler on March 23. He yielded two runs on seven hits and one walk while striking out four in 7 1/3 innings. Tieman did not allow a run over the first seven innings and both runs charged to him scored after he had left the game. He sent down 11 straight batters from the third to the sixth. Tieman's outing came against Big East foe Butler, a team that entered that game with a 16-3 record... Has allowed two walks or fewer in each of his last six starts... In the conference opener vs. Bradley, he left in position for the win but wound up with no decision after allowing three runs (two earned) on eight hits and two walks in seven innings... Has lasted seven innings or more in each of his last six starts... Took the loss after allowing six runs (three earned) in 7 1/3 innings on April 6 at Southern Illinois... Got no decision despite eight strong innings at Michigan State on April 13... Threw his first career complete game in a 7-2 win over Evansville on April 20. Scattered nine hits and permitted only two earned runs while racking up a season-high eight strikeouts. Earned his fourth win of the year, matching his season win total from his rookie campaign. The CG marked the third by a Valpo pitcher this season, all in the last three weeks.

- **Trey Ferketic:** Valpo is his fourth school (Saddleback, Long Beach State, UC San Diego)... Didn't pitch last spring due to an injury and threw just 3 2/3 innings at UC San Diego in 2016... Has allowed just 36 hits in 40 2/3 innings... Went seven innings and allowed two runs on five hits and one walk on March 30 against Bradley, a game Valpo eventually won in 10 innings. He received no decision... Became the first Valpo player this season to throw a complete game in a 6-2 win over Southern Illinois on April 7. He threw 130 pitches... Followed that up with another complete game to help the Crusaders over Michigan State 7-6 on April 13... Was lifted after 5 2/3 innings on April 21 at Evansville and got no decision in an eventual 9-8 defeat.

- **Wes Gordon:** Pitched in nine games, all starts, in his first year as a Crusader last season after transferring from Lake County (JUCO), but didn't appear after April 14 due to an injury... Has issued only five walks in 34 2/3 innings this season... Left in position for the win in his first conference start, scattering seven hits and yielding two runs (one earned)

while walking none in seven innings on April 1 against Bradley, but eventually received no decision... Worked four scoreless innings but was charged with five runs in the fifth in his most recent outing April 8 at Southern Illinois... Had a strong outing in his last start, going six strong innings and yielding just one run on seven hits on April 22 at Evansville. Picked up his first victory since April 8, 2017 against Northern Kentucky and limited the opposition to fewer than two runs for the first time since March 24 of last season at UIC.

Player-by-Player Profiles – Position Players

- **Chase Dawson, 2B:** Had already surpassed his career high for RBIs in a single season before conference play even began. Had 15 RBIs in 52 games last season after having 17 in 49 games as a freshman. Hit a grand slam against Arkansas Pine Bluff on March 16... Hit .221 over the first 29 games last season before batting .364 over the final month (April 23 – May 24, 16 games), leading the team in batting average and on-base percentage (.364) during that stretch... Has led off and started at second base for Valpo every game this season... A local to Northwest Indiana as an Andrean High School alum and Chesterton native... Is the first Valpo player with five triples since Kyle Gaedele had eight in 2010... Leads The Valley in triples... Played against former high school teammate and childhood friend Nick Podkul on Wednesday at Notre Dame.

- **Sam Shaikin, SS:** Was the only Crusader to start all 53 games last season. Has started every game this year... Led Valpo in batting average at .317 a year ago... Started at third base for the first 12 games of the season, but has started at shortstop every game since... Has batted second for Valpo in every game this season... Named to the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List by College Baseball Foundation for an award that goes to the top shortstop in the nation... Is the only Crusader to have earned MVC Player of the Week Honors as he did so in the second week of the year, hitting a robust .700 in three games against Oklahoma and Holy Cross... Launched his team-leading seventh home run of the year on Wednesday at Notre Dame, lifting his career total to 11. Also upped his team-high in RBIs to 34, a number that ranks sixth in the conference.

- **Blake Billinger, LF:** Was a unanimous first team all-conference selection in both seasons he played at Mission College (JUCO)... Has batted third in every game this season... Hit a home run against Alabama in his first at-bat as a Crusader... Had a three-double game on March 2 vs. CSUN, becoming the first Valpo player with three doubles in a game since Andrew Quinnette on April 26, 2008 against Butler... Is tied with Missouri State's Jeremy Eierman for the conference lead with 16 doubles... Hit .769 (10-for-13) in a three-game series at Southern Illinois (April 6-8), becoming the first Crusader since 2010 to go 5-for-5 in a game... Belted his third homer of the year on April 17 at Illinois... Leads the team with 17 multi-hit games and seven games with three hits or more.

- **Giovanni Garbella, RF:** Missed nine games with an injury earlier this season... Entered April 9 of last season hitting .213 with no home runs and eight RBIs in 26 games and was a career .204 hitter over three years. He hit .380 the rest of the way with five home runs and 24 RBIs over the final 25 games of the season... Drove in a season-high four runs and launched his fourth homer of the season in Valpo's 6-2 win on April 7 at SIU... Followed that with a home run on April 13 at Michigan State, ripping three extra-base hits and recording the go-ahead RBI in a 7-6 win over the Spartans in the second game of a doubleheader... Had a career-high four hits on April 17 at Illinois... Had a season-high five RBIs, all in his first two plate appearances, in a win over Evansville on April 20. That included his sixth home run of the season and the 13th of his career.

- **Zack Leone, 1B:** Transferred to Valpo this season after having tremendous success from 2014-2017 at Susquehanna, where he was named an All-American by D3Baseball.com and the ABCA... Racked up 178 hits (fourth all-time), a .405

average (second all-time), 112 RBIs (second all-time), 49 doubles (program record), 18 home runs (second all-time), a .470 career OBP and a .641 career slugging percentage in his time at the Division III level... Enters the weekend as The Valley's leading hitter at .396... Had seven RBIs in a game on March 17 at Arkansas Pine Bluff, becoming just the second player in the Missouri Valley Conference with a seven RBI game this season... Of his 26 RBIs, 22 have come with two outs... Returned to the lineup on April 13 at Michigan State after missing the previous four games with a hand injury... Extended his on-base streak to 16 games on April 25 at Notre Dame, matching Billinger for the longest by a Crusader this season... Had three doubles in the April 25 defeat to the Fighting Irish, becoming the second Valpo player this season with a three-double game and just the third player in the entire MVC with three doubles in a contest this year.

- **Chad Jacob, 3B:** Before March 9 at Loyola Marymount, hadn't started a game at third base since his freshman year in 2015, but has started at third every game since, switching positions with SS Sam Shaikin... Has played in every game this season after dealing with various injuries through his first three collegiate campaigns... Leader on Valpo's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee.

- **Scott Kapers, C:** Missed three games this season before returning to the lineup on March 28 at Purdue after starting 52 of 53 games last season... Threw out 41.5 percent of would-be base stealers last year and has upped that to 41.9 percent this year... Batted a team-best .378 over the final 14 games of 2017 and started this season with a .317 average over the first 18 games. Has made tremendous offensive strides since batting .196 as a freshman... Brother Jake, also a catcher, has signed his NLI to play at Valpo starting next season... On the Johnny Bench Award Watch List for an award given annually to the nation's top catcher.

- **DH spot** – Valpo has used four different players at designated hitter and in the eighth spot in the batting order in the past four games – Steven Fitzsimmons, Christian Barczy, Blake Lutgen and Patrick Donohue.

- **Jayden Eggmann, CF:** Has 31 RBIs after having 13 all of last season... Ranks second on the team in RBIs despite batting ninth in the order... Drilled a three-run homer in the ninth inning of an 11-7 victory over Grand Canyon on March 4. The homer was extra special for Eggmann, who started his collegiate career at Grand Canyon and is a native of the Phoenix area... Racked up seven RBIs on April 11 vs. Milwaukee, finishing a double shy of the cycle. Only four players in The Valley have seven RBI games this season, and two of them play for the Crusaders. Also launched a first-inning grand slam in the win over the Panthers.

Top 25 Win: On the exact 55-year anniversary of Valpo's most recent win over Illinois, the Crusaders beat the No. 25 Fighting Illini 11-7 on Tuesday, April 17 in Champagne. It marked just the second time all season Illinois had lost a game by more than three runs. The Crusaders also beat a Top 25 team in 2016, topping No. 25 Dallas Baptist 6-1. Illinois entered the game ranked 25th by Baseball America, 27th in the RPI and 17th by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper. Illinois had won five straight and 22 of its

previous 27. The 11 runs are the most Illinois had given up in a loss all year.

Beating Big Ten Competition: After dropping the first game of a doubleheader at Michigan State in 12 innings on Friday, April 13, Valpo picked up a 7-6 win in the nightcap. This marks the third straight season Valpo has beaten a team from the Big Ten Conference, as the Crusaders knocked off in-state foe Purdue each of the last two years. The Crusaders followed that with the 11-7 win over the Fighting Illini, the fourth Big Ten win Valpo has notched in the last three years and the second in a row.

A Weekend To Remember: The Crusaders picked up several signature wins in the same day on Feb. 24 in Norman, Okla. Valpo upended host Oklahoma, a team ranked 28th nationally, 11-4 in the first game of the day, before routing Holy Cross 20-6. Both Oklahoma and Holy Cross reached the NCAA Tournament last season. The 20 runs in a game were Valpo's most since April 2, 2010 (26 against Chicago State) – a marked that has since been topped with a 23-run outpouring on April 11 vs. Milwaukee. The final game of the weekend in Norman saw the Crusaders take the Sooners to extra innings, but Oklahoma prevailed 3-2.

Ninth Inning Magic: On March 2 against CSUN – a neutral site game at GCU Ballpark in Phoenix – Valpo scored nine times in the top of the ninth to create a 13-13 tie. Chase Dawson capped the miraculous rally with a two-run homer, but CSUN walked off with a run in the bottom of the ninth for a 14-13 victory.

Walk-Off Winner: Valpo reversed the ghosts of years past on March 30 when Zack Leone crushed a three-run, walk-off home run, Valpo's first game-ending long ball in over 15 years. The swing that sent Valpo to a 5-2, 10th inning victory over Bradley for its first Missouri Valley Conference triumph also allowed the team to lay to rest the ghosts of the program's recent past. Three of the Crusaders' first five losses this season came in walk-off fashion, while Valpo has been hurt by walk-off home runs in the past as well – most recently last year's season opener at Western Kentucky and most notably a 2013 NCAA Tournament game against Indiana.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack, the 17th head coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his fifth season at the helm of the Crusaders. He led Valparaiso to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. The former big leaguer followed that up with a 22-win season in 2015, then guided the team to its first winning record since 2013 in 2016. In 2017, Schmack continued his success despite guiding a youthful roster that featured 11 freshmen and 15 total newcomers. He led the Crusaders to 24 wins, including a strong finish to the regular season that saw them win eight of their last 11. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Looking Back: Valpo finished 2017 with a 24-29 record and a 13-15 mark in the Horizon League. Three Crusaders earned all-league freshman team honors, the first time Valpo had three players on the all-freshman team since 2013 and the seventh straight year the Crusaders had multiple players on the all-freshman squad. After posting a 4-1 record, 2.93 ERA and seven saves, right-handed pitcher Jon Tieman was named a Freshman All-American, becoming the first Crusader to earn that high honor since shortstop Spencer Mahoney in 2012. The 2017 season also saw the Crusaders set the program record for team fielding

percentage, as they put together a .971 fielding percentage that bested the previous mark of .968, which had stood since 1998. The Valpo offense has enjoyed a significant statistical uptick over the last three seasons. The Crusaders held a combined average of .279, slugging percentage of .387 and on-base percentage of .372 from 2015-2017, all improvements from a .265/.351/.337 slash line from 2012-2014.

Preseason Poll: The Crusaders were picked to finish eighth in the preseason poll in their first season in The Valley. Dallas Baptist is the preseason favorite to win the league and is ranked 18th nationally by D1Baseball.com, 20th by the NCBWA and 17th in the USA Today Coaches Poll. Missouri State, picked second in The Valley, is ranked 35th nationally by the NCBWA and received 35 votes in the USA Today Preseason Coaches Poll.
