Next Up in Valpo Softball: The Valparaiso University softball team continues Missouri Valley Conference play on the road this weekend, heading to Carbondale, Ill. for a three-game series against Southern Illinois.

Previously: Valpo opened MVC play last weekend at Bradley, dropping both ends of Saturday's doubleheader before rebounding with a win on Sunday in the series finale. The home schedule for the Brown and Gold was scheduled to open up on Wednesday, but the games ended up being cancelled.

Looking Ahead: Should the weather cooperate, Valpo will host IUPUI on Wednesday afternoon for its home opener. The program's first home MVC series of the season is then on tap next weekend against Missouri State.

Following Valpo Softball: All three games this weekend are scheduled to be broadcast live on ESPN+. All three games will also have live stats available via ValpoAthletics.com.

Head Coach Kate Stake: Kate Stake was hired as head coach of the Valparaiso softball program on July 23, 2014 and is in her fifth season as head coach in 2019. Stake, who is 98-126 at Valpo, led the Crusaders to the 2016 Horizon League Championship and a berth in the NCAA Tournament - the third in program history. Stake arrived at Valpo with eight seasons of assistant coaching experience at the Division I level, most recently serving as an assistant at mid-major power Hofstra. She played her collegiate softball at fellow MVC member Illinois State and is a 2005 graduate of ISU.

Series Notes: Valpo and SIU have met just three times in program history. The Salukis won a non-conference game between the two squads to open the 2005 season, 6-0. Last season, playing for the first time as MVC opponents, the two teams split a doubleheader in Valpo: the Crusaders took the opener, 7-6, while the Salukis won the nightcap, 9-6. The third game of that series was cancelled due to inclement weather.

Scouting the Opposition: The Salukis enter the weekend series at 14-9 overall and 2-3 in MVC play, most recently taking one out of three games against Drake last weekend. Jenny Jansen hits a team-best .411, while Ashley Wood has totaled a team-high six home runs and 23 RBIs this season. In the circle, Brianna Jones is 10-6 with a 2.08 ERA and 70 strikeouts in 87.2 innings and has thrown two perfect games this season.

Valpo Picked Sixth in Preseason Poll: Valpo was tabbed to finish in sixth position in the MVC preseason poll, as voted on by the conference's head coaches. Valpo tallied 53 points in the polling to finish in sixth position, just five points behind Illinois State for fifth place. Drake topped the poll with 99 points, including nine first-place votes.

Looking Back at 2018: Valpo made an immediate impact in its transition to the Missouri Valley Conference in 2018. Despite the move to the MVC, which concluded the 2018 season 12th in the nation in conference RPI - a 16-spot jump from the Horizon League the previous year - the Crusaders posted a 27-24 record and improved on their team RPI by 67 spots from the previous season. After being picked ninth in the preseason poll, Valpo earned a fourth-place regular season finish and advanced to the MVC Tournament semifinals. Valpo boasted the MVC Newcomer of the Year and a Second Team All-Conference honoree in Kelsie Packard.

Unfriendly Weather: Valpo was supposed to play its home opener this past Wednesday against Central Michigan, but the scheduled doubleheader was initially adjusted to just one game because of weather and then, after getting in two innings of the single game, the contest was called by the umpires. It's been a rough spring from a weather standpoint for the Crusaders, as they have now had six of their scheduled 25 contests to date cancelled.

Look at the RPI: Valpo's front end of the MVC slate is loaded, as the four MVC teams which currently reside in the top-100 in the NCAA's first RPI release account for the Crusaders' first four Valley series of the season. Valpo came in 191 in the initial RPI release, while as a conference, the MVC currently ranks 11th - one spot higher than its 12th-place finish a year ago. For comparison, the Horizon League was 28th in 2017 in Valpo's final season as a league member.

It Takes Three (or Fewer): It seems overly simplistic, but limiting opponents' run production has been the key to Valpo's wins this season. In all nine of its victories, Valpo's opponent has scored two runs or fewer - including five shutouts. Meanwhile, Valpo has lost all 10 games when it gives up four or more runs.

Taking Advantage of Scoring Opportunities: After going a combined 1-for-15 with runners in scoring position in its first two games at Bradley, both losses, Valpo rebounded in the finale to go 4-for-10 en route to the win over the Braves. In Valpo's nine victories this season, it has hit .329 with runners in scoring position, while in its 10 losses, it is hitting just .185 in the same situations.

Lawton Hitting Bombs: Senior Jaymee Lawton led Valpo offensively in its opening MVC series of the year, hitting .500 and slugging at a 1.375 clip. Her weekend was highlighted by hitting home runs in back-to-back at-bats of the middle game of the series - the third multi-homer game of her Valpo career. Lawton now owns 20 career home runs, eighth-most in program history and just two shy of a tie for sixth.

Taking Down NC State: Valpo closed its time in North Carolina with a 4-0 win over NC State on March 5, shutting out an offense which at that point was averaging better than five runs/game and leading the nation in home runs/game. The Crusaders earned their third win in program history over an ACC team with the win, the last coming as the 2008 squad won at Maryland. It was also Valpo's first shutout of a power conference team since blanking Georgetown, 8-0, in 2007.

Pack Bounces Back: Junior pitcher Kelsie Packard rebounded from taking the loss against Bradley on Saturday, her first loss in nearly a month, to earn the win on Sunday. For Packard, it is the fourth time in her last five losses, dating back to last season, that she has come back with a win in her next appearance. Packard also has earned six victories over Valpo's last four MVC series dating back to last season. Already this season, Packard has thrown a no-hitter against Wagner, earned the win with five shutout innings of relief at NC State, and was named MVC Pitcher of the Week on March 11.

Crusader Tidbits

#1 Addi Burke (So., IF)

- Has made 10 starts at third base and one at designated player this season
- Had pair of multi-hit games in MVC-opening series at Bradley, going 4-for-9 over the three games
- Made highlight-reel play as defensive replacement in March 5 win at NC State, snagging a line drive at third base and doubling up the runner at third for a game-ending double play; play was @NCAASoftball #4 Play of the Week

#2 Jenna Edwards (R-Jr., P)

- Had her best performance in a Valpo uniform March 10 against Buffalo, throwing 5.2 innings of shutout relief with six strikeouts
- Entered with bases loaded and one out in the second inning and escaped jam without allowing a run; went on to allow just two hits and strike out six in the victory
- Pitched last season at Chattanooga State C.C., where she was an All-Conference honoree, recording 17 wins and tallied 154 strikeouts in 148 innings of work

#4 Morgan Matalin (Jr., OF)

- Has started all 19 games in the outfield this year - 11 in left field and eight in center field
- Went 2-for-3 with two doubles and two RBIs in March 2 win over College of Charleston
- Has already drawn five walks this year after going the entire 2018 season without a single walk
- Led Valpo in batting average (.322) and slugging percentage (.508) within MVC play last season

#5 Ashley Barker (So., IF)

- Has made one start at third base and three at designated player this year
- Connected on a double and scored a run in a pinch-hitting appearance on March 3 in the March 1 suspended game against Wagner

#8 Taylor Knight (Fr., P)

- Has made two starts and four relief appearances in the circle this year
- Tossed two shutout innings in March 2 win over College of Charleston
- A two-time First Team All-State honoree for Elkhorn South [Neb.] H.S., helped team to four state championship game appearances and was the winning pitcher in the 2016 state title game

#9 Addison Pixley (Jr., OF)

- Has started three games in right field and two at designated player this year
- Came off the bench with an RBI double and scored a run on March 3 in the March 1 suspended game against Wagner

#10 Jaina Westphal (Fr., OF)

- Went 3-for-11 with two doubles in MVC-opening series at Bradley
- Owns a team-best 10 stolen bases on the year; has already stolen multiple bases three times this season
- Has started all 19 games this season in one of the corner outfield spots (11 in right field; 8 in left field)
- Has reached base successfully in 15 of 19 games
- First Team All-State honoree as a senior at Burlington [Wis.] H.S., helping team to berth in state title game

#11 Carly Trepanier (Jr., IF)

- Recorded a triple in MVC-opening series at Bradley and now owns 10 career triples - fourth-most in program history, one shy of a tie for second, and the most by any Crusader this century
- Ranks sixth in program history in career batting average (.325), seventh in on-base percentage (.394), ninth in hits (175) and tied for tenth in stolen bases (27)
- Has started 163 consecutive games for the Crusaders
- Tied for team-high honors with five multi-hit games on the year and also had a team-best 13-game on-base streak (snapped March 16 G2 at Bradley)
- An MVC All-Defensive Team selection a season ago
- NFCA Third Team All-Midwest Region as a sophomore in 2017

#13 Brittany Anderson (So., UT)

- Has started all 19 games this season - 10 games at first base, six games at third base and three games in right field
- Scored at least one run in seven consecutive games Feb. 22-March 2, including three two-run games
- Has not committed an error in 173 career chances in the field
- Two-sport star at Valpo; an MVC First Team All-Conference honoree on the Crusaders' volleyball team in the fall of 2018, helping to lead team to postseason appearance in the NIVC

#16 Hannah Dybalski (Jr., C)

- Has started three games at catcher and four games at designated player this year
- Drew pair of walks off the bench in nightcap March 16 at Bradley; started next day at DP and produced run-scoring single
- Went 2-for-2 with a double, an RBI and two runs scored in March 1 suspended game victory over Wagner

#20 Jaymee Lawton (Sr., IF)

- Reached base in five of six plate appearances in March 16 twinbill at Bradley, going 4-for-5 with three runs scored and a walk
- Hit home runs in consecutive at-bats in game two of that double-header and now owns 20 career home runs, eighth-most in program history and just two shy of a tie for sixth
- Had an 11-game on-base streak snapped in the series finale at Bradley

Crusader Tidbits

#23 Peyton Moeder (Fr., OF)

- Missed opening weekend due to injury; has started each of the last 13 games (11 in center field, 2 in right field)
- Led way for Valpo offensively in March 17 win at Bradley, going 2-for-3 with a run scored and three RBIs
- Stole a base in all three games of the series against the Braves after swiping just one in her first 11 appearances
- Drew three walks and scored a pair of runs Feb. 24 in win over Princeton
- Two-time First Team All-State honoree at Mill Valley [Kan.] H.S.; helped team win regional titles and finish fourth in state each of her final two seasons

#28 Kelsie Packard (R-Jr., P)

- Bounced back from loss in series opener at Bradley to pick up win in finale, throwing a complete-game six-hitter while striking out six
- Named MVC Pitcher of the Week March 11 after posting a 0.47 ERA in 15 innings of work over two wins, striking out 15 and allowing opponents to hit just .137 against her.
- Threw five shutout innings of relief in March 5 win over NC State, just the third win over an ACC team in program history
- Threw 11th no-hitter in program history March 1 against Wagner - game was suspended after three innings and resumed March 3, when she threw the final two innings
- MVC Newcomer of the Year and a Second Team All-MVC selection in 2018 in her first season as a Crusader
- Went 6-3 with a 1.78 ERA and struck out 78 batters over 67 innings in conference action last season

#32 Maddie Henry (Fr., C/UT)

- Has made three pinch-hit appearances this year
- Connected on her first collegiate hit in resumption of suspended game against Wagner March 3, an RBI double
- Played travel ball for Team Glory Fastpitch, where she was coached by former Crusader Maggie Seidel

#33 Taylor Herschbach (Fr., IF)

- Has appeared in 18 of 19 games in her rookie season, including 17 starts - 8 at designated player, 6 at 1st base, 2 at 3rd base and 1 at shortstop
- Owns Valpo's longest hitting streak of the year, hitting in seven straight games March 1-10
- Scored at least one run in five straight games Feb. 24-March 3
- Second Team All-State honoree as a senior at Lockport Township [Ill.] H.S.

#45 Emily Richardson (Jr., P)

- Has pitched in eight games this season, making four starts and four relief appearances
- Threw two shutout innings in March 5 win over NC State, striking out four

- Has made the first two plate appearances of her career this season, drawing a bases-loaded walk for an RBI in her first PA at Mississippi State Feb. 9 and connecting on a single in the resumption of the Wagner suspended game March 3
- Threw no-hitter last season against North Carolina Central, striking out a career-high 11 batters; was Valpo's first seven-inning no-no since 2002
- Went 4-2 with a 2.71 ERA and four saves in 72.1 innings of work last year, striking out 67 batters while surrendering just 51 hits

#88 Taylor Tonoian (Fr., C)

- Has appeared in 18 of Valpo's 19 games, making 16 starts behind the plate
- Picked off runner on 3rd base in 8th inning of March 10 game at Lipscomb in eventual 10-inning victory for Valpo
- Recorded two RBIs in Feb. 24 win over Princeton

Andie Kalembe - Team IMPACT

- Joined the Crusader program in February of 2016 in conjunction with Team IMPACT - a nonprofit that creates team-based support systems for children facing life-threatening and chronic illnesses
- Was diagnosed with Fanconi Anemia - a rare genetic condition which affects many parts of the body - when she was just eight months old. People with Fanconi Anemia may have bone marrow failure, physical abnormalities, organ defects, and an increased risk of certain cancers.
- Is in her fourth season as a team member, and not only has being a member of Team IMPACT and the Crusader softball program had a positive impact on Andie, but also the impact that Andie has had on all the members of the softball team is immeasurable
- Is currently a sophomore in high school
- Celebrated the 10-year anniversary of her bone marrow transplant in April of 2018

Head Coach Kate Stake

- Fifth season as head coach of the Crusaders; owns 98 career wins and led Valpo to the 2016 Horizon League Tournament championship and an NCAA Regional berth
- Led Valpo as it transitioned from the Horizon League - the nation's 28th-ranked conference by RPI - to the Missouri Valley Conference - which ranked 12th in the nation in RPI last year.
- Has raised Valpo's profile over her four years - program was 263 in RPI her first season with a 16-35 record, and finished last year 27-24 with an RPI of 136
- Previously spent two seasons as an assistant coach at mid-major powerhouse Hofstra, three years as an assistant at the United States Military Academy and two years as a full-time assistant at Eastern Illinois
- Was a collegiate standout for Melinda Fischer at Illinois State, where she was a four-year starter at second base
- A four-time All-MVC selection for the Redbirds; earned First Team All-MVC honors each of her final two years
- Second Team Academic All-American as a senior
