**Next Up in Valpo Softball:** As the regular season winds down, Valpo takes the field for four MVC games this week. The Brown and Gold close out a five-game homestand with a home game Wednesday at Loyola, and then faces their final road conference tests of the year this weekend at Evansville.

**Previously:** Valpo claimed two of three games in its series last weekend against Indiana State, winning in walk-off fashion in the opener, 7-6, and rallying in the sixth inning for a 7-5 win in the middle game before the Sycamores claimed a 9-1 win in the finale. Freshman Peyton Moeder led Valpo with seven hits over the three games en route to claiming MVC Newcomer of the Week honors.

**Looking Ahead:** The regular season comes to an end next week with a non-conference twinbill at Northern Illinois and a home series against Illinois State.

**Following Valpo Softball:** The Loyola game will have a live audio broadcast on WVUR (95.1 FM, Valparaiso), while all three games of the Evansville series can be seen live on ESPN+. Live stats for all four games will also be available via ValpoAthletics.com.

**Head Coach Kate Stake:** Kate Stake was hired as head coach of the Valparaiso softball program on July 23, 2014 and is in her fifth season as head coach in 2019. Stake, who is 104-139 at Valpo, led the Crusaders to the 2016 Horizon League Championship and a berth in the NCAA Tournament - the third in program history. Stake arrived at Valpo with eight seasons of assistant coaching experience at the Division I level, most recently serving as an assistant at mid-major power Hofstra. She played her collegiate softball at fellow MVC member Illinois State and is a 2005 graduate of ISU.

**Series Notes:** The second-most common opponent in program history, Valpo is now 26-41 all-time against Loyola after dropping a road doubleheader earlier this year to the Ramblers, 4-2 and 9-1. Meanwhile, the Crusaders are just 4-14 all-time against Evansville, with the Purple Aces taking two of three games in Valpo last season. Prior to last year, the Purple Aces and Crusaders had not faced off since 1998.

**Valpo Picked Sixth in Preseason Poll:** Valpo was tabbed to finish in sixth position in the MVC preseason poll, as voted on by the conference's head coaches. Valpo tallied 53 points in the polling to finish in sixth position, just five points behind Illinois State for fifth place. Drake topped the poll with 99 points, including nine first-place votes.

**Looking Back at 2018:** Valpo made an immediate impact in its transition to the Missouri Valley Conference in 2018. Despite the move to the MVC, which concluded the 2018 season 12th in the nation in conference RPI - a 16-spot jump from the Horizon League the previous year - the Crusaders posted a 27-24 record and improved on their team RPI by 67 spots from the previous season. After being picked ninth in the preseason poll, Valpo earned a fourth-place regular season finish and advanced to the MVC Tournament semifinals. Valpo boasted the MVC Newcomer of the Year and a Second Team All-Conference honoree in Kelsie Packard.

**Look at the Ratings:** Valpo's front end of the MVC slate was loaded, as the four MVC teams which currently reside in the top-100 in the RPI accounted for the Crusaders' first four Valley weekend series. In Monday's NCAA RPI release, Valpo came in at 176, while as a conference, the MVC boasted four top-100 teams and ranked 10th- one spot higher than its 12th-place finish a year ago. For comparison, the Horizon League was 28th in 2017 in Valpo's final season as a league member. In fact, Valpo has already played 16 games this year against top-100 RPI teams, 11 of which have come in MVC play - compared to 13 such games in its final two years in the Horizon League combined, none of which were league games.

**Moeder Named Newcomer of the Week:** Freshman Peyton Moeder became the third Valpo player to earn an MVC weekly honor this year, as she was named the MVC Newcomer of the Week for her performances last week. Moeder recorded hits in all four games, going 8-for-15 with four runs scored, in extending her on-base streak to a season-best seven games. She became the first Valpo player with a three-hit game this year, doing so in each of the first two games of the series with Indiana State, both wins. She also scored a Valpo season-high three runs in the series-opening win against the Sycamores, including the game-tying run. In the middle game of the series, she drove in a run in the bottom of the 6th with an RBI single to cut Valpo's deficit to one, and was the lead runner on the game-deciding three-run double. Moeder joins Kelsie Packard (Pitcher of the Week - March 11) and Jaina Westphal (Newcomer of the Week - April 1) as Valpo's MVC award winners this season.

**Walking It Off:** A three-run bottom of the 7th in mid-week action against Western Michigan gave Valpo a 4-3 walk-off win, and then in the series opener against Indiana State, after surrendering five runs in the top of the 7th, the Crusaders scored two runs in the bottom of the inning for a 7-6 walk-off victory. It marked Valpo's first consecutive walk-off wins since May of 2012, when the Crusaders actually captured the Horizon League Tournament title on three straight walk-off victories, the last two of which came on walk-off hits from Angie Doerffler.

**In the Middle of the Action:** Both walk-off wins featured senior Carly Trepanier, as she delivered the game-winning hit against Western Michigan before scoring the game-winning run in the series opener versus Indiana State. Trepanier has now been part of five walk-offs over her four years at Valpo, either as the winning hit or the winning run, tied for the most in program history.

**Lawton Delivers Big Hits:** Senior Jaymee Lawton came up to bat with the bases loaded in the first inning of the middle game of the series with Indiana State and popped out. At that point, Lawton had no way of knowing she would have two more at-bats in that game with the Sycamores with the bases loaded, and both times, she would come through. In the 3rd and the 6th inning of that game, Lawton again stepped to the plate with the bases loaded, and both times, she delivered a three-run double - the latter giving Valpo the 7-5 lead in its eventual win. Her six RBIs in the opener were a career best, surpassing her previous mark of four, and a Valpo season high. It is just the 10th time in program history that a single player has driven in six or more runs in a single game, and the first such occurrence since Jenna Stauffenberg did it on Feb. 19, 2017.

**First Career Win:** Freshman Taylor Knight picked up the first victory of her Valpo career in the circle in the middle game of the Indiana State series. After surrendering five runs to the Sycamores over the first two innings, Knight settled in and posted four consecutive shutout frames to earn the win. She threw a career-best six innings in the winning effort, just the second time this year she has pitched more than four innings.

## Crusader Tidbits

### #1 Addi Burke (So., IF)

- Has made 17 starts at third base and six at designated player this season
- Scored game-tying run in seventh inning in win over WMU
- Had pair of multi-hit games in MVC-opening series at Bradley, going 4-for-9 over the three games
- Made highlight-reel play as defensive replacement in March 5 win at NC State, snagging a line drive at third base and doubling up the runner at third for a game-ending double play; play was @NCAASoftball #4 Play of the Week

### #2 Jenna Edwards (R-Jr., P)

- Picked up consecutive complete-game wins over WMU April 17 and Indiana State April 19, and added a save in middle game of ISU series
- Tossed a gem in nightcap against Drake April 6, taking a tough-luck 1-0 loss in a three-hitter, striking out seven
- Threw a complete-game five-hitter with a season-best 10 K's in the nightcap win April 1 vs. Missouri State, and followed with five innings of three-hit ball, giving up just one run, to earn the win at UIC April 3
- Earned first career save in March 27 appearance versus IUPUI, throwing two shutout innings
- Had her longest scoreless performance in a Valpo uniform March 10 against Buffalo, throwing 5.2 innings of shutout relief with six strikeouts
- Pitched last season at Chattanooga State C.C., where she was an All-Conference honoree, recording 17 wins and tallied 154 strikeouts in 148 innings of work

### #4 Morgan Matalin (Jr., OF)

- Has started all 38 games in the outfield this year - 30 in left field and eight in center field
- Picked up hits in all three games of Indiana State series, going 4-for-9 with three runs; kicked off four-run rally in bottom of 6th of middle game with leadoff triple
- Connected on three-run homer in middle game of SIU series; picked up game-winning RBI with tie-breaking RBI single in fifth inning against IUPUI
- Went 2-for-3 with two doubles and two RBIs in March 2 win over College of Charleston
- Led Valpo in batting average (.322) and slugging percentage (.508) with in MVC play last season

### #5 Ashley Barker (So., IF)

- Has made four starts at third base and six at designated player this year
- Reached base three times in middle game of series with Indiana State, going 2-for-3 with a walk, a double and a run scored
- Drew a walk to lead off eventual five-run inning in nightcap win over Missouri State April 1
- Connected on a double and scored a run in a pinch-hitting appearance on March 3 in the March 1 suspended game against Wagner

### #8 Taylor Knight (Fr., P)

- Has made four starts and 10 relief appearances in the circle this year
- Earned first collegiate victory in opener April 20 against Indiana State, closing out a six-inning start with four consecutive scoreless frames
- Threw 1.2 shutout innings in opener April 1 against Missouri State
- Tossed two shutout innings in March 2 win over College of Charleston
- Two-time First Team All-State honoree for Elkhorn South [Neb.] H.S., helped team to four state title game appearances and was the winning pitcher in the 2016 state title game

### #9 Addie Pixley (Jr., OF)

- Has started three games in right field and two at DP this year
- Came off the bench with an RBI double and scored a run on March 3 in

the March 1 suspended game against Wagner

### #10 Jaina Westphal (Fr., OF)

- Scored game-winning run April 17 against WMU to cap off a 2-for-3, two-run, one-RBI performance
- Has hit three home runs this year, most recently connecting on a two-run shot against IUPUI March 27
- Went 3-for-11 with two doubles in MVC-opening series at Bradley
- Owns a team-best 12 stolen bases on the year; has already stolen multiple bases three times this season
- Has started all 38 games this season in one of the corner outfield spots (27 in right field; 11 in left field)
- First Team All-State honoree as a senior at Burlington [Wis.] H.S., helping team to berth in state title game

### #11 Carly Trepanier (Jr., IF)

- Went 4-for-10 with two runs scored and three RBIs in series against Indiana State; scored walk-off run in series opener
- Capped 2-for-4 performance with walk-off two-run single April 17 in win over WMU
- Ranks fourth in program history in triples (10), sixth in hits (188), sixth in total bases (261), seventh in on-base percentage (.392), ninth in batting average (.319), 10th in stolen bases (28) and 10th in walks (60).
- Has started 183 consecutive games for the Crusaders
- Leads Valpo with eight multi-hit games on the year and also had a team-best 13-game on-base streak (snapped March 16 G2 at Bradley)
- An MVC All-Defensive Team selection a season ago
- NFCA Third Team All-Midwest Region as a sophomore in 2017

### #13 Brittany Anderson (So., UT)

- Has started all 38 games this season - 29 games at first base, six games at third base and three games in right field
- Has walked three times in one game twice this year, matching a Valpo season high - most recently reached base in all four PAs in middle game of Indiana State series, going 1-for-1 with three walks and two runs scored
- Hit fourth home run of the season April 14 at UNI, a three-run homer in the third inning
- Scored at least one run in seven consecutive games Feb. 22-March 2, including three two-run games
- Two-sport star at Valpo; an MVC First Team All-Conference honoree on the Crusaders' volleyball team in the fall of 2018, helping to lead team to postseason appearance in the NIVC

### #16 Hannah Dybalski (Jr., C)

- Has started 13 games at catcher and five games at DP this year
- Kicked off seventh-inning rally April 17 against WMU with a leadoff double, eventually scoring a run as well
- Delivered 3-run homer in series finale against Drake April 7
- Connected on first career home run in April 3 win at UIC as part of 1-of-2, 2-run, 2-RBI, 1-walk performance
- Went 2-for-2 with a double, an RBI and two runs scored in March 1 suspended game victory over Wagner

## Crusader Tidbits

- Connected on decisive grand slam in nightcap win over Missouri State April 1, her second career grand slam
- Hit home runs in consecutive at-bats in game two of Bradley double-header March 16, part of a 4-for-5, 3-runs, 1-walk twinbill
- Now owns 21 career home runs, eighth-most in program history and just one shy of a tie for sixth
- Had an 11-game on-base streak snapped in the series finale at Bradley
- Hit 11 home runs last season, tied for second in the MVC and tied for fourth in a single season in Valpo history

### #23 Peyton Moeder (Fr., OF)

- Missed opening weekend due to injury; has started each of the last 323 games (31 in center field, 2 in right field)
- MVC Newcomer of the Week April 22
- Posted Valpo's first three-hit games of the year, going 3-for-4 in back-to-back games in the first two games of the Indiana State series; also scored a Valpo season-high three runs in the series opener
- Led way for Valpo offensively in March 17 win at Bradley, going 2-for-3 with a run scored and three RBIs
- Stole a base in all three games of the series against the Braves after swiping just one in her first 11 appearances
- Two-time First Team All-State honoree at Mill Valley [Kan.] H.S.; helped team win regional titles and finish fourth in state each of her final two seasons

### #28 Kelsie Packard (R-Jr., P)

- Suffered injury while warming up for fifth inning April 1 against Missouri State and has been sidelined since
- Earned mid-week win over IUPUI with five innings of two-hit work
- Named MVC Pitcher of the Week March 11 after posting a 0.47 ERA in 15 innings of work over two wins, striking out 15 and allowing opponents to hit just .137 against her
- Threw five shutout innings of relief in March 5 win over NC State, just the third win over an ACC team in program history
- Threw 11th no-hitter in program history March 1 against Wagner - game was suspended after three innings and resumed March 3, when she threw the final two innings
- MVC Newcomer of the Year and a Second Team All-MVC selection in 2018 in her first season as a Crusader
- Went 6-3 with a 1.78 ERA and struck out 78 batters over 67 innings in conference action last season

### #32 Maddie Henry (Fr., C/UT)

- Has made six pinch-hit appearances this year
- Knocked a single back up the middle April 3 at UIC
- Connected on her first collegiate hit in resumption of suspended game against Wagner March 3, an RBI double
- Played travel ball for Team Glory Fastpitch, where she was coached by former Crusader Maggie Seidel
